§ 202.1. § 203. Exemption from Filing Fees. The Director shall not be required pay any fee to any public officer for filing, recording or in any manifestating any paper or instrument relating to any proceeding underginarticle, nor for services rendered by any public officer for serving process; but such fees and costs may be taxed as costs against the defending in the suit by order of the court and paid to such public officer.
