This Security Instrument is given to Centennial Mortgage Company, a Division of
Superior Bank FSB, which is organized and existing under the laws of
the United States of America, and whose address is 9525 West Bryn Mawr,
Rosemont, IL 60018 ("Lender").
Borrower owes Lender the principal sum of Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100

Dollars (U.S. \$ 25,000.00). This debt is evidenced by Borrower's note dated the same
date as this Security Instrument ("Note"), which provides for monthly payments with the full debt, if not
paid earlier, due and payable on October 27, 2011. This Security Instrument secures
to Lender: (a) the repayment of the debt evidenced by the Note, with interest as provided by the terms of
the Note, and all renewals, extensions and modifications of the Note; (b) the payment of all other sums,
with interest, advanced under paragraph 6 to protect the security of this Security Instrument; and (c) the
performance of Borrower's covenants and agreements under this Security instrument and the Note. For
these purposes Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender the following described
property located in Cook County, Illinois:

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All insurance policies and renewals must be acceptable to Lender and must include a standard mortgage clause in favor of and in a form acceptable to Lender. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals. If Lender requires, Borrower shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid premiums and renewals.

4. **Hazard or Property Insurance.** Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against losses by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage" and any other hazards, including floods or flooding, for which Lender requires insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lender requires, not to exceed the full replacement cost of the buildings and improvements on the Property. The insurance company shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's approval, which shall not be unreasonable for the purpose of insuring the Property. The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower to maintain coverage described above, at Lender's option, obtainable withheld. If Borrower fails to maintain coverage described above, Lender may, at Lender's option, obtain coverage to protect Lender's rights in the Property in accordance with Paragraph 6.

Borrower shall perform all of Borrower's obligations under any mortgage, deed of trust or other security instrument with, creating or having a priority over, this Security Instrument, including but not limited to, Borrower's covenant to make payments when due. Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien which has priority over this Security Instrument (other than a senior mortgage), deed of trust or other security instrument to make payments when due. Borrower shall pay over a sum equal to the amount of principal and interest then due on the note, plus any costs, expenses, attorney fees, and other amounts due under this Security Instrument, to the holder of the note or to the holder's assignee, if any, in the manner and at the time specified in the note.

3. Prior Mortgagor's Liens. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument. Borrower shall pay all notices of amounts to be paid under leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts to be paid under this paragraph, and receipts evidencing such payments.

2. Application of Payments. Unless applicable law provides otherwise, Lender will apply each of Borrower's payments under the Note first to accrued and unpaid interest under the Note to the date of payment and the remainder, if any, to the unpaid principal balance under the Note. Any late charges and collection costs and the remainder, if any, to the projected check charges and payments made by Lender to enforce the Note and/or to protect Lender's interests under this Security Instrument will be assessed separately.

Borrower and Lender covenant and agree as follows:

BORROWER CONNANTS states Borrower is lawfully seized of the estate hereby conjectured has the right to mortgagor convey the Property and that the Predecessy is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands subject to any encumbrances of record.

TOGETHER WITH all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all fixtures, appurtenances, rents, royalties, minerals, oil and gas rights and royalties, water rights and easements, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, minerals, oil and gas rights and royalties, water rights and easements now or hereafter a part of the property. If Borrower abandons the Property, or does not answer within 30 days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claim, then Lender may collect the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The 30-day period will begin when the notice is given.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraph 1 or change the amount of the payments. If under paragraph 17 the Property is acquired by Lender, Borrower's right to any insurance policies and proceeds resulting from damage to the Property prior to the acquisition shall pass to Lender to the extent of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately prior to the acquisition.

5. Occupancy, Preservation, Maintenance and Protection of the Property; Borrower's Loan Application; Leasetholds; Condominiums; Planned Unit Developments. Unless Borrower's loan application and Lender's loan approval provided that the Property was not required to be occupied as Borrower's principal residence, Borrower shall occupy, establish, and use the Property as Borrower's principal residence within 60 days after the execution of this Security Instrument and shall continue to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least 1 year after the date of occupancy, unless Lender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Borrower's control. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall not permit, or be alleged to have permitted, the Property to be used in connection with any illegal activity. In that regard, Borrower shall be in default if any forfeiture action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's good faith judgment could result in forfeiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower shall also be in default if Borrower, during the loan application process, gave materially false or inaccurate information or statements to Lender (or failed to provide Lender with any material information) in connection with the loan evidenced by the Note, including, but not limited to, representations concerning Borrower's occupancy of the Property as a principal residence. If this Security Instrument is on a leasehold, Borrower shall comply with all the provisions of the lease. If Borrower acquires fee title to the Property, the leasehold and the fee title shall not merge unless Lender agrees to the merger in writing.

If this Security Instrument is on a unit in a condominium or a planned unit development, Borrower shall perform all of Borrower's obligations under the declaration or covenants creating or governing the condominium or planned unit development, the by-laws and regulations of the condominium or planned unit development and constituent documents.

6. Protection of Lender's Rights in the Property. If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or forfeiture or to enforce laws or regulations), then Lender may do and pay for whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. Lender's actions may include paying any sums secured by a lien which has priority over this Security Instrument, paying insurance premiums, appearing in court, paying reasonable attorneys' fees and entering on the Property to make repairs. Although Lender may take action under this paragraph 6, Lender does not have to do so.

Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this paragraph 6 shall become additional debt of Borrower secured by this Security Instrument. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these

9. Borrower Not Releasee; Lender Not a Waiver. Extentions of the time for payment or modifications of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender to Borrower or to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of Lender to Borrower or to any successor in interest of Borrower that is not otherwise released by Lender in writing. 8. **Condemnation.** The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for convenience in connection with any condemnation of any part of the Property, or for the amount secured by this condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender and applied to the amount secured by this condemnation instrument, subject to the terms of any senior mortgage, deed of trust or other security instrument. Any excess will be paid to the persons legally entitled to it.

