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NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the debt evidenced by the Note and to secure the payment of said principal num of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this Mortgage, and of the Note becared hereby (collectively, the Note, thin Mortgage and all other documents executed in connection therewith are referred to herein as the "boan Documents"), including any and all extensions, modifications and renewals of the foregoing indebtedmens, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein and in the Note contained, by Mortgagor to be performed, and any other indebtedness or liability of Mortgagor to Mortgagee, whether direct or indirect, joint or several absolute or contingent, now or hereafter exinting however created or arluing and however evidenced and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) in a nd paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Mortgagor doca by those presents GRANT, MORTGAGE and CONVEY unto the Mortgagee, i's successors and assigns, the following:

- (a) All that certain described real estate and all of Its estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the City of Catago, County of Cook, State of Illinois, which is more specifically described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to herein as the "Premises";
- (b) All improvements, tenements, casements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and ducing all such times as Mortgagor may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily);
- (c) If and to the extent owned by Mortgagor, all fixtures, fittings, furnishings, appliances, apparatus, equipment and machinery including, without limitation, all gas and electric fixtures, radiators, heaters, engines and machinery, boilers, ranges, ovens, elevators and motors, bathtubs, sinks, water closets, basins, pipes, faucets and other air-conditioning, plumbing and heating fixtures, mirrors, mantles, reinigerating plants, refrigerators, iceboxes, dishwashers, carpeting furniture, laundry equipment, cooking apparatus and appurtenances, and all building material, supplies and equipment now or hereafter delivered to the Promises and intended to be installed therein; all other fixtures and personal property of whatever kind and nature at present contained in or hereafter placed in any building standing on said Premises; such other goods, equipment, chattels and personal property as are usually furnished by landlords in letting other premises of the character of the Preminen; and all renewals or replacements thereof or articles in substitution thereof; and all proceeds and profits thereof and all of the estate, right, title and interest of the

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Mortgagor in and to all property of any nature whatsoever, now or hereafter situated on the Premises or intended to be used in connection with the operation thereof;

- (d) All of the right, title and interest of Mortgagor in and to any fixtures or personal property subject to a lease agreement, conditional sale agreement, chattel mortgage, or security agreement, and all deposits made thereon or therefor, together with the benefit of any payments now or bereafter made thereon;
- (a) All leases and use agreements of machinery, equipment and other personal property of Mortgagor in the categories hereinabove set forth, under which Mortgagor is the lesses of, or entitled to use, such items;
- All rerts, income (including all revenues, receipts, income, accounts, accounts receivable and other receivables including, without limitation, revenues, receipts, income, receivables and accounts relating to or arising from rentals, rent equivalent income, income and profits from quest rooms, meeting rooms, food and beverage facilities, vending machines, telephone and television systems, guest laundry, the provision or wale of other goods and services, and any other items of revenue, receipts or other income as identified in the Uniform System of Accounts for Hotels, 8th Edition, International Association of Hospitality Accountants (1986), we from time to time amended), profits, revenues, receipts, royalties, bonuses, rights, accounts, contract rights, general isoengibles and benefits and guarantees under any and all leanes, terangies, licenses or other use agreements or arrangements now existing or hereafter created of the Premises or any part thereof (including any business conducted thereon) with the right to receive and apply the same & to indebtedness due Mortgagee and Mortgagee may demand, sue for and recover such payments but shall not be required to do so;
- (g) All judgments, awards of damages and settlements hereafter made as a result of or in lieu of any taking of the Premises of any part thereof or interest therein under the power of eminent domain, or for any damage (whether caused by such taking or otherwise) to the Premises or the improvements thereon or any part thereof or interest therein, including any award for change of grade of streets;
- (h) All proceeds of the conversion, voluntary or involuntary, of any of the foregoing into cash or liquidated claims;
- (i) Any monion on deposit with Mortgagee for the payment of real estate taxes or special associates against the Premises or for the payment of premises on policies of fire and other hazard

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insurance covering the collateral described hereunder or the Premises, and all proceeds paid for damage done to the collateral described hereunder or the Premises;

