

WHEREAS, the Office of Thrift Supervision Department of the Treasury of the United States (the "OTS") by Order No. 89-460, dated December 7, 1989, appointed the Resolution Trust Corporation (the "RTC") as Receiver for City Federal Savings Bank ("Old City"). On December 7, 1989, RTC accepted such appointment and, by operation of law, thereupon succeeded to "all rights, titles, powers and privileges" of Old City pursuant to 12 U.S.C. Section 1821(d) (2) (A);

WHEREAS, effective December 7, 1989, the OTS, by Order No. 89-461, approved the chartering of a new federal mutual savings association in the name of City Savings Bank, F.S.B. ("Interim City");

WHEREAS, effective December 8, 1989, the RTC as Receiver for Old City entered into a Purchase and Assumption Agreement with the RTC as Conservator of Interim City pursuant to which the right, title and interest in and to substantially all of the assets of Old City, including real property, mortgages, deeds of trust and similar security instruments and loans, were transferred to Interim City pursuant to the authority granted to the RTC as Receiver for Old City to transfer any asset of Old City "without any approval, assignment or consent with respect to such transfer," pursuant to 12

WHEREAS, the OTS, by Order No. 89-462, dated December 7, 1989, appointed the RTC as Conservator for Interim City;

WHEREAS, on December 8, 1989, the RTC accepted such appointment;

WHEREAS, effective September 21, 1990, the OTS by Order No. 90-1763 replaced the RTC as Conservator with the RTC as Receiver for Interim City. On September 21, 1990, the RTC accepted such appointment and, by operation of law, thereupon succeeded to "all rights, titles, powers and privileges" of Interim City pursuant to 12 U.S.C. Section 1821 (d) (2) (A);

WHEREAS, the BTC, as Receiver for Interim City, immediately organized City Savings, F.S.B. ("New City") and caused it to be chartered as a federal savings association;

WHEREAS, on September 21, 1990, the RTC as Receiver for Interim City entered into a Purchase and Assumption Agreement with the RTC as Conservator for New City pursuant to which the right, title and interest in and to substantially all of the assets of Interim City, including real property, mortgages, deeds of trust and similar security instruments and loans, were transferred to New City pursuant to the authority granted to the RTC as Receiver for Interim City to transfer any asset of Interim City "without any approval, assignment or consent with the respect to such transfer," pursuant to 12 U.S.C. Section 1821 (d) (2) (G);

WHEREAS, the OTS, by Order No. 90-1766, dated September 21, 1990, appointed the RTC as Conservator for New City;

WHEREAS, On September 21, 1990, the RTC accepted such appointment;

WHEREAS, effective January 11, 1991, the OTS by Order No. 93-17 replaced the RTC as - Conservator with the RTC as Receiver of New City; and

NOW THEREFORE, the RTC as Receiver for City Savings, F.S.B. ("Assignor"), for an in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby sell, assign, grant, bargain, transfer and set over, without recourse, representation or warranty whatsoever, express or implied, to Great American Savings and Loan Association, F.A. ("Assignee"), its successor and assigns, all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the above Mortgage as of the 20th of September, 1994.
