2. OBLIGATIONS DEFINED. The term "Obligations" is defined as and includes the following:

. (Note) dated August 30, 1996, with a maturity date of August A. A promissory note, No. 30, 2001, and executed by MOUNT GREENWOOD BANK A/T/U/T/A DATED 7-22-96 A/K/A TRUST #5-1198 (Borrower) payable in monthly payments to the order of Bank, which evidences a loan (Loan) to Borrower in the amount of \$600,000.00, plus interest, and all extensions, renewals, modifications or substitutions thereof.

B. All future advances by Bank to Borrower, to Mortgagor, to any one of them or to any one of them. and others (and all other obligations referred to in the subparagraph(s) below, whether or not this Mortgage is specifically referred to in the evidence of indebtedness with regard to such future and additional indebtedness).

C. All additional sums advanced, and expenses incurred, by Bank for the purpose of insuring. preserving or otherwise protecting the Property (as herein defined) and its value, and any other sums advanced, and expenses incurred by Bank pursuant to this Mortgage, plus interest at the same rate provided for in the Note computed on a simple interest method.

D. All other obligations, now existing or hereafter arising, by Borrower owing to Bank to the extent the

taking of the Property (as herein defined) as security therefor is not prohibited by taw, including but not limited to liabilities for overdrafts, all advances made by Bank on Borrower's and/or Mortgagor's, behalf as authorized by this Mortgage and liabilities as guarantor, endorser or surety, of Borrower to Bank, due or to become due, direct or indirect, absolute or contingent, primary or secondary, liquidated or unliquidated, or joint, several, or joint and several.

E. Borrower's performance of the terms in the Note or Loan, Mortgagor's performance of any terms in this Mortgage, and Borrower's and Mortgagor's performance of any terms in any deed of trust, any trust deed, any trust indenture, any other mortgage, any deed to secure debt, any security agreement, any assignment, any construction loan agreement, any loan agreement, any assignment of beneficial interest, any guaranty agreement or any other agreement which secures, guaranties or otherwise relates to the Note or Loan.

However, this hichgage will not secure another debt:

- A. if Bank falls to make any disclosure of the existence of this Mortgage required by law for such other debt.
- CONVEYANCE. In consideration of the Loan and Obligations, and to secure the Obligations (which
 includes the Note according to its specific terms and the obligations in this Mortgage), Mortgager hereby
 bargains, grants, mortgages, sails, conveys and warrants to Bank, as Mortgagee, the following described
 property (Property) situated in CCOK County, ILLINOIS, to-wit:

such property not constituting the homestead of Borrower, together with all buildings, improvements, fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to the Property, including, but not limited to, all heating, air conditioning, ventilation, plumbing, cooling, electrical and lighting fixtures and equipment; all landscaping; all exterior and interior improvements; all easements, issues, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, oil and gas rights, privileges, proceeds, profits other minerals, water, water rights, and water stock, crops, grass and timber at any time growing upon said land, including replacements and additions thereto, all of which shall be deemed to be and remain a part of the Property. All of the foregoing Property shall be collectively hereinafter referred to as the Property. To have and to hold the Property, together with the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto Pank forever to secure the Obligations. Mortgagor does hereby warrant and defend the Property unto Bank forever, against any claim or claims, of all persons claiming or to claim the Property or any part thereof. Mortgagor further releases and waives all rights under and by virtue of the homestead laws and exemption laws of the state of ILLINOIS.

INTEREST AND REPAYMENT OF THE OBLIGATIONS. The Note accrues interest from August 30, 1996, on the unpaid principal balance at the rate of 8% per annum (Contract Rate) until the Note matures or the obligation is accelerated. After maturity or acceleration, the unpaid balance shall been interest at the rate specified in the Note until paid. The Loan and the Note are limited to the maximum lawful amount of interest (Maximum Lawful Interest) permitted under federal and state laws. If the interest accrued and collected exceeds the Maximum Lawful Interest as of the time of collection, such excess shall be applied to reduce the principal amount outstanding, unless otherwise required by law. If or when no principal amount is outstanding, any excess interest shall be refunded to Borrower according to the actuarial method. Interest shall be computed on the basis of a 360-day year and the actual number of days elapsed.

