



EXRIBIT "A" LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

#### PARCEL 1:

Lots 47 to 54, both inclusive, and Lots 67 to 80, both inclusive.

and an irregular strip of land lying Southwesterly from and adjoining Lots 79 and 80 more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the West line of Artesian Avenue in the City of Chicago, Illinois and the Northerly right of way line of the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad; thence South along the West line of Artesian Avenue projected Southerly 6.54 feet; thence Northwesterly, 81.35 feet to a point in the Northerly right of way line of said Railroad, measured along the face of coping on said Railroad Co's retaining wall; thence southeasterly along the Northern right of way line of said Railroad, 77.23 feet to the place of commencement, all of the above describe land being situated in Block 16 in Walker's Subdivision of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 25, Township 39 North, Range 13, East of the Tair I Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois;
