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TOGETHER WITH all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, mineral, oil and gas rights and profits, water rights and stock and all fixtures now or hereafter a part of the property. All replacements and additions shall also be covered by this Security Instrument. All of the foregoing is referred to in this Security Instrument as the "Property."

BORROWER COVENANTS that Borrower is lawfully seized of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered. Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property

against all claims and demands, subject to any encumbrances of record.

1. Payment of Principal, Interest and Late Charge. Borrower shall pay when due the principal of, and interest on, the debt

evidenced by the Note.

2. Payment of Property Charges. Borrower shall pay all property charges consisting of taxes, ground rents, flood and hazard insurance premiums, and assessments in a timely manner, and shall provide evidence of payment to Lender, unless Lender pays property charges by withholding funds from monthly payments due to the Borrower or by charging such payments to a line of credit

as provided for in the Lorn Agreement.

3. Fire, Flood and Other Hazard Insurance. Borrower shall insure all improvements on the Property, whether now in existence or subsequently erected, against any hazards, casualties, and contingencies, including fire. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts, to the extent and for the periods required by Lender and the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development ("Secretary"). Borrower shall also move all improvements on the Property, whether now in existence or subsequently erected, against loss by floods to the extent required by the Secretary. All insurance shall be carried with companies approved by Lender. The insurance policies and any renewals shall be held by Lender and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of, and in a form acceptable to, Lender.

In the event of loss, Borrower shall give Leader immediate notice by mail. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower. Each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss to Borrower and to Lender jointly. Insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the damaged Property, if the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lender's security is not testened. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's security would be lessened, the insurance proceeds shall or applied first to the reduction of any indebtedness under a Second Note and Second Security instrument held by the Secretary on the Property and then to the reduction of the indebtedness under the Note and this Security instrument. Any excess insurance proceeds over an amount required to pay all outstanding indebtedness under the Note and this Security Instrument shall be paid to the entity legally entitled thereto.

In the event of foreclosure of this Security Instrument or other transfer of title to the Property that extinguishes the indebtedness,

all right, title and interest of Borrower in and to insurance policies in force, stall pass to the purchaser.

4. Preservation and Maintenance of the Property, Leaseholds. Borrower shall not commit waste or destroy, damage substantially change the Property or allow the Property to deteriorate, reasonable wear and tear excepted. Lender may inspect the Property is vacant or abandoned or the loan is in default. Lender may take reasonable action to protect and preservation vacant or abandoned Property. If this Security Instrument is on a leasehold, Borrower shall comply with the provisions of the lease. It Borrower acquires fee title to the Property, the leasehold and fee title shall not be merged unless Lender agrees to the merge in writing.

5. Charges to Borrower and Protection of Lender's Rights in the Property. Borrower shall pay all governmental or municipal charges, fines and impositions that are not included in Paragraph 2. Borrower shall pay these obligations on time directly to the extity which is owed the payment. If failure to pay would adversely affect Lender's interest in the Property, upon Lender's request Horrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing these payments. Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien

which has priority over this Security Instrument in the manner provided in Paragraph 12(c).

If Borrower fails to make these payments or the property charges required by Paragraph 2, or fails to perform any other covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, for condemnation or to enforce laws or regulations), then Lender may do and pay whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property, including payment of taxes, hazard insurance and other items mentioned in Paragraph 2.

Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this Paragraph shall become an additional debt of Borrower as provided for in the Loan

Agreement and shall be secured by this Security Instrument.

To protect Lender's security in the Property, Lender shall advance and charge to Borrower all amounts due to the Secretary for the Mortgage insurance Premium as defined in the Loan Agreement as well as all sums due to the loan servicer for servicing activities as defined in the Loan Agreement.

6. Inspection. Lender or its agent may enter on, inspect or make appraisals of the Property in a reasonable manner and at reasonable times provided that Lender shall give the Borrower notice prior to any inspection or appraisal specifying a purpose for the

inspection or appraisal which must be related to Lender's interest in the Property.

7. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in place of condemnation shall be paid to Lender and Borrower jointly. The proceeds shall be applied first to the reduction of any indebtedness under a Second Note and Second Security

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Instrument held by the Secretary to the Property, and then to the reduction of the indebtedness under the Note and this Security Instrument. Any excess proceeds over an amount required to pay all outstanding indebtedness under the Note and this Security Instrument shall be paid to the entity legally entitled thereto.

8. Fees. Lender may collect fees and charges authorized by the Secretary.

9. Grounds for Acceleration of Debt.

(a) Due and Payable. Lender may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument if:

(i) A Borrower dies and the Property is not the principal residence of at least one surviving Borrower; or

(ii) A Borrower conveys all of his or her title in the Property and no other Borrower retains title to the Property in fee simple or retains a leasehold under a lease for less than ninety-nine years which is renewable or a lease having a remaining period of not less than 50 years beyond the date of the 100th birthday of the youngest Borrower.