7. Inspection. Lender or its agent may make reasonable entries upon and inspections of the property. Lender or its agent shall give Borrower notice at the time of or prior to an inspection specifying reasonable cause for the inspection.

13. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law, Illinois law and any local law that applies in the place in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.

14. Borrower's Copy. Borrower acknowledges receipt of photocopy or a conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.

15. Sale of Note, Change of Loan Servicer. The Note or a partial interest in the Note (together with this Security Instrument) may be sold one or more times without prior notice to Borrower. A sale may result in a change in the entity (known as the "Loan Servicer") that collects monthly payments due under the Note and this Security Instrument. There also may be one or more changes of the Loan Servicer unrelated to a sale of the Note. If there is a change of the Loan Servicer, Borrower will be given written notice of the change in accordance with paragraph 12 and applicable law. The notice will state the name and address of the new Loan Servicer and the address to which payments should be made. The notice will also contain any other information required by applicable law.

16. Hazardous Substances. Borrower shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storage, or release of any Hazardous Substances on or in the Property. Borrower shall not do, nor allow anyone else to do, anything affecting the Property that is in violation of any Environmental Law. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Property of small quantities of Hazardous Substances that are generally recognized to be appropriate to normal residential uses and to maintenance of the Property.

Borrower shall promptly give Lender written notice of any investigation, claim, demand, lawsuit or other action by any governmental or regulatory agency or private party involving the Property and any Hazardous Substance or Environmental Law of which Borrower has actual knowledge. If Borrower learns, or is notified by any governmental or regulatory authority, that any removal or other remediation of any Hazardous Substance affecting the Property is necessary, Borrower shall promptly take all necessary remedial actions in accordance with Environmental Law.

As used in this paragraph 16, "Hazardous Substances" are those substances defined as toxic or hazardous substances by Environmental Law and the following substances: gasoline, lead-based paint, kerosene, other flammable or toxic petroleum products, toxic pesticides and herbicides, volatile solvents, materials containing asbestos or formaldehyde, and radioactive materials. As used in this paragraph 16, "Environmental Law" means federal laws and laws of the jurisdiction where the Property is located that relate to health, safety or environmental protection.

17. Lender's Rights if Borrower Fails to Keep Promises and Agreements. If any of the events or conditions described in subparagraphs (A), (B), (C), (D), (E) or (F) of this paragraph 17 shall occur, Lender, after giving Borrower any timely notice of Borrower's right to cure as may then be required by applicable law and Borrower's failure to cure within the time period set forth in such notice, may require that Borrower pay immediately the entire amount remaining unpaid under the Note and this Security Instrument. This requirement will be called "Immediate Payment in Full."

If Lender requires Immediate Payment in Full, Lender may bring a lawsuit to take away all of Borrower's remaining rights in the Property and to have the Property sold. At this sale Lender or another person may acquire the Property. This is known as "foreclosure and sale." If the proceeds of this sale are

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If Lender gives notice of breach to Borrower, and to the extent that rents are not being collected by the holder of an assignment of rents which has priority over this Security Instrument; (ii) all rents received by Borrower shall be held by Borrower as trustee for the benefit of Lender only, to be applied to the sums secured by the Security Instrument; (iii) Lender shall be entitled to collect and receive all of the rents

19. Assignment of Rents. Borrower unconditionally assigns and transfers to Lender all the rents and revenues of the Property. Borrower authorizes Lender or Lender's agent(s) to collect the rents and revenues of each directee of the Property to pay the rents to Lender or Lender's agent(s). except that Lender shall not be entitled to collect such rents and revenues if and to the extent such rents and revenues are being collected by the holder of an assignment of rents which has priority over this Security Instrument. However, prior to Lender's notice to Borrower of Lender's breach of any covenant or agreement in the Security Instrument, Borrower shall collect and receive all rents and revenues of the Property as trustee for the benefit of Lender and Borrower. The assignment of rents constitutes an absolute assignment and not an assigment for security only.

18. Assignment of Leases. Borrower hereby assigns to Lender all leases of the Property and all security deposits made in connection with leases of the Property. Upon Lender's notice to Borrower of Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument, Lender shall have the right to terminate the existing leases and to execute new leases, in Lender's sole discretion. Upon acceleration under paragraph 17 or abandonment of the Property and at any time thereafter Lender, in person, by agent or by judicially appointed receiver, shall be entitled to enter upon, take possession of and manage the Property and to collect the rents of the Property, including those past due, pursuant to paragraph 19. However, Lender shall be under no obligation to enter upon, take control of or maintain the Property. Any rents collected by Lender or the receiver shall be applied first to payment of the costs of management of the Property and collection of rents, including, but not limited to, receiver's fees, premiums on receiver's bonds and reasonable attorneys' fees, and then to the sums secured by this Security Instrument. Lender and any receiver shall be liable to account only for those rents actually received.

21. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall discharge this Security Instrument without charge to Borrower. Borrower shall pay all costs of recordation, if any.

22. Waiver of Homestead. Borrower waives all right of homestead exemption in the Property.

23. Use of Property; Compliance with Law. Borrower shall not seek, agree to or make a change in the use of the Property or its zoning classification, unless Lender has agreed in writing to the change. Borrower shall comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations and requirements of any governmental body applicable to the Property.

24. Riders to this Security Instrument. If one or more riders are executed by Borrower and recorded together with this Security Instrument, the covenants and agreements of each such rider shall be incorporated into and shall amend and supplement the covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument as if the rider(s) were a part of this Security Instrument.
