

WHEREAS, the Note has been issued under and subject to the provisions of a Construction Loan Agreement bearing even date herewith between Mortgagor, Mortgagor's beneficiary and Mortgagee (such Construction Loan  $A_{\rm B}$  reement being hereinafter referred to as the "Loan Agreement"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, to secure (i) the payment when and as due and payable of the principal of and interest on the Note or so much thereof as may be advanced from time to time under and pursuant to the Loan Agreemen!, (ii) the payment of all other indebtedness which this Mortgage by its terms secures, and (iii) the performance and observance of the covenants and agreement contained in this Mortgage, the Loan Agreement, the Note, the Environmental Indemnity Agreement by Mortgagor and Stephen J. Nardi for the benefit of Mortgage of even date here with (he "Environmental Indemnity Agreement") and all other instruments or documents security the Note (collectively, the "Loan Documents") (all of such indebtedness, obligations and liabilities identified in (i) (ii) and (iii) above being hereinafter referred to as the "indebtedness hereby secured"), the Mortgagor does hereby grant, sell, convey, mortgage and assign unto the Mortgage, its successors and assigns and does hereby grant to Mortgagee, its successors and assigns a security interest in all land singular the properties, rights, interests and privileges descried in Granting Clauses I, II III, IV, V, VI and VII below all of same being collectively referred to herein as the "Mortgaged Promises":

#### GRANTING SLAUSE I

That certain real estate lying and being in the County of DuPage and State of Illinois, more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto and n ade a part hereof.

#### GRANTING CLAUSE II

All buildings and improvements of every kind and description neretofore or hereafter erected or placed on the property described in Granting Clause I and all materials intended for construction, reconstruction, alteration and repair of the buildings and improvements now or hereafter erected thereon, all of which materials shall be deemed to be included within the premises immediately upon the delivery thereof to the said real estate, and, all fixtures, machinery, apparatus, equipment, fittings and articles of personal property of every kind and nature whatsoever now or hereafter attached to or contained in or used in connection with said real estate and the buildings and improvements now or hereafter located thereon and the operation, maintenance and protection thereof, including but not limited to, all machinery, motors, fittings, radiators, awnings, shades, screens, all gas, coal, steam, electric, oil and other heating, cooking, power and lighting apparatus and fixtures, all fire prevention and extinguishing equipment and apparatus, all cooling and ventilating apparatus and systems, all plumbing, incinerating, sprinkler equipment, all window and structural cleaning rigs and all other machinery and other equipment of every nature and fixtures and appurtenances thereto and all items of farniture, appliances,

draperies, carpets, other furnishings, equipment and personal property used or useful in the operation, maintenance and protection of the said real estate and the buildings and improvements now or hereafter located thereon and all renewals or replacements thereof or articles in substitution therefor, whether or not the same are or shall be attached to said buildings or improvements in any manner; it being mutually agreed, intended and declared that all the aforesaid property shall, so far as permitted by law, be deemed to form a part and parcel of the real estate and for the purpose of this Mortgage to be real estate and covered by this Mortgage; and as to the balance of the property aforesaid, this Mortgage is hereby deemed to be as well a Security Agreement under the provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code for the purpose of creating bareby a security interest in said property, which is hereby granted by Mortgagor as debtor to Mortgagee as secured party, securing the indebtedness hereby secured. The addresses of Mortgagor (debtor) and Mortgagee (secured party) appear at the beginning hereof.

#### **GRANTING CLAUSE III**

All right, title and interest of Mortgagor now owned or bereafter acquired in and to all and singular the estates, tenements hereditament, privileges, easements, licenses, franchises, appurtenances and royalties, mineral ol and water rights belonging or in any wise appertaining to the property described in the preceding Cranting Clause I and the buildings and improvements now or hereafter located hereon and the reversions, rents, issues, revenues and profits thereof, including all interest of Mortgagor in all rents, issues and profits of the aforementioned property and all rents, issues, profits, revenues, royalties, bonuses, rights and benefits due, payable or accruing (including all deposits of money as advance leat or for security) under any and all leases and renewals thereof or under any contracts or options for the sale of all or any part of said property (including during any period allowed by law for the redemption of said property after any foreclosure or other sale), together with the right, but not the obligation, to collect, receive and receipt for all such rents and other sums and apply them to the indebtedness hereby secured and to demand, sue for and recover the same when due or payable; provided that the assignments made hereby shall not impair or diminish the obligations of Mortgagor under the provisions of such leases or other agreements nor shall such obligations be imposed upon Mortgagee. By acceptance of this Mortgage, Mortgagee agrees that until an Event of Defact (as hereinafter defined) shall occur giving Mortgagee the right to foreclose this Mortgage, Mortgagor may collect, receive (but not more than thirty (30) days in advance) and enjoy such rents.

#### **GRANT CLAUSE IV**

All judgments, awards of damages, settlements and compensation resulting from condemnation proceedings or the taking of the property described in Granting Clause I or any part thereof or any building or other improvements now or at any time hereafter located thereon or any easement or other appurtenance thereto under the power of eminent domain, or any similar power or right (including any award from the United States Government at any time after the allowance

of the claim therefor, the ascertainment of the amount thereof and the issuance of the warrant for the payment thereof), whether permanent or temporary, or for any damage (whether caused by such taking or otherwise) to said property or any part thereof or improvements thereon or any part thereof, or to any rights appurtenant thereto, including severance and consequential damage, and any award for change of grade of streets (collectively "Condemnation Awards").

#### **GRANTING CLAUSE V**

All property and rights, if any, which are by the express provisions on this instrument required to be subjected to the lien hereof and any additional property and rights that may from time to time hereafter by installation or writing of any kind, be subjected to the lien hereof.

#### **GRANTING CLAUSE VI**

All rights in and to common areas and access roads on adjacent properties heretofore or hereafter granted to Mortgagor and any after-acquired title or reversion in and to the beds of any ways, roads, streets, avenues and alleys adjoining the property described in Granting Clause I or any part thereof.

#### GRANTING CLAUSE VII

All of the Mortgagor's "general intangibles" (as defined in the Uniform Commercial Code) now owned or hereafter acquired and related to the Mortgagod Premises, including, without limitation, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to: (i) all agreements, leases, licenses and contracts to which the Mortgagor is or may become a party relating to the Mortgagod Premises or improvements thereon; (ii) all obligations or indebtedness awing to the Mortgagor (other than accounts) or other rights to receive payments of money from whatever source relating to the Mortgaged Premises; (iii) all tax refunds and tax refund claims relating to the Mortgaged Premises; (iv) all intellectual property relating to the Mortgaged Premises; and (v) all choses in action and causes of action relating to the Mortgaged Premises.

All of Mortgagor's "accounts" (as defined in the Uniform Commercial Code) now owned or hereafter created or acquired as relates to the Mortgaged Premises including, without limitation, all of the following now owned or hereafter created or acquired by Mortgagor: (i) accounts receivable, contract rights, book debts, notes, drafts, and other obligations or indebtedness owing to the Mortgagor arising from the sale, lease or exchange of goods or other property and/or the Performance of services, (ii) the Mortgagor's rights in, to and under all purchase orders or goods, services or other property, (iii) the Mortgagor's rights to any goods, services or other property represented by any of the foregoing, (iv) monies due to or to become due to the Mortgagor under all contracts for the sale, lease or exchange of goods or other property

and/or the performance of services including the right to payment of any interest or finance charges in respect thereto (whether or not yet earned by performance on the part of the Mortgagor), (v) uncertified securities, and (vi) proceeds of any of the foregoing and all collateral security and guaranties of any kind given by any person or entity with respect to any of the foregoing. All warranties, guarantees, permits and licenses received by Mortgagor in respect to the Mortgaged Premises.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Mortgaged Premises and the properties, rights and privileges hereby granted, bargained, sold, conveyed, mortgaged, pledged and assigned, and in which a courity interest is granted, unto Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever; provided, however, that this instrument is upon the express condition that if the principal of and interest on the Note shall be paid in full and all other indebtedness hereby secured shall be fully paid and performed and any commitment to advance funds contained in the Loan Agreement shall have been terminated, from this instrument and the estate and rights hereby granted shall cease, determine and be void and this instrument shall be released by Mortgagee upon the written request and at the expense of Mortgagor, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

Mortgagor hereby covenants and agrees with Mortgagee as follows:

