MORTGAGE

Credit Agreement. The maturity date of the obligations secured by this Mortgage is June 22, 2011. The interest rate under the Credit Agreement is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 8.250% per annum. PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE.