All unpeld principal and accrued interest are due and payable upon demand. Until demand is made, principal and accrued interest are due and payable in 59 equal monthly payments of \$4,677.71 on the 30th day of each month, beginning September 30, 1996, or the day following if the payment day is a holiday or is a non-business day for Bank. Unless paid prior to maturity or demand is made, the last scheduled payment plus all other unpaid principal, accrued interest, costs and expenses are due and payable on August 30, 2001, which is the date of maturity. These payment amounts are based upon timely payment of each installment. Each installment payment shall be paid on the date due, or if such date does not exist for that month, then such payment shall be due on the last day of

that month or the day following if the payment day is a holiday or is a non-business day for Bank. All amounts shall be paid in legal U.S. currency. Any payment made with a check will constitute payment only when collected.

- 5. LIENS AND ENCUMBRANCES. Mortgagor warrants and represents that the Property is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. Mortgagor agrees to pay all claims when due that might result, if unpaid, in the foreclosure, execution or imposition of any lien, claim or encumbrance on or against the Property or any part thereof. Mortgagor may in good faith contest any such lien, claim or encumbrance by posting any bond in an amount necessary to prevent such claim from becoming a lien, claim or encumbrance or to prevent its foreclosure or execution.
- 6. ESCROW ACCOUNT. Subject to applicable law, Montgagor shall pay to Bank or to such other person as Bank or law may require (Escrow Agent) on each day a payment is due under the Note and this Mortgage, until the Note is paid in full, the following sums:
 - A. A prorated amount (divided by the required number of payments in a year) equal to ground rents, if any, and the yearly taxes and assessments next due on the Property, plus yearly premiums on policies of fire flood and other hazard insurance on the Property due in advance. Such amounts shall be reasonably estimated by Bank (or Escrow Agent), initially and from time to time, taking into account all shortages or excesses, if any. Such amounts are hereby designated as the Escrow Funds (Escrow Funds). The Escrow Funds are to be held by Escrow Agent in trust to pay such ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments before they become delinquent; and
 - B. The Escrow Funds and the imounts payable under the Note and this Mortgage shall be applied to the following items in the order as listed: (1) ground rents, taxes, assessments, fire insurance premiums, flood insurance premiums and other hazard insurance premiums; (2) fees, expenses and costs incurred by Bank for the protection of the Property and the protection of its lien to the extent not prohibited by law; and (3) the balance of any, in accordance with the terms of the Note.

If the Escrow Funds are not sufficient to pay the taxes assessments and premiums as they become due, Mortgagor shall pay to Escrow Agent any amount necessary to make up the deficiency within 30 days of written notice by Bank (or Escrow Agent). Bank (and Escrow Agent), unless required by law, are not required to pay Mortgagor any interest or earnings on the sums held in trust. Mortgagor expressly grants a lien on the Escrow Funds as additional security for the Obligations and other amounts secured by this of Mortgagor.

- 7. EVENTS OF DEFAULT. Mortgagor shall be in default upon the occurrence of any of the following events, circumstances or conditions (Events of Default):
 - A. Failure by any party obligated on the Obligations to make payment when due or
 - B. A default or breach by Borrower, Mortgagor or any co-signer, endorser, surety, or guarantor under any of the terms of this Mortgage, the Note, any construction loan agreement or other loan agreement, any security agreement, mortgage, deed to secure debt, deed of trust trust deed, or any other document or instrument evidencing, guarantying, securing or otherwise relating to the Obligations; or
 - C. The making or furnishing of any verbal or written representation, statement or warranty to Bank which is or becomes faise or incorrect in any material respect by or on behalf of Mortgagor, Borrower, or any co-signer, endorser, surety or guarantor of the Obligations; or
 - D. Failure to obtain or maintain the insurance coverages required by Bank, or insurance as is customary and proper for the Property (as herein defined); or
 - E. The death, dissolution or insolvency of, the appointment of a receiver by or on behalf of, the assignment for the benefit of creditors by or on behalf of, the voluntary or involuntary termination of existence by, or the commencement of any proceeding under any present or future federal or state insolvency, bankruptcy, reorganization, composition or debtor relief law by or against Mortgagor, Borrower, or any co-signer, endorser, surety or guarantor of the Obligations; or
 - F. A good faith belief by Bank at any time that Bank is insecure with respect to Borrower, or any co-signer, endorser, surety or guarantor, that the prospect of any payment is impaired or that the

