ILLINOIS OPEN-END MORTGAGE (Securing Future Advances)

THIS MORTGAGE is made on December 26, 1995. The mortgagor is Cardell Williams and Linda Williams, His Wife ("Borrower"). This Mortgago is given to MENA Consumer Services, Inc., a Delaware corporation whose address is 400 Christiana Road, Newark, Delaware 19713. In this Mortgago, the terms "you," "your" and "yours" refer to the mortgagor(s). The terms "we," "us" and "our" refer to MBNA Consumer Services, Inc.

Pursuant to a Home Equity Line of Credit Agreement dated the same date as this Mortgage ("Agreement"), you may incur maximum unpaid loan indebtedness (exclusive of interest thereon) in amounts fluctuating from time to time up to the maximum principal sum outstanding at any time of Thirty One Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (U.S. \$31,000.00). The Agreement establishes the rate(s) of interest to be charged thereunder and provides for a final scheduled installment due and payable on January 5, 2016. You agree that this Mortgage shall continue to secure all sums now of hereafter advanced under the terms of the Agreement including, without limitation, such sums that are advanced by us whother or not at the time the sums are advanced there is any principal sum outstanding under the Agreement. The parties hereto intend that this mortgage shall secure unpaid balances, and all other amounts due to us hereunder and under the Agreement.

This Mortgage secures to us: (a) the repayment of the debt evidenced by the Agreement, with interest, and all refinancings, renewals, extensions and modifications of the Agreement; (b) the payment of all other sums, with interest, advanced under this Mortgage to protect the security of this Mortgage; and (c) the performance of your covenants and agreements under this Mortgage and the Agreement. For this purpose and in consideration of the debt, you do to by mortgage, grant, convey and warrant (unless you are an illinois land trust, in which case you mortgage, grant, convey and principalism) to us and our successors and assigns the property located in Cook County, Illinois and more fully described in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, which property is more commonly known as 4954 Wast 186th Street, Country Club Hills, Illinois 60478 ("Property Address"), hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of the homestead examption laws of Illinois;

TOGETHER WITH all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, and fixtures now or hereafter a part of the property. All replacements and additions shall also be covered by this Mortgage. All of the foregoing is referred to in this Mortgage as the "Property."

YOU COVENANT that you are lawfully seized of the sainte hereby conveyed and have the right to mortgage, grant, convey and, if you are not and illinois land trust, then also warrant the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Unless you are an illinois land trust, you warrant and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any encumbrances of record.

YOU AND WE covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. Payment of Principal, Interest and Other Charges. You shall pay when due the principal of and interest owing under the Agreement and all other charges due under the Agreement.
- 2. Prior Mortgages: Charges: Liens. You shall perform all of your obligations under any mortgage, deed of trust or other security instruments with a lien which has priority over this Mortgage, including your covenants to make payments when due. You shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Mortgage or any advance under this Mortgage, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Upon our request, you shall

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promptly furnish to us all notices of amounts to be paid under this paragraph and receipts evidencing any such payments you make directly.

You shall promptly discharge any lien (other than a lien disclosed to us in your application or in any title report

we obtained) which has priority over this Mortgage or any advance to be made under the Agreement or this Mortgage.

3. Hazard Insurance. You shall keep the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards included within the term dextended coverage" and any other hazards, including floods or flooding, for which we require insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that we require. You may choose any insurer reasonably acceptable to us.

Insurance policies and renewals shall be acceptable to us and shall include a standard mortgage clause. If we require, you shall promptly give us all receipts of pald premiums and renewal notices. You shall promptly notify the insurer and us

of any loss. We may make proof of loss if you do not promptly do so.

Insurance proceeds shall be applied to restore or repair the Property damaged, if restoration or repair is economically feasible and our security would not be lessened. Otherwise, insurance proceeds shall be applied to sums secured by this Mortgage, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to you. If you abandon the Property, or do not answer within 30 days our notice to you that the insurer has offered to settle a claim, then we may collect and use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Mortgage, whether or not then due. The 30-day period will begin when notice is given.

Any application of proceeds to principal shall not require us to extend or postpone the due date of monthly payments. If we acquire the Projecty at a forced sale following your default, your right to any insurance proceeds resulting from damage to the Property prior to the acquisition shall pass to us to the extent of the sums secured by this Mortgage immediately prior to the acquisition.

- 4. Preservation and Mainterance of Property; Leaseholds. You shall not destroy, damage or substantially change the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate or commit waste. If this Mortgage is on a leasehold, you shall comply with the lease. If you acquire fee title to the Property, the leasehold and fee title shall not merge unless we agree to the merger in writing.
- 5. Protection of Our Rights in the Property; Mortgage Insurance. If you fail to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Mortgage, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect our rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or forfeiture or to enforce laws or regulations), then we may do, and pay for, anything necessary to protect the Property's value and our rights in the Property. Our actions may include paying any sums secured by a tien which has priority over this Mortgage or any advance under the Agreement or this Mortgage, appearing in court, paying reasonable attorneys' fees, paying any sums which you are movined to pay under this Mortgage and entering on the Property to make repairs. We do not have to take any action we are permitted to the under this paragraph. Any amounts we pay under this paragraph shall become additional debts you owe us and shall be secured by this Mortgage. These amounts shall bear interest from the disbursement date at the rate established under the Agreement and shall be payable, with interest, upon our request.