- 1. Payment of the Indebtedness. The indebtedness hereby secured will be promptly paid as and when the same becomes due.
- Representation of Title and Further Assurances. Mortgagor will execute and 2. deliver such further instruments and do such further acts as may be reasonably necessary or proper to carry out more effectively the purposes of this instrument and, without limiting the foregoing, to make subject to the lien hereof any property agreed to be subjected hereto or covered by the Granting Clauses hereof or intended so to be. At the time of delivery of these presents, the Mortgagor is well seized of an indefeasible estate in fee simple in the portion of the Mortgaged Premises which constitutes real property subject only to me matters set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof (the "Permitted Exceptions"), and Mortgagor has good right, full power and lawful authority to convey, mor gage and create a security interest in the same, in the manner and form aforesaid; except as set forto in Exhibit B hereto, the same is free and clear of all liens, charges, easements, covenants, conditions, restrictions and encumbrances whatsoever, including the personal property and fixtures (security agreements, conditional sales contracts and anything of a similar nature, and the Mortgagor shall and will forever defend the title to the Mortgaged Premises against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
- Mortgage Constitutes Construction Mortgage. This Mortgage, in part, secures an obligation for the construction of improvements on the real property herein described, and constitutes a construction mortgage for the purpose of Article Nine of the Uniform Commercial Code of Illinois and is entitled to all of the benefits afforded construction mortgages thereunder.

- 4. <u>Compliance with Loan Agreement</u>. Mortgagor will abide by and comply with and be governed and restricted by all of the terms, covenants, provisions, restrictions and agreements contained in the Loan Agreement, and in each and every supplement thereto or amendment thereof which may at any time or from time to time be executed and delivered by the parties thereto or their successors and assigns.
- Provisions of Loan Agreement. The proceeds of the Note are to be disbursed by 5. the Mortgagee in accordance with the terms contained in the Loan Agreement, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference to the same extent as if fully set forth herein. Mortgagor covenants that any and all monetary disbursements made in accord with the Loan Agreement shall constitute adequate consideration to Mortgagor for the enforcability of this Mortgage and the Note, and that all advances and indebtedness arising and accruing under the Loan Agreement from time to time, whether or not the total amount thereof may exceed the face amount of the Note, so all be secured by this Mortgage; provided, however, that the total indebtedness secured by the Note and any other document or instrument now or hereafter given as security for the indebtedness bereby secured shall not in any event exceed \$10,000,000.00. Upon the occurrence of an Event of Default under the Loan Agreement, the Mortgagee may (but need not): (i) declare the entire principal indebtedness and interest thereon due and payable and pursue all other remedies conferred upon Mortgagee by this Mortgage or by law upon a default; or (ii) complete the construction of the improvements described in the Loan Agreement and enter into the necessary contracts therefor. All monies so expended shall be so much additional indebtedness secured by this Mortgage and shall be payable on demand with interest at the Default Interest Rate (as defined in the Note). Mortgagee may exercise either or both of the aforesaid remedies. The provisions, rights, powers and remedies contained in the Loan Agreement are in addition to, and not in substitution for, those contained herein.
- taxes and all special taxes, special assessments, water, drainage and sewer charges and all other charges, of any kind whatsoever, ordinary or extraordinary, which may be levied, assessed, imposed or charged on or against the Mortgaged Premises or any part hereof and which, if unpaid, might by law become a lien or charge upon the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof, and shall exhibit to Mortgagee official receipts evidencing such payments, except that, unless and until foreclosure, distraint, sale or other similar proceedings shall have been commenced, no such charge or claim need be paid if being contested (except to the extent any full or partial gayment shall be required by law), after notice to Mortgagee, by appropriate proceedings which shall operate to prevent the collection thereof or the sale or forfeiture of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof to satisfy the same, conducted in good faith and with due diligence and if Mortgagor shall have furnished such security, if any, as may be required in the proceedings or required by Mortgagee's title insurer to insure over the lien of such taxes.
- 7. Payment of Taxes on Note, Mortgage or Interest of Mortgagee. Mortgagor agrees that if any tax, assessment or imposition upon this Mortgage or the indebtedness hereby secured or the Note or the interest of Mortgagee in the Mortgaged Premises or upon Mortgagee by reason

of any of the foregoing (including, without limitation, corporate privilege, franchise and excise taxes, but excepting therefrom any income tax on interest payments on the principal portion of the indebtedness hereby secured imposed by the United States or any State) is levied, assessed or charged, then, unless all such taxes are paid by Mortgagor to, for or on behalf of Mortgagee as they become due and payable (which Mortgagor agrees to do upon demand of Mortgagee, to the extent permitted by law), or Mortgagee is reimbursed for any such sum advanced by Mortgagee, all sums hereby secured shall become immediately due and payable, at the option of Mortgagee upon thirty (30) days notice to Mortgagor, notwithstanding anything contained herein or in any law heretofore or hereafter enacted, including any provision thereof forbidding Mortgagor from making any such payment. Mortgagor agrees to provide to Mortgagee, upon request, official receipts showing payment of all taxes and charges which Mortgagor is required to pay hereunder.

Tao sud Insurance Deposits. Upon Mortgagee's request, Mortgagor covenants and 8. agrees to deposit with Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage is fully paid, a sum equal to (i) one-twelfth (1/12th) of the annual taxes and assessments (general and special) on the Mortgaged Premises (unless said taxes are based upon assessments which exclude improvements thereon now constructed or to be constructed, in which event the amount of such deposits shall be based upon Mortgagee's reasonable estimate as: the amount of taxes and assessments to be levied and assessed), and (ii) one-twelfth (1/12th) or the annual premiums payable for the insurance required to be maintained in accordance with Paragraph 11 hereof. If prior deposits are institutient, immediately following an Event of Default (as hereinafter defined), Mortgagor shall deposit with Mortgagee an amount of money which, together with the aggregate of the monthly deposits made or to be made pursuant to (i) above as of one month prior to the date on which the total annual taxes and assessments for the current calendar year become due, shall be sufficient to pay in full the total annual taxes and assessments estimated by Mortgagee to become due and payable with respect to the Mortgaged Premises for the current calendar year, and an amount of money which, together with the aggregate deposits made or to be made pursuant to (ii) above as of one month prior to the date on which the next annual insurance premium becomes due, shall be sufficient to pay in fui the total annual insurance premium estimated by Mortgagee to next become due and payable with respect to the Mortgaged Premises. Such deposits are to be held without any allowance of interest and are to be used for the payment of taxes and assessments (general and special) and insurance premiums respectively, on the Mortgaged Premises next due and payable when they become due. Mortgagee may, at its option, itself pay such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums when the same become due and payable (upon submission of appropriate bills therefor from Mortgagor) or shall release sufficient funds to Mortgagor for payment of such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums. If the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any such taxes, assessments (general or special and premiums for any year when the same shall become due and payable, Mortgagor shall within ten (10) days after receipt of demand therefor, deposit additional funds as may be necessary to pay such taxes, assessments (general and special) and premiums in full. If the funds so deposited exceed the amount required to pay such taxes, assessments (general and special) and premiums for any year, the excess shall be applied on a subsequent deposit or deposits. Said deposits need not be kept separate and apart from any other funds of Mortgagee.

- Mortgagee's Interest In and Use of Deposits. Upon the occurrence of an Event of 9. Default under this Mortgage, the Note, the Loan Agreement or any other document securing the Not:, the Mortgagee may at its option, without being required so to do, apply any monies at the tiral on deposit pursuant to Paragraph 8 hereof to the performance of any of Mortgagor's obligations hereunder or under the Note or Loan Agreement, in such order and manner as Mo tgages may elect. When the indebtedness secured hereby has been fully paid, any remaining deposits shall be paid to Mortgagor. Such deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the indebtedness hereunder and shall be irrevocably applied by Mortgagee for the purposes for which made hereunder shall not be subject to the direction or control of Mortgagor; provided, however, that Mortgagee shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes, assessments and insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgagor, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested Mortgagee in writing to make application of such funds to the payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums. Mortgagee shall not be liable for any act or omission taken in good faith or pursuant to the instruction of any party.
- Recordation and Payment of Taxes and Expenses Incident Thereto. Mortgagor will cause this Mortgage, all mortgages supplemental hereto and any financing statement or other not ces of a security interest required by Mortgagee at all times to be kept, recorded and filed at its own expense in such manner and in such places as may be required by law for the recording and filing or for the rerecording and refiling of a mortgage, security interest, assignment or other lien or charge upon the Mortgaged Premises, or any part thereof, in order fully to preserve and protect the rights of Mortgagee hereunder, and, without limiting the foregoing, Mortgagor will pay or reimburse Mortgagee for the payment of any and all taxes, fees or other charges incurred in connection with any such recordation or rerecordation, including any documentary stamp tax or tax imposed upon the privilege of having this instrument or any instrument issued pursuant hereto recorded.
- 11. <u>Insurance</u>. Mortgagor will, at its expense, maintain insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Loan Agreement. The proceeds of such insurance shall be applied as provided in Section 12 hereof. In the event of foreclosure, Mortgagor authorities and empowers Mortgagee to effect insurance upon the Mortgaged Premises in the amounts aforesaid, for a period covering the time of redemption from foreclosure sale provided by law, and if necessary therefor, to cancel any or all existing insurance policies.