(j) All substitutions, replacements, additions and proceeds, including insurance and condemnation award proceeds, of any of the foregoing property; it being understood that the enumeration of any specific articles of property shall in so wise exclude or be held to exclude any items of property not specifically mentioned. All of the land, estate and property hereinabove described, real, personal and mixed, whether affixed or annexed or not (except where otherwise hereinabove specified) and all rights hereby conveyed and mortgaged are intended so to be as a wall and are hereby understood, agreed and declared to form a part and parcel of the real estate and to be appropriated to the use of the real estate, and shall be for the purposes of this Mortgage decmed to be real estate and conveyed and mortgaged hereby.

As to any of the property aforewald which (notwithstanding the aforemaid declaration and agreement) does not so form a part and parce) of the real artate, this Mortgage is hereby deemed to be, as well, a Security Agreement under the Uniform Commercial Code in effect in the jurisal tion in which the Premines are located (hereinafter referred to as the "UCC") for the purpose of creating hereby a security interest in such property, which Mortgager hereby grants to Mortgage as Secured Party (as said term is defined in the UCC), securing said indebtedness and obligations and Mortgagee shall have is addition to its rights and remedies hereunder all rights and remedies of a Secured Party under the UCC. As to above personal propercy which the UCC classifies as fixtures, this instrument shall constitute a fixture filing and financing statement under the UCC.

Mortgager covenants (i) that it is lawfully seized of the Premises, (ii) that the same are subject only to the liens, encumbrances, conditions, restrictions, casements, and other matters, rights or interests shown on Schedule B of the title policy delivered to Mortgagee in connection with the grant of this Mortgage, and (iii) that it has good right, full power and lawful authority to convey and mortgage the same and that it will warrant and forever defend said Premises and the quiet and peaceful possession of the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

As used in this Mortgage, the term "indebtedness" shall mean and include the principal sum evidenced by said Note, together with all interest and late charges thereon, any other payments due to the Mortgages thereunder, and all other sums at any time secured by this Mortgage. Further, as used in this Mortgage, the term "Note" shall mean and include any renewals, modifications, extensions, amendments and replacements thereof.

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TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Premisen unto Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever for the purposes and uses herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits Mortgagor does hereby expressly release and waive.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

Maintenance, Repair and Restoration of Improvements, Payment of Prior Liens, etc.

Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the Premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep said Premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanica' 10 pg or other liens or claims for lies not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof, other than any such liens which are being contested in a diligent and good faith manner by appropriate proceedings; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be recured by a fire or charge on the Premises superior to the lien hereof, and wook request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Mortgagee; (d) complete within a reasonable time in building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said Premises; (e) comply with all requirements of law, municipal ordinances, or restrictions of record with respect to the Premises and the use thereof; (f) make no alterations in said Premises; (3) suffer or permit no change in the general nature of the occupacy of the Premises, without Mortgagee's prior written consent; (1) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning variation or reclassification, without Mortgagee's prior written consent; (i) pay each item of indebtedness secured by this Mortgage when due according to the Lerms hereof or of said Note.

Payment of Taxes

2. Mortgagor shall pay, before any penalty attaches, all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the Premises when due, and shall, upon written request, firstsh to Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor.

Tax Deposits

3. Mortgagor covenants and agrees to deposit with Mortgagee at the office of Mortgagee set forth on the first page of this Mortgage, on a monthly basis until the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage is fully paid, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the last total annual taxes and general and/or special assessments (collectively, the "Taxes") for the last ascertainable year on said Premises (unless such Taxes are based upon assessments which exclude the improvements or any part

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thereof now constructed or to be constructed, in which event the amount of such deponits shall be based upon the Mortgagee's reasonable estimate as to the amount of Taxes to be levied and assessed). Such deposits shall be held without allowance for interest and shall be used for the payment of Taxes on said Premises next due and payable when they become due. If the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any of the Taxes for any year when the same shall become due and payable, Mortgagor shall, within 10 days after receipt of demand therefor, deposit such additional funds as may be necessary to pay the Taxes in full. If the funds so deposited exceed the amount required to pay the Taxes for the year, the excess shall be applied on a subsequent deposit of deposits. Said deposits need not be kept separate and apart from other funds of Mortgagee.