If we required mortgage insurance as a condition of making the lean secured by this Mortgage, you shall pay the premiums for such insurance until such time as the requirement for the insurance terminates.

6. Inspection. We may inspect the Property at any reasonable time and upon reasonable notice.

7. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to us.

8. You are Not Released; Forbearance by Us Not a Waiver. Extension of time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Mortgage granted by us to any of your successors in interest single not operate to release your liability or the liability of your successors in interest. We shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest, refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Mortgage by reason of any demand made by you or your successors in interest. Our forbearance in exercising any right or remedy shall not waive or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.

9. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability: Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Mortgage shall bind and benefit your successors and permitted assigns. Your covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Anyone who co-signs this Mortgage but does not execute the Agreement: (a) is co-signing this Mortgage only to mortgage, grant and convey such person's interest in the Property; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the Agreement, but is obligated to pay all other sums secured by this Mortgage; and (c) agrees that we and anyone else who signs this Mortgage may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations regarding the terms of this Mortgage or the Agreement without such person's consent.

10. Notices. Unless otherwise required by law, any notice to you provided for in this Mortgage shall be delivered or mailed by first class mail to the Property Address or any other address you designate by notice to us. Unless otherwise required by law, any notice to us shall be given by first class mail to our address stated above or any other address we designate by notice to you.

11. Governing Law: Severability. This Mortgage shall be governed by federal law and, except as preempted by federal law, by the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Mortgage or the Agreement conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Mortgage or the

Agreement which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Mortgage and the Agreement are declared to be severable.

- 12. Transfer of the Property. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in you is sold or transferred and you are not a natural person) without our prior written consent, we may, at our option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Mortgage. However, this option shall not be exercised by us if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Mortgage.
- 13. Sale of Agreement; Change of Loan Servicer. The Agreement or a partial interest in the Agreement (together with this Mortgage) may be sold one or more times without prior notice to you. A sale may result in a change in the entity (known as the "Loan Servicer") that collects monthly payments due under the Agreement and this Mortgage. There also may be one or more changes of the Loan Servicer unrelated to the sale of the Agreement. If there is a change of the Loan Servicer, you will be given written notice of the change as required by applicable law. The notice will state the name and address of the new Loan Servicer and the address to which payments should be made. The notice will also contain any information required by applicable law.
- 14. Hazardous Substances. You shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storage, or release of any Hazardous Substances on o, in the Property. You shall not do, nor allow anyone else to do, anything affecting the Property that is in violation of any Environmental Law. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Property of Hazardous Substance. To quantities that are generally recognized to be appropriate to normal residential uses and to maintenance of the Property.

You shall promptly give as written notice of any investigation, claim, demand, lawsuit or other action by any governmental or regulatory agency or private party involving the Property and any Hazardous Substance or Environmental Law of which you have actual knowledge. If you lead or are notified by any government or regulatory authority, that any removal or other remediation of any Hazardous Substance affecting the Property is necessary, you shall promptly take all necessary remedial actions in accordance with Environmental Law.

As used in this Mortgage, "Hazardous Substances" are those substances defined as toxic or hazardous substances by Environmental Law and the following substances: gasonics, kerosene, other flammable or toxic perfoleum products, toxic pesticides and herbicides, volatile solvents, materials containing reports or formaldehyde, and radioactive materials. As used in this Mortgage, "Environmental Law" means federal laws and lava or the jurisdiction where the Property is located that relate to health, safety or environmental protection.

- breach of any covenant or agreement in this Mortgage (but not prior to acceleration following Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in this Mortgage (but not prior to acceleration under paragraph 12 unless applicable law provides otherwise). The notice shall specify: (a) the default; (b) the exton required to cure the default; (c) a date, not less than 30 days from the date the notice is given to Borrower, by which the default must be cured; and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage, foreclosure by judicial proceeding and sale of the Property. The notice shall further deferm Borrower of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in the foreclosure proceeding the non-existence of a default or any other defense of Borrower to acceleration and foreclosure. If the default is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice, Lender at its option may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Mortgage without further demand and may foreclose this Mortgage by judicial proceeding. Lender shall be entitled to collect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this paragraph 15, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' feet and costs of title avidence.
- 16. Lender in Possession. Upon acceleration under this Mortgage, abandonment or vacating of the Property and at any time prior to the expiration of any period of redemption following judicial sale, we (in person, by agent, or by judicially appointed receiver) shall be entitled to enter upon, take possession of and manage the Property and to collect the rents of the Property including those past due. Any rents collected by us or the receiver shall be applied first to payment of the costs of management of the Property and collection of rents, including, but not limited to, receiver's fees, premiums on receiver's bonds and reasonable attorneys' fees, and then to the sums secured by this Mortgage. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as constituting us a "mortgagee in possession," unless we shall have entered into and shall remain in actual possession of the Property.
- 17. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Mortgage, Lender shall release this Mortgage without charge to Borrower shall reimburse Lender for any recordation costs.
- 18. Receipt of Sums Pending Foreclosure. You agree that the acceptance of rents, hazard insurance proceeds, condemnation awards or any other sums of whatever nature or origin to be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage after the commencement of foreclosure proceedings prior to the expiration of any right of redemption shall not constitute a waiver of such foreclosure.
 - 19. Walvers. Borrower walves all rights of homestead exemption in the Property.