Property (as herein defined) is impaired; or

- G. Failure to pay or provide proof of payment of any tax, assessment, rent, insurance premium, escrow or escrow deficiency on or before its due date; or
- H. A material adverse change in Mortgagor's business, including ownership, management, and financial conditions, which in Bank's opinion, impairs the Property or repayment of the Obligations; or
- I. A transfer of a substantial part of Mortgagor's money or property; or
- J. If all or any part of the Property or any interest therein is sold, leased or transferred by Mortgagor except as permitted in the paragraph below entitled "DUE ON SALE OR ENCUMBRANCE".
- 8. REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. At the option of Bank, all or any part of the principal of, and accrued interest on, the Obligations shall become immediately due and payable without notice or demand, upon the occurrence of an Event of Default or at any time thereafter. In addition, upon the occurrence of any Event of Default, Bank, at its option, may immediately commence foreclosure proceedings and may immediately invoke any or all other remedies provided in the Note, this Mortgage or related documents. Bank is entitled to all rights and remedies provided at law or equity whether or not expressly stated in this Mortgage. By choosing any remedy, Bank does not waive its right to an immediate use of any other remedy if the event of default continues or occurs again.
- 9. DUE ON SALE OR ENCUMERANCE. Bank may, at Bank's option, declare the entire balance with all accrued interest on the Obligations to be immediately due and payable upon the contract for, or creation of, any lien, encumbrance, transfer or sale of the Property, or any portion thereof, by Mortgagor. Lapse of time or the acceptance of payments by Sank after such creation of any lien, encumbrance, transfer or sale, or contract for any of the foregoing, shall not be deemed a waiver or estoppel of Bank's right to accelerate the Obligations. If Bank exercises such option to accelerate, Bank shall mail, by certified mail or otherwise, Mortgagor notice of acceleration to the address of Mortgagor shown on Bank's records; the notice shall provide for a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is mailed within which Mortgagor shall pay the sums declared due. If Mortgagor fails to pay such sums prior to the expiration of such period, Bank may, without further notice or demand on Mortgagor, invoke any remedies permitted on Default. This covenant shall run with the Property and shall remain in effect until the Obligations and this Mortgage are fully paid.

In the preceding paragraph, the phrase "transfer or sale" includes the conveyance of any right, little or interest in the Property, whether voluntary or involuntary, by outright sale, deed, installment contract sale, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three years, lease-option contract or any other method of conveyance of the Property interests; the term "interest" includes, whether legal or equitable, any right, title, interest, lien, claim, encumbrance or proprietary right, choate or inchoate, any of which is superior to the lien created by this Mortgage.

- 10. POSSESSION ON FORECLOSURE. If an action is brought to foreclose this Mortgage for all or any part of the Obligations, Mortgagor agrees that the Bank shall be entitled to immediate possession as Mortgagee in possession of the Property to the extent not prohibited by law, or the court may appoint, and Mortgagor hereby consents to such appointment, a receiver to take possession of the Property and to collect and receive rents and profits arising therefrom. Any amounts so collected shall be used to pay taxes on, provide insurance for, pay costs of needed repairs and for any other expenses relating to the Property or the foreclosure proceedings, sale expenses or as authorized by the court. Any sum remaining after such payments will be applied to the Obligations.
- 11. PROPERTY OBLIGATIONS. Mortgagor shall promptly pay all taxes, assessments, levies, water rents, other rents, insurance premiums and all amounts due on any encumbrances, if any, as they become due. Mortgagor shall provide written proof to Bank of such payment(s).
- 12. INSURANCE. Mortgagor shall insure and keep insured the Property against loss by fire, and other hazard, casualty and loss, with extended coverage including but not limited to the replacement value of all

improvements, with an insurance company acceptable to Bank and in an amount acceptable to Bank. Such insurance shall contain the standard "Mortgagee Clause" and where applicable. "Loss Payee Clause", which shall name and endorse Bank as mortgagee and loss payee. Such insurance shall also contain a provision under which the insurer shall give Bank at least 30 days notice before the cancellation, termination or material change in coverage.