Anything in this Paragraph 3 to the contrary notwithstanding, if the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay the Taxes or any Installment thereof, Mortgagor will, not later than 30 days prior to the last day on which the same may be paid without penalty or Interest, deposit with Mortgagee the full amount of any such deficiency.

If any Taxes shall be levied, charged, assessed or imposed upon or for the Premises, or any portion thereof, and if such Taxes shall also be a levy, charge, assessment or imposition upon or for any other premises not govered by the lies of this Mortgage, then the computation of any amount to be deposited under this Paragraph 3 shall be based upon the entire amount of such Taxes, and Mortgagor shall not have the right to apportion the amount of any such taxes or assessments for the purpose of such computation.

Mortgagee's Interest In and Use of Deposits

In the event of a Default hereunder of the Note secured hereby, Mortgagee may at its option, without being required to do no, apply any monies at the time of deposit pursuant in Paragraphs 3 and 5 hereof, on any of Mortgagor's obligations herein or in said Note contained, in such order and manner as Mortgagee may elect. When the indebtedness secured herery has been fully paid, any remaining depoults shall be paid to Mortgagor or to the then owner of the Premises. A security interest within the meaning of the UCC is hereby granted to Mortgagee in and to any monies on deposit pursuant to Paragraphs 3 and 5 hereof, as additional security for the indebtedness hereunder and such monies shall be applied by Mortgagee for the purposes made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of Mortgagor; provided, however, that Mortgague shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes, annessments and insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgagor, while not in Default hereunder, shall have requested Mortgagee in writing to make application of such funds to the

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payment of the particular taxes, assessments and insurance premiums for payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums. Mortgagee shall not be liable for any act or omission taken in good talth or pursuant to the instruction of any party but shall be liable only for its gross negligence or willful misconduct.

Insurance

Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on the Premines inmured against loss or damage by policies of All Risk Replacement Cost Insurance with an Agreed Awount Endorsement and such other appropriate insurance as may be required by Mortgagee, all in form and aubatance satisfactory to Mortgagee, including, without limitation, rent insurance, by iness interruption insurance, flood insurance (if and when the Premises lie within an area designated by an agency of the federal government an a flood risk area) and war risk insurance whenever in the opinion of Mortgagee such protection is necessary and such wer rink insurance is obtainable from an agency of the United States Government. Mortgagor shall also provide liability insurance with such limits for personal injury and death and property dwage as Mortgagee may require. All policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be in forms, companies and amounts satisfactory to Mortgagee, each insurer to have a Best's rating of A+:XV, with mortgagee clauses attached to all policies in favor of and in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, including a provision requiring that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or materially modified without 30 days' prior written notice to Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to Mortgagee, and, in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not ices than 30 days prior to their respective dates of expiration Upon Mortgagor's failure to comply with the requirements of this Paragraph. Mortgagee may, in its sole discretion but without any obligations hereunder so to do, effect any insurance required hereunder and pay the premiums due therefor, and any amounts so pair by Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable by the Mortgagor with interest at the Default Rate as described in Paragraph 11, hereof, and shall be secured by this Mortgage.

Mortgagor shall not take out separate insurance concurrent in form or contributing in the event of loss with that required to be maintained hereunder unless Mortgagee is included thereon under a standard mortgagee clause acceptable to Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall immediately notify Mortgagee whenever any such separate insurance is taken out and shall promptly deliver to Mortgagee the policy or policies of such insurance.

Mortgagor covenants and agrees that Mortgagee may in its complete and sole discretion request that Mortgagor deposit on a

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monthly basis an amount equal to the premiums due on any such policies and that Mortgagee, beginning on the first day of the calendar month tollowing such request by Mortgagee and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter shall deposit with Mortgagee, an amount equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on such policies divided by the number of months to elapse prior to the date when such premiums become delinquent. No interest shall be payable on such deposits, and such deposits need not be kept in a separate account.

