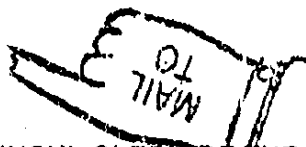

### 5/202.1. Advisory Committee

§ 202.1. The Director may, with the approval of the court, appoint an Advisory Committee, consisting of policyholders, claimants, or other persons, including Guaranty Funds and Guaranty Associations, should the Director deem it necessary to the proper performance of his responsibilities under this Article and Article XIII½. The Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the Director and shall serve without compensation other than reimbursement for travel and per diem living expenses incurred in attending committee meetings. No other committees of any nature shall be appointed by the Director or the court in any proceeding conducted under this Article and Article XIII½.

### 5/203. Exemption from filing fees

§ 203. Exemption from Filing Fees. The Director shall not be required to pay any fee to any public officer for filing, recording or in any manner authenticating any paper or instrument relating to any proceeding under this article, nor for services rendered by any public officer for serving in the process; but such fees and costs may be taxed as costs against the defendant in the suit by order of the court and paid to such public officer.

### 5/204. Prohibited and voidable transfers and liens

§ 204. Prohibited and Voidable Transfers and Liens. (1) No company shall make any transfer of or create any lien upon any of its property with intent of giving to or enabling any creditor or policyholder to obtain a greater percentage of his debt than any other creditor of the same class.

(2) Any transfer of, or lien upon, any property of any company made or created within four months prior to the filing of a complaint under this article, which gives to any creditor or policyholder or enables him to obtain a greater percentage of his debt than any other creditor or policyholder, is