#### 12. Damage to the Destruction of the Improvements.

(a) Notice. In the case of any material damage to or destruction of any improvements which are or will be constructed on the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof, Mortgagor shall promptly give notice thereof to mortgagee generally describing the nature and extent of such damage or destruction. Material damage shall mean damages in excess of \$50,000.00.

- (b) Restoration. Upon on the occurrence of any damage to or destruction or any improvements on the Mortgaged Premises, provided Mortgagee permits the proceeds of insurance to be used for repairs, Mortgagor shall cause same to be restored replaced or rebuilt as nearly as possible to their value, condition and character immediately prior to such damage or destruction. Such restoration, replacement or rebuilding shall be effected promptly and Mortgagor shall notify the Mortgagee if it appears that such restoration, replacement or rebuilding may unduly delay completion of such improvements. Any amounts required for repairs in excess of insurance proceeds shall be paid by Mortgagor.
- Application of Insurance Proceeds. Net insurance proceeds received by the Mortgagee under the provisions of this Mortgage or any instrument supplemental hereto or thereto or any policy or policies of insurance covering any improvements on the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereor single be applied by the Mortgagee at its option as and for a prepayment on the Note (whether or not the same is then due or otherwise adequately secured) or shall be disbursed for restoration of such ir provements (in which event the Mortgagee shall not be obligated to supervise restoration work nor shall the amount so released or used be deemed a payment of the inceptedness evidenced by the Note). Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions Mortgagee agrees that in the event of a casualty to the Mortgaged Premises, net insurance proceeds shall be made available for the restoration of the portion of the Mortgaged Premises dan aged or destroyed if written application for such use is made within thirty (30) days after receipt of such proceeds and the following conditions are satisfied: (i) no Event of Default, or event which if uncured within any applicable cure period, would constitute an Event of Default, shall have occurred and be continuing (and if such an event shall occur during restoration Mortgagee may, at its election, apply any insurance proceeds then remaining in its hands to the reduction of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note and the other indebtedness hereby secured), (ii) if the cost of repairs ex seeds \$50,000, Mortgagor shall have submitted to Mortgage's plans and specifications for the restoration which shall satisfy Mortgagee in its reasonable judgment that the Mortgaged Premises may be restored to their condition immediately prior to the casualty, (iii) Mortgagor shall have su mnitted to Mortgagee evidence satisfactory to Mortgagee (including, at Mortgagee's election, fixed price contracts with good and responsible contractors and materialmen covering all work and materials necessary to complete restoration), that the cost to complete restoration is not in excess of the amount of insurance proceeds available for restoration, or, if a deficiency shall exist, Mortgagor shall have deposited the amount of such deficiency with Mortgagee or otherwise assured Mortgagee, in its sole and absolute judgment, of Mortgagor's ability to pay such shortfall, (i) Mortgagor shall have obtained a waiver of the right of subrogation from any insurer under such policies of insurance, (v) in Mortgagee's judgment, all restoration can be completed prior to the due date of the Note, and (vi) no leases of the Mortgaged Premises are terminated as a result of such casualty or if a lease is terminated, such lease is not replaced with another lease (and tenant) satisfactory to Lender in its sole and complete discretion. In any case, where the insurance proceeds are used for rebuilding and restoration, such proceeds shall be disbursed in the manner and under the conditions that the Mortgagee may require and upon Mortgagee being firmished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with architect's certificates, waivers of lien, contractor's and subcontractors' sworn statements and

other evidence of cost and payments so that Mortgagee can verify that the amounts disbursed from time to time are represented by completed and in place work and that said work is free and clear of mechanic's lien claims which are not insured or bonded over to Lender's satisfaction. If the estimated cost of completion exceeds the amount of the insurance proceeds available, Mortgagor immediately shall, on written demand of Mortgagee, deposit with Mortgagee in cash the amount of such estimated excess cost. No payment made prior to the final completion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed from time to time, and at all times the undisbursed balance of such proceeds remaining in the hands of the disbursing party shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work free and clear of liens. Any surply's which may remain out of said insurance proceeds after payment of such cost of building or rectoration shall, at the option of the Mortgagee, be applied on account of the incebtedness leaved hereby or be paid to any party entitled thereto without interest. If Mertgagee elects to permit the use of insurance proceeds to restore such improvements pursuant to the terms hereof, it may do all necessary acts to accomplish that purpose including using funds de losited by Mortgagor with it for any purpose and advancing additional funds, all such additional fullds to constitute part of the indebtedness secured by the Mortgage. All necessary and reasonable title insurance charges and other costs and expenses paid to or for the account of Mortgagee in connection with the release of such insurance proceeds shall constitute so much ad litional indebtedness secured by thi. Mortgage to be payable upon demand and if not paid upon demand shall bear interest at the Delevi Interest Rate (as defined in Section 36 hereof). Mutgagee may deduct any such costs and expenses from insurance proceeds at any time held by Mortgagee. No interest shall be payable to Mortgagor upon insurance proceeds held by Mortgagee.

(d) Adjustment of Loss. Mortgagee is hereby authorized and empowered, at its option, to adjust or compromise any loss of more than \$50,000 under any insurance policies covering or relating to the Mortgaged Premises and to collect and receive the proceeds from any such policy or policies. Mortgagor hereby irrevocably appoints Mortgagee as its attorney-in-fact for the purposes set forth in the preceding sentence. Each insurance company a hereby authorized and directed to make payment (i) of 100% of all such losses of more than said amount directly to Mortgagee alone, and (ii) of 100% of all such losses of said amount or less directly to Mortgagor alone, and in no case to Mortgagor and Mortgagee jointly. After deducting from such insurance proceeds any expenses incurred by Mortgagee in the collection and settlement thereof including without limitation attorneys' and adjusters' fees and charges, Mortgagee shall apply the net proceeds as provided in Paragraph 12(c) hereof. Mortgagee shall not be responsible for any failure to collect any insurance proceeds due under the terms of any policy regardless of the cause of such failure.

#### 13. Eminent Domain.

(a) <u>Notice</u>. Mortgagor covenants and agrees that Mortgagor will give Mortgagee immediate notice of the actual or threatened commencement of any proceedings under condemnation or eminent domain affecting all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises including

any easement therein or appurtenance thereof or severance and consequential damage and change in grade of streets, and will deliver to Mortgagee copies of any and all papers served in connection with any such proceedings.

