MORTGAGE (Participation)

This mortgage made and entered into this 157 day of 304, 1976 by and between Randolph-Racine Management, Inc. (be cinafter referred to as "Mortgagor"), and Illinois Small Business Growth Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Mortgagee"), who maintains an office and place of business at 511 West Capitol Avenue, Suite 102, Springfield, Illinois 62704-1968.

Said promissory note was given to secure a loan in which the Small Business Administration, an agency of the United States of America, has participated. In compliance with section 101.1(d) of the Rules and Regulations of the Small Business Administration [13 C.F.R. 101.1(d)], this instrument is to be construed and enforced in accordance with applicable Federal law.

The mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- a. He will promptly pay the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2 b. He will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, or frimpositions, for which provision has not been made hereinbefore, and will promptly deliver the official receipts therefor to the said mortgagee.
 - c. He will pay such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection and maintenance of said property, including the fees of any attorney employed by the mortgagee for the collection of any or all of the indebtedness hereby secured, or foreclosure by mortgagee's sale, or court proceedings, or in any other litigation or proceeding affecting said property. Attorney's fees reasonably incurred in any other way shall be paid by the mortgagor.
 - d. For better security of the indebtedness hereby secured, upon the request of the mortgagee, it successors or assigns, he shall execute and seriver a supplemental mortgage or mortgages covering any additions, improvements or betterments made to the property hereinancive described and all property acquired by it after the date hereof (all in form satisfactory to mortgagee).  - e. The rights created by this conveyance shall remain in full force and effect during any postponement or extension of the time of the payment of the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note or any part thereof secured hereby.
 - He will continuously maintain hazard insurance, of such type or types and in such amounts as the mortgagee may from time to time require on the improvements now or hereafter on said property, and will pay promptly when due any premiums thereof. All insurance shall be carried in companies acceptable to mortgagee and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the mortgagee. In event of loss, mortgagor will give immediate notice in writing to mortgagee, and mortgagee may make proof of loss if not made promptly by mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to mortgagee instead of to mortgagor and mortgagee jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by mortgagee at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or the restoration or repair of the property damaged or destroyed. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage, or other transfer of title to said property in extenguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title, and interest of the mortgagee, may be surrendered for a refund.
 - g. He will keep all buildings and other improvements on said property in good repair and condition; will permit, commit, or suffer no waste, impairment, deterioration of said property or any part thereof: in the event of failure of the mortgager to keep the building on said premises and those erected on said premises, or improvements thereof, in good repair, the mortgagee may make such repairs as in its discretion it may deem necessary for the proper preservation thereof; and the full amount of each and every such payment shall be immediately due and payable; and shall be secured by the lien of this mortgage.
