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Credit Agreement. The maturity date of the obligations secured by this Mortgage is June 12, 2011. The interest rate under the Credit Agreement is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 8.250% per annum. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate 3.450 percentage points above the index, subject however to the following maximum rate. Under no circumstances shall the interest rate be more than the lesser of 19.800% per annum or the maximum rate allowed by applicable law.

Existing Indebtedness. The words "Existing Indebtedness" mean the indebtedness described below in the Existing Indebtedness section of this Mortgage.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means WILLIE B SMITH and THELMA J SMITH. The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage.

Indebtedness. Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall produce and miletain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsaments on a replacement best for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender.