(b) Due and Payable with Secretary Approval. Lender may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this

Security Instrument, upon approval of the Secretary, if:

- (i) The Property ceases to be the principal residence of a Borrower for reasons other than death and the Property is not the principal residence of at least one other Borrower; or
- (ii) For a period of longer than 12 consecutive months, a Borrower fails to occupy the Property because of physical or mental illness and the Property is not the principal residence of at least one other Borrower; or
  - (iii) An obligation of the Borrower under this Security Instrument is not performed.

"Principal residence" shall have the same meaning as in the Loan Agreement.

(c) Notice to Lender. Borrower shall notify Lender whenever any of the events listed in subparagraphs (a) and (b) of this

Paragraph 9 occur.

- (d) Notice to Secretary and Borrower. Lender shall notify the Secretary and Borrower whenever the loan becomes due and payable under this Paragraph 9. Lender shall not have the right to foreclose until Borrower has had thirty (30) days after notice to either:
  - (i) Correct the matter which resulted in the Security Instrument coming due and payable: or

(ii) Pay the balance in full; or

(iii) Sell the Property for at least 95% of the appraised value and apply the net proceeds of the sale toward the balance;

(iv) Provide the Lender with a deed in lieu of foreclosury.

(e) Trusts. Conveyance of a Borrower's interest in the Property to a trust which meets the requirements of the Secretary, or conveyance of a trust's interest in the Property to a Borrower, shall not be considered a conveyance for purposes of this Paragraph. A trust shall not be considered an occupant or be considered as having a principal residence for purposes of this Paragraph.

10. No Deficiency Judgments. Borrower shall have no personal liability for payment of the debt. Lender may enforce the debt only through sale of the Property. Lender shall not be permitted to obtain a deficiency judgment against Borrower if the Property is foreclosed. If this Security Instrument is assigned to the Secretary, Borrower shall not be liable for any difference between the mortgage insurance benefits paid to Lender and the outstanding indebtedness, including account interest, owed by Borrower at the

time of the assignment.

- 11. Reinstatement. Borrower has a right to be reinstated if Lender has required immediate payment in full. This right applies even after foreclosure proceedings are instituted. To reinstate this Security Instrument, Borrower shall located the condition which resulted in the requirement for immediate payment in full. Foreclosure costs and reasonable and custories; attorney's fees and expenses properly associated with the foreclosure proceeding shall be added to the principal balance. Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations that it secures shall remain in effect as if Lender had not required immediate payment in full. However, Lender is not required to permit reinstatement if: (i) Lender has accepted reinstatement after the commencement of foreclosure proceedings within two (2) years immediately preceding the commencement of a current foreclosure proceeding, (ii) reinstatement will preclude foreclosure on different grounds in the future, or (iii) reinstatement will adversely affect the priority of the mediate payment in the future, or (iii) reinstatement will adversely affect the priority of the mediate payment in the future, or (iii) reinstatement will adversely affect the priority
  - 12. First Lien Status.
  - (a) Modification. If state law limits the first lien status of this Security Instrument as originally executed and recorded, to a maximum amount of debt or a maximum number of years, or if state law otherwise prevents the Lender from making Loan Advances secured by the first lien, Borrower agrees to execute any additional documents required by the Lender and approved by the Secretary to extend the first lien status to an additional amount of debt and an additional number of years and to cause any other liens to be removed or subordinated as provided in the Loan Agreement. If state law does not permit extension of the first lien status, whether or not due to any action of Borrower, then for purposes of Paragraph 9 Borrower will be deemed to have failed to have performed an obligation under this Security Instrument.
    - (b) Tax Deferral Programs. Borrower shall not participate in a real estate tax deferral program, if any liens created by

the tax deferral are not subordinate to this Security Instrument.



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(c) Prior Liens. Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien which has priority over this Security Instrument unless Borrower: (a) agrees in writing to the payment of the obligation secured by the lien in a manner acceptable to Lender; (b) contests in good faith the lien by, or defends against enforcement of the lien in, legal proceedings which in the Lender's opinion operate to prevent the enforcement of the lien or furfeiture of any part of the Property; or (c) secures from the holder of the lien an agreement satisfactory to Lender subordinating the lien to all amounts secured by this Security Instrument. If Lender determines that any part of the Property is subject to a lien which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, Lender may give Borrower a notice identifying the lien. Borrower shall satisfy the lien or take one more of the actions set forth above within ten (10) days of the giving of notice.

13. Relationship to Second Security Instrument.

(a) Second Security Instrument. In order to secure payments which the Secretary may make to or on behalf of Borrower pursuant to Section 255(i)(1)(A) of the National Housing Act and the Loan Agreement, the Secretary has required Borrower to grant a Second Security Instrument on the Property to the Secretary.

(b) Relation by of First and Second Security Instruments. Payments made by the Secretary shall not be included in the

debt under the Note secured by this Security Instrument unless:

(i) This Security instrument is assigned to the Secretary; or

(ii) The Secretary accepts reimbursement by the Lender for all payments made by the Secretary.