- heretofore or hereafter made or to be made to the present and all subsequent owners of the Mortgaged Premises by any governmental body for taking or affecting the whole or any part of said Mortgaged Premises, the improvements on the Mortgaged Premises or any easement therein or appurtenance thereto (including any award from the United States Government at any time after the allowance of the claim therefor, the ascertainment of the amount thereof and the issuance of the award for payment thereof) are hereby assigned by Mortgagor to Mortgagee to the extent of the existing principal balance, interest thereon and other outstanding charges owed by Mortgagor to Mortgagee and Mortgagor hereby irrevocably constitutes and appoints Mortgagee its true and lawful attorney in fact with full power of substitution for it and in its name, place and stead to collect and receive the proceeds of any such award gramed by virtue of any such taking and to give proper receipts and acceptances therefor. Mortgagee shall not settle any condemnation award with the condemning party without the consent of the Mortgagor. Mortgagor shall have the right to participate in any proceedings which determine the award to be granted.
- proceedings are commenced by any governmental body or other person to take or otherwise affect the Mortgaged Premises, the improvements thereon or any easement therein or appurtenance thereto. Mortgagee may, at its option, apply the proceeds of any award made in such proceedings as and for a prepayment on the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, notwithstanding the fact that said indebtedness may not then be due and payable or is otherwise adequately secured.
- 14. Construction, Repair, Waste, Etc. Except for the improvements on the Mortgaged Fremises to be constructed pursuant to the provisions of the Loca Agreement, Mortgagor c wenants and agrees (i) that no building or other improvement on the Mortgaged Premises and constituting a part thereof shall be materially altered, removed or denvelished nor shall any f xtures or appliances on, in or about said buildings or improvements be seveled, removed, sold or mortgaged, without the consent of Mortgagee; and in the event of the demolition of destruction in whole or in part of any of the fixtures, chattels or articles of personal property covered hereby, the same will be replaced promptly by similar fixtures, chattels and articles of personal property at least equal in quality and condition to those replaced, free from any security interest in or encumbrance thereon or reservation of title thereto; (ii) to permit, commit or suffer no waste, impairment or deterioration of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof; (iii) to keep and maintain said Mortgaged Premises and every part thereof in good and first class repair and condition (ordinary wear and tear excepted); (iv) to effect such repairs as Mortgagee may reasonably require and from time to time to make all needful and proper replacements and additions so that said buildings, fixtures, machinery and appurtenances will, at all times, be in good and first class condition, fit and proper for the respective purposes for which they were originally erected or installed; (v) to comply with all statutes, orders, requirements or decrees

relating to said Mortgaged Premises by any Federal, State or Municipal authority; (vi) to observe and comply with all conditions and requirements necessary to preserve and extend any and all rights, Licenses, permits (including, but not limited to, zoning variances, special exceptions and nonconforming uses), privileges, franchises and concessions which are applicable to the Mortgaged Premises or which have been granted to or contracted for by Mortgagor in connection with any existing or presently contemplated use of the Mortgaged Premises or any part hereof and not to initiate or acquiesce in any changes to or terminations of any of the foregoing or of zoning classifications affecting the use to which the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof may be put without the prior written consent of Mortgagee; and (vii) to make no alterations in or improvements or additions to the Mortgaged Premises without Mortgagee's written permission except as contemplated by the Loan Agreement or required by governmental authority.

- Lien and Encumbrances. Mortgagor will not, without the prior written consent 15. of Mortgagee, directly or indirectly, create or suffer to be created, or to remain, and will discharge or promptly cause to be discharged any mortgage, fien, encumbrance or charge on, pledge or conditional sale or other title retention agreement with respect to the Mortgaged Promises or any part thereof, whether superior or subordinate to the lien hereof, except for this instrument and the lien of all other documents given to secure the indebtedness hereby secured; provided, however, that Mortgagor may contest the validity of any mechanic's lien, charge or encumbrance (other than the lien of this Mortgage or of any other document securing payment of the Note) upon giving Mortgagee timely notice of its intention to contest the same and either (a) maintaining with Mortgagee a deposit of cash of negotiable securities satisfactory to Mortgagee in an amount sufficient in the opinion of Mortgagee to pay and discharge or to assure compliance with the matter under contest in the event of a final determination thereof adversely to Mortgagor, or (b) obtaining title insurance coverage over such lien on Mortgagee's title insurance policy by er dorsements acceptable to Mortgagee. Mortgagor agrees to prosecute and contest such lien difigently and by appropriate legal proceedings which will prevent the enforcement of the matter under contest and will not impair the lien of this Mortgage or interfere with the normal conduct of business on the Mortgaged Premises, on final disposition of such confust, any cash or securities in Mortgagee's possession not discharge or assure compliance with the matter returned to Mortgagor without interest.
- Right of Mortgagee to Perform Mortgagor's Covenants. Etc. If Mortgagor shall fail to make any payment or perform any made or performed hereunder, Mortgaget, without walving or releasing any obligation or default, may (but shall be under no obligation to) at any time thereafter upon prior written notice to Mortgagor and failure of Mortgagor to make such payment or perform such act within any applicable cure period provided herein make such payment or perform such act for the account and at the expense of Mortgagor, and may enter upon the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof for such purpose and take all such action thereon as, in the opinion of Mortgagee, may be necessary or appropriate therefor. All sums so paid by Mortgagee and all costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses) so incurred, together with interest thereon from the date of payment or incurrence at the Default Interest Rate, shall constitute so much additional indebtedness hereby secured and

shall be paid by Mortgagor to Mortgagee on demand. Mortgagee in making any payment authorized under this Section relating to taxes or assessments may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate produced from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lier or title or claim thereof.

- After-Acquired Property. Any and all property hereafter acquired which is of the kind or nature herein provided and related to the premises described in Granting Clause I hereof, or intended to be and become subject to the hereof, shall ipso facto, and without any further conveyance, assignment or act on the part of Mortgagor, become and be subject to the lien of this Mortgagor shall from time to time, if requested by Mortgagee, execute and deliver any and all such further assurances, conveyances and assignments as Mortgagee may reasonably require for the purpose of expressly and specifically subjecting to the lien of this Mortgage all such property.
- 18. <u>Inspection by Medgagee</u>. Mortgagee and its agents shall have the right to inspect the Mortgaged Premises at all reasonable times, and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 19. <u>Subrogation</u>. Mortgagor acknowledges and agrees that Mortgagee shall be subrogated to any lien discharged out of the proceeds of the loan evidenced by the Note or out of any advance by Mortgagee hereunder or under the Loan Agreement, irrespective of whether or not any such lien may have been released of record.

#### 20. Environmental Matters.

- (a) <u>Definitions:</u> As used herein, the following terms soul have the following meanings:
- (i) "Environmental Laws' means all federal, state and local statutes, laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, requirements, or rules of common aw, including but not limited to those listed or referred to in paragraph (b) below, any judic allocal administrative interpretations hereof, and any judicial and administrative consent decrees, orders or judgments, whether now existing or hereinafter promulgated, relating to public health and safety and protection of the environment.
- (ii) "Hazardous Material" means any above or underground storage tanks, flammables, explosives, accelerant, asbestos, radioactive materials, radon, urea formaldehyde foam insulation, lead-based paint, polychlorinated biphenyls, petroleum or petroleum based on related substances, hydrocarbons or like substances and their additives or constituents, methane, solid waste, refuse, garbage, construction debris, rubble, hazardous materials, hazardous wastes, toxic substances or related materials, and including, without limitation, substances now or hereafter defined as "hazardous substances," "hazardous materials," "toxic substances" or "hazardous wastes" in The

Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended (42 U.S.C. §9601, et. seq.), as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (P.L. 99-499, 42 U.S.C.), The Toxic Substance Control Act of 1976 as amended, (15 U.S.C. §2601 et. seq.), The Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. §6901, et. seq.), The Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, as amended (49 U.S.C. §1801, et. seq.), The Clean Water, as amended (33 U.S.C. §1251, et. seq.), The Clean Air Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. §7401 et. seq.), The Illinois Environmental Protection Act, as amended (415 ILCS 6/1 et. seq.), any so-called "Superfund" or "Superlien" law or any other applicable federal, state or local law, common law, code, rule, regulation, or ordinance, presently in effect or hereafter enacted, promutigated or implemented.

