- 3. To comply with all requirements of federal, state and municipal laws and regulations, including those relating to all environmental governing the property and the use thereof; and to permit Mortgagee to inspect the property at all reasonable times.
- 4. To keep the property free from mechanics or other liens or claims for liens of any kind; to pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the property, and, upon request, to exhibit to Mortgagee satisfactory evidence of the payment and discharge of such liens or claims. The Mortgagor shall have the right to contest any lien or claim for liens in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois in a timely manner.
- 5. To pay, when due, all general and special taxes, all special assessments, water charges, drainage charges sewer service charges and other charges against the property, of any kind whatsoever, which may be levied, assessed, charged or imposed on the property, or any part thereof.
- 6. To exhibit to Mortgagee, at least annually and at any time upon request, official receipts showing full payment of all taxes, assessments and charges which Mortgagor is required to pay under.
 - 7. To execute an assignment of revis on said property of even date herewith.
- 8. To keep the property continuously lasured, until the indebtedness secured hereby is fully paid (or in case of foreclosure until a sale pursuant to a judgment of foreclosure) against loss or damage under such types of hazard and liability is surance and in such forms, amounts and companies as may be approved or reasonably required from time to time by Mortgagee; all policies whether or not required by the terms of this mortgage shall contain loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgagee (or, in case of foreclosure sale, in favor of the owner of the certificate of sale); in the event of loss, Mortgagor shall immediately notify Mortgagee in writing and Mortgagor hereby authorizes and directs each and every insurance company concerned to make payments for such loss jointly to Mortgagor and Mortgagee, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by Mortgagee, at its option, either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damagoo, and any application thereof to the indebtedness shall not relieve Mortgagor from making the payments herein required until the indebtedness is paid in full. Mortgagee may, from time to time, at its option, waive, and after any such waiver, reinstate, any or all provisions hereof requiring deposit of insurance policies, by notice to Mortgagor in writing.

To deliver to Mortgagee, all policies of insurance with evidence of premiums prepaid (renewal policies to be delivered not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration), and all abstracts of title, title guarantee policies, Torrens certificates of title and other evidence of title to the property, all of which shall be held by Mortgagee without liability, and in the event of foreclosure of this mortgage or transfer of title to the property in extinguishment of said indebtedness, shall become the absolute property of Mortgagee.

Mortgagee may from time to time at its option waive, and after any such waiver reinstate, any or all provisions hereof requiring deposits for taxes, assessments or insurance premiums, by notice to Mortgagor in writing. While any such waiver is in effect, Mortgagor shall pay taxes, assessments and insurance premiums as herein elsewhere provided.
- 11. Any awards of damage resulting from condemnation proceedings or the taking or injury of the property for public use, less reasonable costs and associated attorneys' fees and expenses of Mortgagor, shall be paid to hortgagee and the proceeds or any part thereof shall be applied by Mortgagee, at its option, after the payment of all of its expenses, including costs and attorneys' fees, to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured.
- 12. In the event of default in performance of any of Mortgagor's covenants or agreements herein contained, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagor, in any form and manner deemed expedient and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or any other lien, encumbrance, suit, title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting the purperty or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized an and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other noneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the property and the lien hereof shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon.

Mortgagee in making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments shall be the sole judge of the legality and validity thereof and of the amount necessary to be paid in satisfaction thereof.

13. If (a) default be made in payment, when due, of any sum secured hereby, or in any of the other covenants or agreements herein contained to be performed by Mortgagor; and said default is not cured within Fifteen (15) days after written notice to Borrower or, (b) if any proceedings be instituted or process issued (i) to enforce any other lien, charge, or encumbrance against the property, except for any such proceeding which Mortgagor is contesting in good faith or (ii) against Mortgagor under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws, or (iii) to place the property

or any part thereof in the custody or control of any court through its receiver or other officer, and such proceedings are not dismissed or stayed on appeal or such process withdrawn within ten days after written notice to Mortgagor; or (c) in the event the Mortgagor shall convey title to any person or persons other than the Mortgagor, or if a beneficial interest in Mortgagor be sold or transferred without Mortgagee's prior written consent, or (d) if Mortgagor makes any assignment for the benefit of creditors, or is declared a bankrupt, or, if by or with the consent or at the instance of Mortgagor, proceedings to extend the time of payment of the Note or to change the terms of this mortgage be instituted under any bankruptcy or insolvency law; then,

- 1. All sums secured hereby shall, at the option of Mortgagee, become immediately due and payable without notice, with interest thereon, and
- If Mortgagee may immediately foreclose this mortgage. The Court in which any proceeding is pending for that purpose may, at one or at any time thereafter, either before of after sale, and without regard to the solvency or insolvency of any person liable for payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and without regard to the then value of the property, appoint a receiver (the provisions for the appointment of a receiver and assignment of rents being an express condition upon which the loan hereby secured is made), for the benefit of Mortgagee, with power to collect the rents, issues and profits of the property, due and to become due during such foreclosure suit. The receiver, out of such rents, issues and profits when collected, may pay costs incurred in the management and operation of the property, prior and subordinate liens, if any, and taxes, assessments, water and other utilities and insurance, then are or thereafter accruing, and may make and pay for any necessary repairs to the property, and may pay all or any part of the indebtedness secured hereby or any deficiency decree, and Mortgagor hereby grants to Mortgagee the right, acting through itself, its agents or attorneys, either with or without process of law, forcibly or otherwise, to enter upon and take possession of the property, expel and remove any persona, goods or chattels, occupying or upon the same, and to collect or receive all the rents, issues and profits thereof, and to manage and control the same, and to leas; the same or any part thereof from time to time, and after deducting all reasonable artorizey's fees, and all expenses incurred in the protection, care, maintenance, management and operation of the property, apply the remaining net income upon the inderaginess secured hereby, or upon any deficiency decree entered by virtue of any sale held pursuant to a decree of foreclosure.
- 14. In any foreclosure of this Mortgage there shall be allowed and included in the decree for sale, to be paid out of the rents or proceeds of such sale:
 - (a) All principal and interest remaining unpaid and secured hereby;
 - (b) All other items advanced or paid by Mortgagee pursuant to this mortgage with interest;

- (c) All court costs, attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, expenditures for documentary and expert evidence, court reporters, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title guarantee policies, Torrens certificates and similar data with respect to title, as Mortgagee may deem necessary. All expenditures and expenses of the type mentioned in this subparagraph (c) shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon in connection with (i) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which Mortgagor shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant, or defendant, by reason of this Mortgage or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (ii) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (iii) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the property or the security arreof, whether or not actually commenced. - 22. Mortgagor will comply with each and every provision of said Construction Loan Agreement.
- 23. All provisions hereof shall inure to and bind the respective heirs, executore, administrators, successors, vendees and assigns of the parties hereto, and the word Mortgagor shall include all persons claiming under or through Mortgagor and all persons liable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the Note or this mortgage.