Adjustment of Losses With Insurer and Application of Proceeds of Insurance

 Au case of loss or damage by fire or other casualty, Mortgagee to authorized (a) to settle and adjust any claim under insurance policies which insure against such risks, or (b) to allow Mortgagor to agree with the innurance company or companion on the amount ic be paid in regard to much loss. In either case, Mortgagee is authorized to collect and innue a receipt for any auch insurance mone? At the option of Mortgagee, such insurance proceeds shall be applied either to reduce the indebtedness necured hereby or to reimburue Mortgagor for the cont of rebuild. ing and remtoration. Irrespective of whether such insurance proceeds are used to reimburs. Mortgagor for the cost of said rebuilding or restoration or not, and irrespective of whether such insurance proceeds are or are not adequate for such purpose, the buildings and improvements small be so restored or rebuilt so as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. If the cost of rebuilding, repairing or restoring the building and improvements can reasonably exceed the sum of \$25,000, then Mortgagee shall approve plans and specifications of such work before such work shall be commenced. In any case, where the assurance proceeds are used for rebuilding and restoration, such proceeds shall be disbursed in the manner and under the conditions that the Mortgagee may require and upon Mortgagee being furnished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with architect's certificates, walvers of lien, contractor's and subcontractors' sworn statements and other evidence of cost and payments so that Mortgagee can verify that the amounts disbursed from time to time are represented by completed and in place work and that said work is free and clear of mechanics' Lien claims. If the estimated cost of completion exceeds the amount of the innurance proceeds available, Mortgagor immediately shall, on written demand of Mortgagee, deponit with Mortgagee in cash the amount of such estimated excess cost. No payment made prior to the final completion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed from time to time, and at all times the undisbursed balance of such proceeds remaining in the hands of the disbursing party shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work free and clear of liens. Any surplus which may remain out of said

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insurance proceeds after payment of such cost of building or restoration shall, at the option of the Mortgages, be applied on account of the indebtedness secured hereby or be paid to any party entitled thereto without interest.

Stamp_Tax

7. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state having jurisdiction over the Mortgagor, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note hereby secured, the Mortgagor covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagor further covenants to reimburse the Mortgagos for any sums which Mortgages may expend by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the Note accured hereby.

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8. Mortgagor Kereby annignn to Mortgageo all of Mortgagor's interest in all regts, lumes and profits of the Property, as further security for the payment of the Note and other numn secured hereby. Mortgagor grants to Mortgagee the right to enter the Premises and to let the Premises, or any part thereof, and to apply said take, insues, profits and proceeds, after payment of all charges and expenses, on account of the Note and other sums secured hereby. This assignment and grant shall continue in effect until the Note and other sums secured hereby are paid in full. Mortgagee hereby agreen not to exercise the right to enter the Premines for the parpose of collecting said rents, issues or profits and Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and receive said rents, issues, profits and proceeds until the occurrence of a Default by Mortgagor under the terms and provisions hereof; provided that any rescan lesues and profits collected and received by Mortgagor after the occurrence of a default hereunder which is not cured within the applicable grace period provided hereby shall be deemed collected and received by Mortgagor in trust for Mortgagee and Mortgagor shall account to Mortgagee for the full amount of such receipts. Mortgagor agrees to apply said rents, issues and profits, whenever received, to payment of the Note and other numn accured hereby. The right of Mortgagor to collect and receive said renta, issues and profits in trust for Mortgagee during the continuance of any Default by Mortgagor under the terms and provisions of this Mortgage may be revoked by Mortgagee's giving written notice of such revocation to Mortgagor.

Mortgagor will, from time to time after notice and demand, execute and deliver to Mortgagee, in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, further agreements evidencing its willingness to comply and its compliance with the provisions of this Section. Mortgagor shall pay Mortgagee the expenses incurred by Mortgagee in connection with the recording of any such agreement.

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Effect of Extensions of Time

9. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof is extended or varied or if any part of any security for the payment of the indebtedness is released or additional security is taken, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said Premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation, or taking of additional security or release, and their liability and the lies and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee notwithstanding such extension, variation, taking of additional security or release.