- (iii) "Environmental Liability" means any losses, liabilities, obligations, penalties, charges fees, claims, litigation demands, defenses, costs, judgments, suits, proceedings, response costs, damages (including consequential damages), disbursements or expenses of any kind or nature whatsoever (including attorneys' fees at trial and appellate levels and expenses, fees and disbursements and expenses incurred in investigating, defending against or prosecuting any litigation, claim or proceeding) which may at any time be imposed upor, incurred by or asserted or awarded against Mortgagee or any of Mortgagee's parent or subsidiary corporations, and their affiliates, shareholders, directors, officers, employees, and age at (collectively "Affiliates") in connection with or arising from:
  - (1) any Hazardous Material or, in, under or affecting all or any portion of the Mortgaged Premises, the groundwater, or any surrounding areas:
  - (2) any misrepresentation, inaccuracy or breach of any warranty, covenant and agreement contained or referred to in this Section;
  - (3) any violation or claim or violation by Mortgagor of any Environmental Laws:
  - (4) the imposition of any lien for damages caused by, or the recovery of any costs for, the cleanup, release or threatened release of Hazardous Materials;
  - (5) the costs of removal of any and all hazardous Materials from all or any portion of the Mortgaged Premises or any surrounding areas;
  - (6) costs incurred to comply, in connection with all or any portion of the Mortgaged Premises or any surrounding areas, with all Environmental Laws with respect to Hazardous Materials;

- (7) all civil penalties, damages, costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by reason of any violation of the Illinois Responsible Property Transfer Act, 765 ILCS 90/1 et seq. ("IRPTA"), including, but not limited to, the production and recording and filing of a disclosure document in connection with the execution and delivery of the Mortgage to Mortgagee or the transactions evidenced or secured by the Note, Loan Agreement and Mortgage.
- (b) <u>Representations and Warranties</u>. Mortgagor hereby represents and warrants to Mortgagee that to the best of Mortgagor's knowledge upon due inquiry:
  - Compliance. The Mortgaged Premises (including underlying groundwater and areas leased to tenants, if any), and the use and operation thereof, are currently in compliance with all applicable Environmental Laws. All required governmental permits and licenses are to effect, and Mortgagor is in compliance therewith. All Hazardous Material generated or handled on the Mortgaged Premises, if any, have been disposed of in a lawful manner.
  - (ii) Absence of Hazardous Material. Other than those Hazardous Material, set forth on Exhibit C attached hereto and made a part hereof, no generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, transportation of disposal of Hazardous Material has occurred nor is occurring on or from the Mortgaged Premises. No environmental or public health or safety hazards currently exist with respect to the Mortgaged Premises or the business or operations conducted thereon. No underground storage tanks (including petroleum storage tanks) are present on or under the Mortgaged Premises.
  - (iii) Proceedings and Actions. There are no bending or threatened: (a) actions or proceedings by any governmental agency or any other cotity regarding public health risks or the environmental condition of the Mortgaged Premises, or the disposal or presence of Hazardous Material, or regarding any Environmental Laws; or (b) liens or governmental actions, notices of violations, notices or noncompliance or other proceedings of any kind that could impair the value of the Mortgaged Premises, or the priority of this Mortgage lien or of any of the other documents or instruments now or hereafter given as security for the indebtedness hereby secured.
  - (iv) <u>Illinois Responsible Property Trans er Act</u>. The Mortgaged Premises is not "real property" within the meaning of Section 3(e) of IRPTA and the granting of this Mortgage does not require the delivery or recording of a disclosure document pursuant to IRPTA.
- Mortgagor's Covenants. Mortgagor hereby covenants and agrees with Mortgagee as follows:

- compliance. The Mortgaged Premises and the use and operation thereof shall comply with all Environmental Laws. All required governmental permits and licenses shall remain in effect, and Mortgagor shall comply therewith. All Hazardous Material present handled or generated on the Mortgaged Premises will be maintained or disposed in a lawful manner. Mortgagor will satisfy all requirements of applicable Environmental Laws for the maintenance and removal of all underground storage tanks on the Mortgaged Premises, if any without limiting the foregoing, all Hazardous Material shall be handled in compliance with all applicable Environmental Laws.
- (ii) Absence of Hazardous Material. No Hazardous Material shall be introduced to or handled on the Mortgaged Premises; provided, however, that (i) Hazardous Materials customarily used in the construction of buildings may be used at the Mortgaged Premises so long as the introduction, use and disposition thereof comply with all applicable Environmental Laws and the quantities thereof are normal for similar construction; and (ii) Hazardous Materials permitted to be stored by Associated Material Handling Associates, the existing tenant, under the terms of its lease, may be stored at the Project provided such material is at all times stored, handled and disposed of in full compliance with all Environmental Laws.
- (iii) Proceedings and Actions. Mortgagor shall immediately notify Mortgagee and provide copies upon receipt of a'r written complaints, claims, citations, demands, inquiries, reports or notices relating to the condition of the Mortgaged Premises or compliance with Environmental Laws. Mortgagor shall promptly cure and have dismissed any such actions and proceedings to the satisfaction of Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall keep the Mortgaged Premises free of any lien imposed pursuant to any Environmental Laws.
- (iv) Environmental Audit. Mortgagor shall provide such information and certification which Mortgagee may reasonably request from time to time to insure Mortgagor's compliance with this Section. To investigate Mortgagee's compliance with Environmental Laws and with this Section, Mortgagee shall be to the right, but no obligation, at any time when Mortgagee, in its reasonable judgment, dee its appropriate, to enter upon the Mortgaged Premises, take samples, review Mortgagor's books and records, interview Mortgagee's employees and officers, and conduct similar activities. Mortgagor shall cooperate in the conduct of such an audit.
- (d) Mortgagee's Right to Rely. Mortgagee is entitled to rely upon Mortgagor's representations and warranties contained in this Section despite any independent investigations by Mortgagee or its consultants. The Mortgagor shall take reasonable actions to determine for itself, and to remain aware of, the environmental condition of the Mortgaged Premises and shall have no right to rely upon any environmental investigations or findings made by Mortgagee or its consultants.

- Indemnification. Mortgagor agrees to indemnify, defend (at trial and appellate (e) levels and with counsel acceptable to Mortgagee and at Mortgagor's sole cost) and hold Mortgagee and its affiliates free and harmless from and against Mortgagee's Environmental Liability. The foregoing indemnity shall survive satisfaction of the loan evidenced by the Note and any transfer of the Mortgaged Premises to Mortgagee by voluntary transfer, foreclosure or by a deed in lieu of foreclosure. This indemnification shall not apply to any liability incurred by Mortgagee as a direct result of affirmative actions of Mortgagee as owner and operator of the Mortgaged Premises after Mortgagee has acquired title to the Mortgaged Premises and which actions are the sole and direct cause of damage resulting from the introduction and initial release of a Hazar coi's Material upon the Mortgaged Premises by Mortgagee; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, this indemnity shall otherwise remain in full force and effect, including, without limitation, with respect to Hazardous Materials which are discovered or released at the Mortgaged Premises after Mortgagee acquires tale to the Mortgaged Premises but which were introduced at the Mortgaged Premises prior to the ame of Mortgagee's taking title to the Mortgaged Premises, with respect to the continuing migration or release of Hazardous Materials previously introduced at or near the Mortgaged Premises and with respect to all substances which may be Hazardous Material and which are situated at the Mortgaged Premises prior to Mortgagee taking title but are removed by Mortgagee subsequent to such date except for any damages resulting from the gross negligence of Lender or its affiliates in such removal.
- (f) <u>Waiver</u>. Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, hereby waive, release and agree not to make any claim or bring any cost recover; action against Mortgagee under CERCLA or any state equivalent, or any similar law now existing or hereafter enacted. It is expressly understood and agreed that to the extent that Mortgagee is strictly liable under any Environmental Laws, Mortgagor's obligation to Mortgagee under this indemnity shall likewise be without regard to fault on the part of Mortgagor with respect to the violation or condition which results in liability to Mortgagee.
- (g) Interest. Any amount claimed hereunder by Mortgagee, not paid by Mortgagor within 30 days after written demand from Mortgagee with an explanation of the amounts claimed, shall bear interest at a rate per annum equal to the Default Interest Rate under the Note.

#### 21. Transfer of the Mortgaged Premises.

(a) In determining whether or not to make the loan secured hereby, Mortgagee has examined the credit-worthiness or Mortgagor, found it acceptable and relied and continues to rely upon same as the means of repayment of the loan. Mortgagor is well-experienced in borrowing money and owning and operating property such as the Mortgaged Premises, was ably represented by a licensed attorney at law in the negotiation and documentation of the loan secured hereby and bargained at arm's length and without duress of any kind for all of the terms and conditions of the loan, including this provision. Mortgagor recognizes that Mortgagee is entitled to keep its loan portfolio at current interest rates by either making new loans at such rate or collecting assumption fees and/or increasing the interest rate on a loan, the security for which is purchased by a party

other than the original Mortgagor. Mortgagor further recognizes that any secondary or junior financing placed upon the Mortgaged Premises (a) may divert funds which would otherwise be used to pay the Note secured hereby, (b) could result in acceleration and foreclosure by any such junior encumbrancer which would force Mortgagee to take measures and incur expenses to protect its security, (c) would detract from the value of the Mortgaged Premises should Mortgagee come into possession thereof with the intention of selling same; and (d) impair Mortgagee's right to accept a deed in lieu of foreclosure as a foreclosure by Mortgagee would be necessary to clear the title to the Mortgaged Premises. For purposes of this paragraph 21, "Mortgagor" shall include Mortgagor's beneficiary.

