

THE NOTE CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE AND THE MONTHLY PAYMENT. THE NOTE LIMITS THE AMOUNT THE BORROWER'S INTEREST RATE CAN CHANGE AT ANY ONE TIME AND THE MAXIMUM RATE THE BORROWER MUST PAY.

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

(A) Change Date

The interest rate may change on the first day of JANUARY 1 , 1998 , and on that day of each succeeding year. "Change Date" means each date on which the interest rate could change.

(B) The Index

Beginning with the first Change Date, the interest rate will be based on an Index. "Index" means the weekly average yield on United States Treasury Securities adjusted to a constant maturity of one year, as made available by the Federal Reserve Board. "Current Index" means the most recent Index figure available 30 days before the Change Date. If the Index (as defined above) is no longer available, Lender will use as a new Index any index prescribed by the Secretary. As used in this Rider, "Secretary" means the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development or his or her designee. Lender will give Borrower notice of the new Index.

(C) Calculation of Interest Rate Changes

Before each Change Date, Lender will calculate a new interest rate by adding a margin of TWO AND THREE FORTHS percentage point(s) (2.750 %) to the Current Index and rounding the sum to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). Subject to the limits stated in paragraph (D) of this Rider, this rounded amount will be the new interest rate until the next Change Date.

(D) Limits on Interest Rate Changes

The interest rate will never increase or decrease by more than one percentage point (1.0%) on any single Change Date. The interest rate will never be more than five percentage points (5.0%) higher or lower than the initial interest rate.

BY SIGNING BELOW, Borrower accepts to the terms and convenants contained in this Addendum.
Rider.

A new interest rate calculated in accordance with Paragraphs (C) and (D) of this Rider will become effective on the Change Date. Borrower shall make a payment in the new monthly amount beginning on the first payment date which occurs at least 25 days after Lender has given Borrower the notice of changes required by Paragraph (F) of this Rider. Borrower shall have no obligation to pay any increase in the monthly payment amount if this Rider is terminated or modified to give timely notice and Borrower made any monthly payment exceeding the payment amount calculated in accordance with Paragraph (E) of this Rider, but Lender failed to give timely notice of the decrease and Borrower made any monthly payment less than 25 days after calculation in accordance with Paragraph (E) of this Rider for any payment date occurring less than 25 days after Lender has given the required notice. If the monthly payment amount calculated in accordance with Paragraph (E) of this Rider for any payment date occurring less than 25 days after Lender has given the required notice is greater than the monthly payment amount calculated in accordance with Paragraph (E) of this Rider for any payment date occurring less than 25 days after Lender has given the required notice, Lender may demand for return its trade.

(G) Effective Date of Changes
Lender will give notice to Borrower of any change in the interest rate and monthly payment amount. The notice must be given at least 25 days before the new monthly payment begins. The new monthly payment amount, and (viii) any other information which may be required by law from time to time, in calculating payment amount, and (vi) the current index and the date it was published, (vii) the method of calculating the change amount, (ii) the Change Date, (iii) the old interest rate, (iv) the new interest rate, (v) the new monthly payment amount, and (vi) the old principal balance which would be owed on the Change Date if there had been no default in payment of the note, (ii) the Change Date, (iii) the old interest rate, (iv) the new interest rate, (v) the new monthly payment amount, and (vi) the old principal balance which would be owed on the Change Date if there had been no default in payment of the note, reduced by the amount of any prepayments to principal. The result of this calculation will be the amount of Note, reduced by the amount of any prepayments to principal and interest.

If the interest rate changes on a Change Date, Lender will calculate the amount of monthly payment of principal and interest which would be necessary to repay the unpaid principal balance in full at the maturity date at the new interest rate through substantially equal payments. In making such calculation, Lender will use the unpaid principal balance which would be owed on the Change Date if there had been no default in payment of Note, reduced by the amount of any prepayments to principal. The result of this calculation will be the amount of Note, reduced by the amount of any prepayments to principal and interest.

(E) Calculation of Payment Change
If the interest rate changes on a Change Date, Lender will calculate the amount of monthly payment of principal and interest which would be necessary to repay the unpaid principal balance in full at the maturity date at the new interest rate through substantially equal payments. In making such calculation, Lender will use the unpaid principal balance which would be owed on the Change Date if there had been no default in payment of Note, reduced by the amount of any prepayments to principal. The result of this calculation will be the amount of Note, reduced by the amount of any prepayments to principal and interest.