Effect of Changes in Laws Regarding Taxation

10. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of the state or which the Premises are located deducting from the value of the Primises for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing apon the Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the temption of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the Mortgager's interest in the Premises, or the manner of collection of taxen, so as to affect this Mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the volders thereof, then, and in any event, the Mortgagor, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgageo may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagor, to declare a) i of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.

Mortgagee's Performance of Defaulted Acts

11. In the event of a Default hereunder, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgagor in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said Premises or consent to any tax or assessment or cure any default of landlord in any lease of the Premises. All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other monies advanced by Mortgagee in regard to any stamp tax or any leases of the Premises or to

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protect the Premises and the Lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the Default Rate. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a walver of any right accruing to it on account of any Default hereunder.

Mortgagee's Reliance on Tax Bills, Etc.

12. Mortgagee in making any payment hereby authorized: (a) relating to taxes and assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate produced from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lies or title or claim thereof; or (b) for the purchase, discharge, compromise or settlement of any other prior lies, may do so without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lies which may be asserted.

Financial Covenants

- 13. (a) Mortgago, shall maintain a Debt Service Ratio of at least 1.25 to 1.0 at all times while any portion of the indebtedness evidence 1 by the Note is uspaid. Debt Service Ratio shall mean an amount represented by a fraction, the numerator of which shall be an amount equal to the annual restal income of the Premises less annual normal operating expenses (including, but not limited to, expenses for heat, light, real estate taxes and maintenance of the Premises) and the denominator of which shall be the amount necessary to pay principal and interest under the Note for the year in which the amount represented by the numerator is calculated. In the year in which the entire principal becomes due under the Note, the amount of the final principal payment shall be disregarded for the purposes of the calculation described in this Paragraph 13(a).
- (b) On each anniversary of the date of the Note (or more frequently, if in the reasonable opinion of Mortgagee, Mortgagee requires the financial information specified in this subparagraph) while any portion of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note is outstanding, Mortgager shall provide Mortgagee with personal financial statements on forms reasonably to be prescribed by Mortgagee, for each maker of the Note and each person who has guaranteed the repayment of the Note and the performance of the Mortgage covenants contained herein.
- (c) Mortgagor shall provide Mortgagee with an annual operating statement (to be prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles consistent with the

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previous years operating statements) for the Premises, which assumed operating statement will indicate the total restal invoice for the Premises and the annual expenses therefor.

Acceleration of Indobtednoon in Case of Default

- 14. The occurrence of any one or more of the following shall constitute a default under this Mortgage (herein, a "Default"):
 - (a) default shall be made in the due and punctual promint of the Note secured hereby, or any payment due in accordance with the terms thereof, either of principal or interest; or
 - (b) default shall be made in the due observance or performance of any of the other covenants, agreements or conditions contained in the Note or any other Loan Document; or
 - (c) default shall be made in the due payment, observance or performance of any of the covenants and agreements or condition; contained in any other agreements or financing arrangements now existing or hereafter entered into between Mortgagor and/o; Mortgagor's beneficiary (the "Beneficiary") and Mortgagor; or
 - (d) Mortgagor, Beneficiary or any guarantor of the Note secured hereby (herein a "Grazantor") shall file a petition seeking relief under the Pederal Bankruptcy Code (11 U.S.C. 101 et seq.) or any similar law, state or federal, whether now or hereafter existing, or any asswer admitting insolvency or inability to par liss or their debts, or fail to obtain a vacation or stay of involuntary proceedings within 30 days; or
 - (e) an order for relief shall be entered in an involuntary case against the Mortgagor, Beneficiary or a Guarantor, or a trustee or a receiver shall be appointed for the Mortgagor, Beneficiary or a Guarantor, or for all of the property of Mortgagor or a Guarantor, or the major part thereof, in any involuntary proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction of the property of the Mortgagor, Beneficiary or a Guarantor, or the major part thereof, in any voluntary or involuntary proceeding for the reorganization, dissolution, liquidation or winding up of the Mortgagor, Beneficiary or a Guarantor and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacated or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within 30 days; or