- (b) In accordance with the foregoing and for the purposes of (i) protecting Mortgagee's security, both of repayment by Mortgagor and in the value of the Mortgaged Premises; (ii) giving Mortgagee the full conefit of its bargain and contract with Mortgagor; (iii) allowing Mortgagee to raise the interest rate and/or collect assumption fees; and (iv) keeping the Mortgaged Premises free of subordinate financing liens, Mortgagor agrees that if this Paragraph be deemed a restraint on alienation, that it is a reasonable one, and Mortgagor shall not permit or suffer to occur any sale, lease, pledge, encumbrance or other transfer of, or the granting of any option in, or any contract for any of the foregoing (on an installment basis or otherwise) pertaining to:
  - (i) the Mortgaged Premises, any part thereof, or any interest therein or proceeds thereof: or
  - (ii) any interest in the beneficial interest under the title holding trust, or in any proceeds thereof.

whether involuntary or by operation of law or otherwise, without the prior written consent of Mortgagee having been obtained to such sale, assignment, conveyance, mortgage, lease, pledge, encumbrance or other transfer. Mortgagor agrees that in the event the ownership of the Mortgaged Premises or the Borrower or the beneficial interest therein, or any interest therein or any part thereof becomes vested in a person other than their current owners, Mortgagee may, without notice to Mortgagor, deal in any way with such successor or successors in interest with reference to this Mortgage, the Note, and any other document evidencing the indeptedness secured hereby, without in any way vitiating or discharging Mortgagor's liability hereunder or under any other document evidencing the indebtedness secured hereby. No sale of the Mortgaged Pemises, forbearance to any person with respect to this Mortgage, or extension to any person of the time for payment of the Note given by Mortgagee shall operate to release, discharge, modify, change or affect the liability of Mortgagor, either in whole or in part, except to the extent specifically agreed in writing by Mortgagee. Without limitation of the foregoing, in any event in which the written consent of Mortgagee is required in this Paragraph 21, Mortgagee may condition its consent upon any combination of (i) the payment of compensation to be determined by Mortgagee. (ii) the increase of the interest rate payable under the Note, (iii) the shortening of maturity of the Note, and (iv) other modifications of the terms of the Note or the other instruments evidencing the indebtedness secured hereby.

- (e) Without limitation of the foregoing, (i) in any event in which Mortgagee's consent is requested in accordance with the terms of this Paragraph 21, Mortgagor shall pay all expenses incurred by Mortgagee, including reasonable attorneys' Lees, in connection with the processing of such request, and (ii) the consent of Mortgagee to any transfer of the Mortgaged Premises shall not operate to release, discharge, modify, change or affect the liability of Mortgagor, either in whole or in part.
- 22. Events of Default. Any one or more of the following shall constitute an "Event of Default" hereunder:
  - Default in making payment when due (whether by lapse of time, acceleration, or otherwise) of the principal of or interest on any of the Note or any other indebtedness pereby secured within the time periods set forth in the Note;
    - (b) Ary violation of Sections 11 or 21 hereof;
    - (c) The Mortgaged Premises is abandoned by the Mortgagor;
  - (d) Default in the observance or performance of any other covenant, condition, agreement or provisions hereof or cothe Note or any additional collateral document which (i) is not provided for elsewhere in this Section 2, and (ii) is not remedied within thirty (30) days after written notice thereof to Mortgagor by Mortgagee; provided, however, that if such default cannot be cured within thirty (30) days, then, so long as Mortgagor promptly commences and diligently performs all actions necessary to cure such default, the period for effecting the cure thereof shall be extended for a period of sixty (60) additional days;
  - (e) Any representation or warranty made by the Mortgagor or any guarantor of the Note (a "Guarantor") herein or in the Note, Loan Agreement, Environmental Indemnity Agreement or any other Loan Document proves untrue in any material respect as of the date of the issuance or making thereof;
  - (f) Mortgagor or any Guarantor becomes insolvent or bankrupt or admits in writing his or their inability to pay its or their debts as they mature or makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors or applies for or consents to the appointment of a trustee, custodian or receiver for any of them or for the major part of the property of any of them;
  - (g) Mortgagor is unable to satisfy any condition of its right to the receipt of any advances under the Loan Agreement for a period in excess of thirty (30) days other than as a result of matters beyond its control;

- (h) Bankruptcy, reorganization, arrangement, insolvency or liquidation proceedings or other proceedings for relief under any bankruptcy laws or laws for the relief of debtors are instituted voluntarily by Mortgagor or a Guarantor; or any instituted involuntarily against Mortgagor or a Guarantor and are not dismissed within sixty (60) days after such institution;
- (i) Any judgment or judgments, writ or writs or warrant or warrants of attachment or any similar process or processes in an aggregate amount in excess of \$100.000.00 shall be entered or filed against Mortgagor, or against any property or assets, and remains unsatisfied, unvacated, unbonded or unstayed for a period of sixty (60) days;
- The title company refuses to issue the endorsements provided for in section 5.2 (a) (6) or 5.2 (a) (7) of the Loan Agreement because of a change in the state of the title or a survey exception and Mortgagor is unable to correct the condition giving rise to the refusal and procure issuance of the notice within thirty (30) days of notice of any such refusal given to Mortgagor by Mortgagee;
- (k) The death of a Guarantor unless such Guarantor's estate complies with the requirements of Section 10.1 (v.) of the Loan Agreement; or
- (l) Any Event of Default shall occur under the Loan Agreement or any other document evidencing or securing the indebtedness evidenced by the note (collectively the "Loan Documents").
- 23. Remedies. When any Event of Default has happened and is continuing (regardless of the pendency of any proceeding which has or might have the effect of preventing Mortgagor from complying with the terms of this instrument) and in addition to such other rights as may be available under applicable law or under the Loan Agreement, but subject at all times to any mandatory legal requirements:
  - (a) Acceleration. Mortgagee may, by written notice to Mortgagor, declare the Note and all unpaid indebtedness of Mortgagor hereby secured, including interest then accrued thereon, to be forthwith due and payable, whereupon the same shall become and be forthwith due and payable, without other notice or demand of any kind.
  - (b) <u>Uniform Commercial Code</u>. Mortgagee shall, with respect to any part of the Mortgaged Premises constituting property of the type in respect of which realization on a lien or security interest granted therein is governed by the Uniform Commercial Code, have all the rights, options and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of Illinois, including without limitation, the right to the possession of any such property or any part thereof, and the right to enter with legal process any premises where any such property may be found. Any requirement of said Code for reasonable notification shall be met by mailing written notice to Mortgagor at its address

above set forth at least ten (10) days prior to the sale or other event for which such notice is required. The expenses of retaking, selling and otherwise disposing of said property, including reasonable attorneys' fees and legal expenses incurred in connection therewith, shall constitute so much additional indebtedness hereby secured and shall be payable upon dernand with interest at the Default Interest Rate.

- Foreclosure. Mortgagee may proceed to protect and enforce the rights of (c) Mortgagee hereunder (i) by any action at law, suit in equity or other appropriate proceedings, whether for the specific performance of any agreement contained herein, or for 24 injunction against the violation of any of the terms hereof, or in aid of the exercise of any power granted hereby or by law, or (ii) by the foreclosure of this Mortgage. In any sui to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional incebtedrass bereby secured in the decree of sale, all expenditures and expenses authorized by the Illinois Mortgage Foreclosure Law, 735 ILCS 5/15-1101 et seq., as from time to time amended (the Act") and all other expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorney's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographer's charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to ilems to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title instrance policies, and similar data and assurance with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at sales which may be had pursuant to such decree the true conditions of the title to or the value of the mortgaged Premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature mentioned in this paragraph, and such other expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of the Mortgaged Premises and rents and income therefrom and the maintenance of the lien of this Mortgage, including the fees of any attorney employed by Mortgagee in any litigation or proceedings affecting this Mortgage, the Note or the Mortgaged premises, including bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparation of the commencement or defense of any proceedings or threatened suit or proceeding, or otherwise in dealing specifically therewith, shall be so much additional indebtedness hereby secured and shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, with interest thereon at the Default Interest Rate until paid.
- (d) Appointment of Receiver. Mortgagee shall, as a matter of right, without notice and without giving bond to Mortgagor or anyone claiming by, under or through it, and without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor or the then value of the Mortgaged Premises, be entitled to have a receiver appointed pursuant to the Act of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises and the rents, issues and profits thereof, with such power as the court making such appointment shall confer, and Mortgagor hereby consents to the appointment of such receiver and shall not oppose any such appointment. Any such receiver may, to the extent permitted under applicable law, without notice, enter upon and take possession of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof by force, summary proceedings, ejectment or otherwise, and may remove Mortgagor or other persons and any

and all property therefrom, and may hold, operate and manage the same and receive all earnings, income, rents, issues and proceeds accruing with respect thereto or any part thereof, whether during the pendency of any forcelosure or until any right of redemption shall expire or otherwise.