If the circumstances described in (i) or (ii) occur, then all payments by the Secretary, including interest on the payments but excluding late charges paid by the Secretary, shall be included in the debt.

(c) Effect on Borrower. Where there is no assignment or reimbursement as described in (b)(i) or (ii) and the Secretary

makes payments to Borrower, then Borrower shall not:

(i) Be required to pay amounts owed under the Note, or pay any rents and revenues of the Property under Paragraph 19 to Lender or a receiver of the Property, until the Secretary has required payment in full of all outstanding principal and accrued interest under the Second Note held by Secretary and secured by the Second Security Instrument; or

(ii) Be obligated to pay interest or shared (pp eriation under the Note at any time, whether accrued before or after the payments by the Secretary, and whether or not acc used interest has been included in the principal balance under the Note.

(d) No Duty of the Secretary. The Secretary has no dray to Lender to enforce covenants of the Second Security Instrument or to take actions to preserve the value of the Property, even though Lender may be unable to collect amounts owed under the Note: because of restrictions in this Paragraph 13.

14. Forbearance by Lender Not a Waiver. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver

of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.

15. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender. An assignment made in accordance with the regulations of the Secretary shall fully relieve the Lender of its obligations under this Security Instrument. Bourgewer may not assign any rights or obligations under this Security Instrument or under the Note, except to a trust that meets the requirements of the Secretary. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several.

16. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first clas; mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address all Borrowers jointly designate. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have

been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.

17. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by Federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.

18. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of this Security Instrument.

19. Assignment of Rents. Borrower unconditionally assigns and transfers to Lender all the rents and revenues of the Property. Borrower authorizes Lender or Lender's agents to collect the rents and revenues and hereby directs each tenant of the Property to pay the rents to Lender or Lender's agents. However, prior to Lender's Notice to Borrower of Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in the Security Instrument, Borrower shall collect and receive all rents and revenues of the Property as trustee for the benefit of Lender and Borrower. This assignment of rents constitutes an absolute assignment and not an assignment for additional security only.

If Lender gives notice of breach to Borrower: (a) all rents received by Borrower shall be held by Borrower as trustee for benefit of Lender only, to be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument; (b) Lender shall be entitled to collect and receive all of the rents of the Property; and (c) each tenant of the Property shall pay all rents due and unpaid to Lender or Lender's agent on

Lender's written demand to the tenant.

Borrower has not executed any prior assignment of the rents and has not and will not perform any act that would prevent Lender from exercising its rights under this Paragraph 19.

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Lender shall not be required to enter upon, take control of or maintain the Property before or after giving notice of breach to Borrower. However, Lender or a judicially appointed receiver may do so at any time there is a breach. Any application of rents shall not cure or waive any default or invalidate any other right or remedy of Lender. This assignment of rents of the Property shall terminate when the debt secured by this Security Instrument is paid in full. 20. Foreclosure Procedure. If Lender requires immediate payment in full under Paragraph 9, Lender may foreclose this Security Instrument by judicial proceeding. Lender shall be entitled to collect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this Paragraph 20, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of title evidence. 21. Adjustable Rate Feature. Under the Note, the initial stated interest rate of 8.8100% which accrues on the unpaid principal balance ("Initial Interest Rate") is subject to change, as described below. When the interest rate changes, the new adjusted interest rate will be applied to the total outstanding principal balance. Each adjustment to the interest rate will be based upon the weekly average yield on United States Treasury Securities adjusted to a constant maturity of one year ("Index") plus a margin. The Index is published in the Federal Reserve Bulletin and made available by the United States Treasury Department in Statistical Release H. 15 (519). If the Index is no longer available, Lender will be required to use any index prescribed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The new index will have an historical movement substantially similar to the original index, and the new index and margin will result in an annual percentage rate that is substantially similar to the rate in effect at the time the original index becomes unavailable. Lender will perform the calculations described below to determine the new adjusted interest rate. The interest rate may change , and on 🔯 that day of each succeeding year 🛘 the first day of each on the first day of February, 1996 succeeding month ("Change Date") until the loan is repaid in fuil. The value of the Index will be determined, using the most recent Index figure available thirty (30) days before the Change Date ("Current Index"). Before each Change Date, is new interest rate will be calculated by adding a margin to the Current Index. The sum of the margin plus the Current Index will be called the "Calculated Interest Rate" for each Change Date. The Calculated Interest Rate will be compared to the interest rate in effect immediately prior to the current Change Date (the "Existing Interest Rate"). At any change date, if the Calculated interest Rate equals the Existing Interest Rate, the interest rate will not change. 22. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall release this Security Instrument without charge to Borrower. Borrower shall pay any recordation costs. 23. Waiver of Homestead. Borrower waives all right of homestead exemption in the Property. 24. Riders to this Security Instrument. If one or more riders are executed by Borrower and recorded together with this Security Instrument, the covenants of each such rider shall be incorporated into and shall ain and and supplement the covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument as if the rider(s) were in a part of this Security Instrument.