If an insurer elects to pay a fire or other hazard loss or damage claim rather than to repair, rebuild or replace the Property test or damaged, Bank shall have the option to apply such insurance proceeds upon the Obligations secured by this Mortgage or to have said Property repaired or rebuilt. Mortgager shall deliver or cause to deliver evidence of such coverage and copies of all notices and renewals relating thereto. Bank shall be entitled to pursue any claim under the insurance if Mortgagor fails to promptly do so.

Mortgagor anall pay the premiums required to maintain such insurance in effect until such time as the requirement for such insurance terminates. In the event Mortgagor fails to pay such premiums, Bank may, at its option, pay such premiums. Any such payment by Bank shall be repayable upon demand of Bank or if no demand is made, in accordance with the paragraph below titled "BANK MAY PAY".

- 13. WASTE. Mortgagor shall not alienate or encumber the Property to the prejudice of Bank, or commit, permit or suffer any waste, impairment or deterioration of the Property, and regardless of natural depreciation, shall keep the Property and all its improvements at all times in good condition and repair. Mortgagor shall comply with and not violate any and all laws and regulations regarding the use, ownership and occupancy of the Property. Mortgagor shall perform and abide by all obligations and restrictions under any declarations, covenants and other documents governing the use, ownership and occupancy of the Property.
- 14. CONDITION OF PROPERTY. As to the Property Mortgagor shall:
 - A. keep all buildings occupied and keep all buildings, structures and improvements in good repair.
 - B. refrain from the commission or allowance of any acts of waste or impairment of the value of the Property or improvements thereon.
 - C. not cut or remove, or permit to be cut or removed, any wood or timber from the Property, which cutting or removal would adversely affect the value of the Property.
 - D. prevent the spread of noxious or damaging weeds, preceive and prevent the erosion of the soil and continuously practice approved methods of farming on the Property if used for agricultural purposes.

15. ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES.

A. As used in this paragraph:

- (1) "Environmental Law" means, without limitation, the Compresensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act ("CERCLA", 42 U.S.C. %) et seq.), all federal, state and local laws, regulations, ordinances, court orders, attorney general opinions or interpretive letters concerning the public health, safety, welfare, environment or a Hazardous Substance (as defined herein).
- (2) "Hazardous Substance" means any toxic, radioactive or hazardous material, waste, pollutant or contaminant which has characteristics which render the substance dangerous or potentially dangerous to the public health, safety, welfare or the environment. The term includes, without limitation, any substances defined as "hazardous material," "toxic substances," "hazardous waste" or "hazardous substance" under any Environmental Law.
- B. Mortgagor represents, warrante and agrees that:
 - (1) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, no Hazardous Substance has been, is or will be located, transported, manufactured, treated, refined, or handled by any person on, under or about the Property except in the ordinary course of business and in strict compliance with all applicable Environmental Law.
 - (2) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, Mortgagor has not and shall not cause, contribute to or permit the release of any Hazardous Substance on the

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Property.