- (e) Taking Possession, Collecting Rents, Etc. Upon demand by Mortgagee, Mortgagor shall surrender to Mortgagee and Mortgagee may enter and take possession of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof personally, by its agent or attorneys or be placed in possession pursuant to court order as mortgagee in possession or receiver as provided in the Act, and Mortgagee, in its discretion, personally, by its agents or attorneys or pursuant to court order as mortgagee in possession or receiver as provided in the Act may enter upon and take and maintain possession of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises, regether with all documents, books, records, papers, and accounts of Mortgagor relating thereto, and may exclude Mortgagor and any agents and servants thereof wholly therefrom and may, on behalf of Mortgagor, or in its own name as Mortgagee and under the powers herein granter!:
  - Premises and conduct the business, if any, thereof, either personally or by its agents, with full power to use such measures, legal or equitable, as in its discretion may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the rents, issues, deposits, profits, and avails of the Mortgaged Premises, including without limitation actions for recovery of rent, actions in forcible detainer, and actions in distress for rent, all without notice to Mortgagor:
  - (ii) cancel or terminate any lease or sublease of all or any part of the Mortgaged premises for any cause or on any ground that would entitle Mortgagor to cancel the same:
  - (iii) elect to disaffirm any lease or sublease of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises made subsequent to this Mortgage without Mo tragee's prior written consent;
  - (iv) extend or modify any then existing leases and make new leases of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises, which extensions, modifications, and new leases may provide for terms to expire, or for options to lessees to extend or renew terms to expire, beyond the maturity date of the loan evidenced by the Note and the issuance of a deed or deeds to a purchaser or purchasers at a foreclosure sale, it being understood and agreed that any such leases, and the options or other such provisions to be contained therein, shall be binding upon Mortgagor, all persons whose interests in the Mortgaged Premises are subject to the lien hereof, and the purchaser or purchasers at any foreclosure sale, notwithstanding any redemption from sale, discharge of the indebtedness hereby secured, satisfaction of any

foreclosure decree, or issuance of any certificate of sale or deed to any such purchaser;

- (v) make all necessary or proper repairs, renewals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments, and improvements in connection with the Mortgaged Premises as may seem judicious to Mortgagee, to insure and reinsure the mortgaged Premises and all risks incidental to mortgagee's possession, operation and management thereof, and to receive all rents, issues, deposits, profits, and avails therefrom; and
- (vi) apply the net income, after allowing a reasonable fee for the collection thereof and for the management of the Mortgaged Premises, to the payment of taxes, premiums and other charges applicable to the Mortgaged Premises, or in reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured in such order and manner as Mortgagee shall select.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed as constituting Mortgagee a mortgagee in possession in the absence of the actual taking of possession of the Mortgaged Premises. The ...ght to enter and take possession of the Morraged Premises and use any personal property therein, to manage, operate, conserve and improve the same, and to collect the rents, issues and profits thereof, shall be in addition to all other rights or remedies of Mortgagee hereunder or afforded by law, and may be exercised concurrently there with or independently thereof. The expenses (including any receiver's fees, counsel fees, costs and agent's compensation) incurred pursuant to the powers herein contained shall be secured hereby which expenses Mortgagor promises to pay upon demand together with interest at the Default Interest Rate from the date incurred. Mortgagee shall not be liable to account to Mortgagor for any action taken pursuant hereto other than to account for any rents actually received by Mortgagee. Without taking possession of the Mortgaged Premises, Mortgagee may, in the event the Mortgaged Premises become vacant or are abandoned, take such steps as it deems appropriate to protect and secure the Mortgaged Premises (including hiring watchmen therefor) and all costs incurred in so doing shall constitute so much additional indebtedness hereby secured payable upon demand with interest the eor, from the date incurred at the Default Interest Rate

#### 24. Compliance with Illinois Mortgage Foreclosure Law.

- (a) In the event that any provision in this Mortgage shall be inconsistent with any provision of the Act the provisions of the Act shall take precedence over the provisions of this Mortgage, but shall not invalidate or render unenforceable any other provision of this Mortgage that can be construed in a manner consistent with the Act.
- (b) If any provision of this Mortgage shall grant to Mortgagee any rights or remedies upon default of the Mortgagor which are more limited than the rights that would otherwise be

vested in Mortgagee under the Act in the absence of said provision, Mortgagee shall be vested with the rights granted in the Act to the full extent permitted by law.

- (c) Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all expenses incurred by Mortgagee to the extent reimbursable under Sections 5/15-1510 and 5/15-1512 of the Act, whether incurred before or after any decree or judgment of foreclosure, and whether enumerated in Sections 23 (c) or 26 of this Mortgage, shall be added to the indebtedness secured by this mortgage or by the judgment of foreclosure.
- 25. Waiver of Right to Redeem: Waiver of Appraisement, Valuation, Etc., Mortgagor shall not and will not apply for or avail itself of any appraisement, valuation, stay, extension or exemption laws, or any so-called "Moratorium Laws," now existing or hereafter enacted in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement or foreclosure of this Mortgage, but hereby waives the benefit of such laws. Moregagor for itself and all who may claim through or under it waives any and all right to have the property and estates comprising the Mortgaged Premises marshaled upon any foreclosure of the lien hereof and agrees that any court having jurisdiction to foreclose such lien may order the Mortgaged Premises sold as an entirety. In the event of any sale made under or by virtue of this instrument, the whole of the Mortgaged Premises may be sold in one parcel as an entirety or in separate lots or parcels at the same or different times, all as the Mortgagee may determine. Mortgagee shall have the right to become the purchaser at any sale made under or by virtue of this instrument and Mortgagee so purchasing at any sale shall have the right to be credited upon the amount of the bid made therefor by Mortgagee with the amount payable to Mortgagee out of the net proceeds of such sale. In the event of any such sale, the Note and the other indebtedness hereby secured, if not previously due shall be and become immediately due and payable without demand or notice of any kind. Mortgagor acknowledges that the Mortgaged Premises does not constitute agricultural real estate, as defined in Section 5/15-1201 of the Act, or residential real estate, as defined in Section 5/15-1219 of the Act. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Mortgagor, pursuant to Section 5/15-1601 (b) of the Act, hereby voluntarily and knowingly waives any and all rights of redemption on behalf of Moregagor, and each and every person acquiring any interest in, or title to the Mortgaged Premises described herein subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, and on behalf of all other persons to the extent permitted by applicable law.
- 26. Costs and Expenses of Foreclosure. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographic charges, publication costs and costs which may be estimated as to items to be expended after the entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examination, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute any foreclosure action or to evidence to the bidder at any sale pursuant thereto the true condition of the title to or the value of the Mortgaged Premises, and all of which expenditures shall become so much additional indebtedness hereby secured which

Mortgagor agrees to pay and all of such shall be immediately due and payable with interest thereon from the date of expenditure until paid at the Default Interest Rate.

