CORPORATE RESOLUTION (TEMPORARY EASEMENT)

WHEREAS, Squire's Sheltered Care Home of Oak Park, Inc.,

The tract of land 66 Feet wide lying between the West Line of Maple Avenue and the East Line of Harlem Avenue Blocks 5 and 12 in W.J. Wilson's Addition to Oak Park in the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 18, Township 39, Range 13 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Cook County, Illinois according to the plat thereof recorded November 16, 1886 in Book 24 of Plats, Page 30 as Document 773322 and being a portion of the land formerly included in Adams Street (now vacated).

Said Parcel described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest Corner of said tract; thence North 89 Degrees 27 Minutes 21 Seconds East (assumed) 10.00 Feet along the Northerly Line thereof; thence South 00 Degrees 47 Minutes 34 Seconds East 7.00 Feet; thence South 89 Degrees 27 Minutes 21 Seconds West 4.00 Feet; thence South 00 Degrees 47 Minutes 34 Seconds East 7.48 Feet; thence South 89 Degrees 12 Minutes 26 Seconds West 6.00 Feet to the Westerly Line of said tract, said Westerly Line being also the Easterly Right of Way Line of Harlem Avenue (Illinois Route 43); thence North 00 Degrees 47 Minutes 34 Seconds West 14.50 Feet along said Right of Way Line to said Point of Beginning, in Cook County, Illinois. Said Parcel contains 0.003 Acres or 115 Square Feet more or less.

This easement shall be in effects for a period of three (3) years from the date of execution or completion of construction operations, whichever occurs first.