- 27. <u>Insurance After Foreclosure</u>. Wherever provision is made in the Mortgage or the Loan Agreement for insurance policies to bear mortgage clauses or other loss payable clauses or endorsements in favor of Mortgagee, or to confer authority upon Mortgagee to settle or participate in the settlement of losses under policies of insurance or to hold and disburse or otherwise control use of insurance proceeds, from and after the entry of judgment of foreclosure, all such rights and powers of the Mortgagee shall continue in the Mortgagee as judgment creditor or mortgagee until confirmation of sale. Upon confirmation of sale, Mortgagee shall be empowered to assign all policies of insurance to the purchaser at the sale.
- 28. Protective Advances. All advances, disbursements and expenditures made by Mortgagee before and during a foreclosure, and before and after judgment of foreclosure, and at any time prior to sale, and, where applicable, after sale, and during the pendency of any related proceedings, for the following purposes, in addition to those otherwise authorized by this Mortgage or by the Act (conscrively "Protective Advances"), shall have the benefit of all applicable provisions of the Act, including those provisions of the Act hereinbelow referred to:
  - (a) all advances by Mortgagee in accordance with the terms of this Mortgage to: (i) preserve or maintain, repair, restore or rebuild the improvements upon the Mortgaged Premises; (ii) preserve the lien of this Mortgage or the priority thereof; or (iii) enforce this Mortgage, as referred to it. Subsection (b) (5) of Section 5/15-1302 of the Act:
  - or other obligations in accordance with the terms of any senior mortgage or other prior lien or encumbrance; (ii) when due installments of real estate taxes and assessments, general and special and all other taxes and assessments of any kind or nature whatsoever which are assessed or imposed upon the mortgaged real estate (ii any part thereof; (iii) other obligations authorized by this Mortgage; or (iv) with court approval, any other amounts in connection with other liens, encumbrances or interests reasonably necessary to preserve the status of title, as referred to in Section 5/15-1505 of the Acc
  - (c) advances by Mortgagee in settlement or compromise of any claims asserted by claimants under senior mortgages or any other prior liens;
  - (d) attorneys' fees and other costs incurred: (i) in connection with the foreclosure of this Mortgage as referred to in Section 5/1504 (d) (2) and 5/15-1510 of the Act; (ii) in connection with any action, suit or proceeding brought by or against the Mortgagee for the enforcement of this Mortgage or arising from the interest of the Mortgagee hereunder; or (iii) in the preparation for the commencement or defense of any such foreclosure or other action;

- (e) Mortgagee's fees and costs, including attorneys' fees, arising between the entry of judgment of foreclosure an the confirmation hearing as referred to in Subsection (b) (1) of Section 5/15-1508 of the Act;
- (f) advances of any amount required to make up a deficiency in deposits for installments of taxes and assessments and insurance premiums as may be authorized by this Mortgage;
- (g) expenses deductible from proceeds of sale as referred to in Subsections (a) and (b) of Section 5/15-1512 of the Act;
- more of the following: (a) premiums for casualty and liability insurance paid by Mortgagee worther or no. Mortgagee or a receiver is in possession, if reasonably required, in reasonable amounts, and all renewals thereof, without regard to the limitation to maintaining of existing insurance in effect at the time any receiver or mortgagee takes possession of the mortgaged real estate imposed by Subsection (c) (1) of Section 5/15-1704 of the Act; (h) repair or restoration of damage or destruction in excess of available insurance proceeds or condemnation awards; (c) payments required or deemed by Mortgagee to be for the benefit of the Mortgaged Premises under any grant or declaration of easement, easement agreement, agreement with any adjoining land owners or instruments creating covenants or restrictions for the benefit of or affecting the mortgaged real estate; (d) shared or common expense assessments payable to any association or corporation in which the owner of the mortgaged real estate is a member in any way affecting the mortgaged real estate; (e) pursuant to any lease or other agreement for occupancy of the Mortgaged Premises.

All Protective Advances shall be so much additional indebtedness secured by this Mortgage, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon from the date of the advance until paid at the Default Interest Rate.

This mortgage shall be a lien for all Protective Advances as to subsequent perchasers and judgment creditors from the time this Mortgage is recorded pursuant to Subsection (i) (10) of Section 5/15-1302 of the Act.

All Protective Advances shall, except to the extent, if any, that any of the same is clearly contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of the Act, apply to and be included in:

- (i) determination of the amount of indebtedness secured by this Mortgage at any time:
- (ii) the indebtedness found due and owing to the Mortgagee in the judgment of foreclosure and any subsequent supplemental judgements, orders, adjudications or findings

- (iii) determination of amounts deductible from sale proceeds pursuant to Section 5/15-1512 of the Act;
- (iv) application of income in the hands of any receiver or Mortgagee in pessession; and
- (v) computation of any deficiency judgment pursuant to Subsections (b) (2) and (e) of Sections 5/15-1508 and Section 5/15-1511 of the Act.
- Premises or of any sale of property pursuant to Section 23(c) hereof shall be distributed in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure or other proceedings including all such items as are mentioned in Sections 23(b), 23(c) and 26 hereof; Second, to all other items which under the terms hereof constitute indebtedness he aby secured in addition to that evidenced by the Note with interest thereon as herein provided; Third, to all interest on the Note; Fourth, to all principal on the Note with any overplus to whomsoever shall be lawfully entitled to same.
- 30. Mortgagee's Remedies Cumulative No Waiver. No remedy or right of Mortgagee shall be exclusive but shall be cumulative and in addition to every other remedy or right now or hereafter existing at law or in equity or by statute or provided for in the Loan Agreement. No delay in the exercise or omission to exercise any remedy or right accruing on any default shall impair any such remedy or right or be construed to be a waiver of any such default or acquiescence therein, nor shall it affect any subsequent default of the same or different nature. Every such remedy or right may be exercised concurrently or independently, and when and as often as may be deemed expedient by Mortgagee.
- Mortgagee Party to Suits. If Mortgagee shall be made a party to or shall intervene in any action or proceeding affecting the Mortgaged premises or the title thereto or the interest of Mortgagee under this Mortgage (including probate and bankruptcy proceedings), or if Mortgagee employs an attorney to collect any or all of the indebtedness hereby secured or to enforce any of the terms hereof or realize hereupon or to protect the lien hereof, or if Mortgagee shall incur any costs or expenses in preparation for the commencement of any foreclosure proceeding or for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the Mortgaged Premises or the security hereof, whether or not any such foreclosure or other suit or proceeding shall be actually commenced, then in any such case, Mortgagor agrees to pay to Mortgagee, immediately and without demand, all reasonable costs, charges, expenses and attorneys' fees incurred by Mortgagee in any such case, and the same shall constitute so much

additional indebtedness hereby secured payable upon demand with interest at the Default Interest Rate.

- Mortgagee, without notice to anyone, and 32. Modifications Not to Affect Lien. without regard to the consideration, if any, paid therefor, or the presence of other liens on the Mortgaged premises, may in its discretion release any part of the Mortgaged Premises or any person liable for any of the indebtedness hereby secured, may extend the time of payment of any of the indebtedness hereby secured and may grant waivers or other indulgences with respect hereto and thereto, without in any way affecting or impairing the liability of any party liable upon any of the indebcdness hereby secured or the priority of the lien of this Mortgage upon all of the Mortgaged Premises not expressly released, and may agree with Mortgagor to modifications to the terms and conditions contained herein or otherwise applicable to any of the indebtedness hereby secured (including modifications in the rates of interest applicable thereto).
- Notices. All notices or other communications required or permitted hereunder 33. shall be (a) in writing and shall be deemed to be given when either (i) delivered in person, (ii) three (3) business days after deposit in a regularly maintained receptacle of the united States mail as registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, (iii) when received if sent by private courier services, or (iv) on the day on which the party to whom such notice is addressed refuses delivery by mail or by private courier service, and (o) addressed as follows:

All rights, powers and remedies provided herein are intended to be limited to the extent necessary so that they will not render this Mortgage invalid, unenforceable or not entitled to be recorded, registered or filed under any applicable law. If any term of this Mortgage shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity and enforceability of the other terms of this mortgage shall in no way be affected thereby.
- 35. Successors and Assigns. Whenever any of the parties hereto is referred to, such reference shall be deemed to include the successors and assigns of such party; and all the covenants, promises and agreements in this Mortgage contained by or on behalf of Mortgager, or by or on behalf of Mortgagee, shall bind and inure to the benefit of the respective successors and assigns of such parties, whether so expressed or not.
- 36. <u>Default Interest Rate</u>. For purposes of this Mortgage, "Default Interest Rate" shall mean the "Default Interest Rate" 2.3 defined in the Note.
- 37. Headings. The headings in this instrument are for convenience of reference only and shall not limit or otherwise affect the meaning of any provision hereof.
- 38. Changes, Etc. This instrument and the provisions hereof may be changed, waived, discharged or terminated only by an instrument rewriting signed by the party against which enforcement of the change, waiver, discharge or termination is sought.
- 39. <u>Variable Rate</u>. This Mortgage is in part, a variable rate mortgage, with changes in the rate of interest, said changes calculated pursuant to the formula in the Note.
- 40. Governing Law. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of Illinois.
- 41. Future Advances.