- (3) Mortgagor shall immediately notify Bank if: (a) a release or threatened release of Hazardous Substance occurs on, under or about the Property or migrates or threatens to migrate from nearby property; or (b) there is a violation of any Environmental Law concerning the Property. In such an event, Mortgagor shall take all necessary remedial action in accordance with any Environmental Law.
- (4) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, Mortgagor has no knowledge of or reason to believe there is any pending or threatened investigation, claim, or proceeding of any kind relating to (a) any Hazardous Substance located on, under or about the Property or (b) any violation by Mortgagor or any tenant of any Environmental Law. Mortgagor shall immediately notify Bank in writing as soon as Mortgagor has reason to believe there is any such pending or threatened investigation, claim, or proceeding. In such an event, Bank has the right, but not the obligation, to participate in any such proceeding including the right to receive copies of any documents relating to such proceedings.
- (5) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, Mortgagor and every tenant have been, are and shall remain in full compliance with any applicable Environmental Law.
- (6) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, there are no underground storace tanks, private dumps or open wells located on or under the Property and no such tank, dump or well shall be added unless Bank first agrees in writing.
- (7) Mortgagor will regularly inspect the Property, monitor the activities and operations on the Property, and confirm that all permits, licenses or approvals required by any applicable Environmental Law are obtained and complied with.
- (8) Mortgagor will permit, or cause any tenant to permit, Bank or Bank's agent to enter and inspect the Property and review all reports at any reasonable time to determine: (a) the existence, location and nature of any Hazardous Substance on, under or about the Property; (b) the existence, location, nature, and magnitude of any Hazardous Substance that has been released on, under or about the Property; (c) whether or not Mongagor and any tenant are in compliance with any applicable, Environmental Law.
- (9) Upon Bank's request, Mortgagor agrees, at Mortgagor's expense, to engage a qualified environmental engineer to prepare an environmental audit of the Property and to submit the results of such audit to Bank. The choice of the environmental engineer who will perform such audit is subject to the approval of Bank.
- (10) Bank has the right, but not the obligation, to perform any of Mortgagor's obligations under this paragraph at Mortgagor's expense.
- (11) As a consequence of any breach of any representation, warranty or promise made in this paragraph, (a) Mortgagor will indemnify and hold Bank and Bank's successors or assigns harmless from and against all losses, claims, demands, liabilities, demages, clear up, response and remediation costs, penalties and expenses, including virtuout limitation all costs of litigation and reasonable attorneys' fees, which Bank and Bank's successors or assigns may sustain; and (b) at Bank's discretion, Bank may release this Mortgage and in return Mortgagor will provide Bank with collateral of at least equal value to the Property secured by this Mortgage without prejudice to any of Bank's rights under this Mortgage.
- (12) Notwithstanding any of the language contained in this Mortgage to the contrary, the terms of this paragraph shall survive any foreclosure or satisfaction of any deed of trust, mortgage or any obligation regardless of any passage of title to Bank or any disposition by Bank of any or all of the Property. Any claims and defenses to the contrary are hereby walved.
- 16. INSPECTION BY BANK. Bank or its agents may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon the Property and inspect the Property provided that Bank shall make reasonable efforts to give Mortgagor prior notice of any such inspection.
- 17. PROTECTION OF BANK'S SECURITY. If Mortgagor fails to perform any covenant, obligation or

agreement contained in the Note, this Mortgage or any loan documents or if any action or proceeding is commenced which materially affects Bank's interest in the Property, including, but not limited to, foreclosure, eminent domain, insolvency, housing or Environmental Law or law enforcement, or arrangements or proceedings involving a bankrupt or decedent, then Bank, at Bank's sole option, may make such appearances, disburse such sums, and take such action as is necessary to protect Bank's interest. Mortgagor hereby assigns to Bank any right Mortgagor may have by reason of any prior encumbrance on the Property or by law or otherwise to cure any default under said prior encumbrance. Without Bank's prior written consent, Mortgagor will not partition or subdivide the Property.

- 18. COLLECTION EXPENSES. In the event of any default or action by Bank for collection of the Obligations, for protection of the Property or for foreclosure, Mortgagor agrees to pay all fees and expenses incurred by Bank. Such fees and expenses include but are not limited to filing fees, stenographer fees, witness fees, costs of publication, foreclosure minutes, and other expenses of collecting and enforcing the Obligations and protecting the Property. Any such collection expenses shall be added to the principal amount of the Obligations, shall accrue interest at the same rate as the Obligations and shall be secured by this Mortgage.
- 19. ATTORNEYS' FEES. In the event of any default or action by Bank for collection of the Obligations, for protection of the Property of for foreclosure, Mortgagor agrees to pay reasonable attorneys' fees, paralegal fees and other legal expenses incurred by Bank. Any such reasonable attorneys' fees shall be added to the principal amount of the Obligations, shall accrue interest at the same rate as the Obligations and shall be secured by this Mortgage.
- 20. CONDEMNATION. In the event all or any part of the Property (including but not limited to any easement therein) is sought to be taken by private raking or by virtue of the law of eminent domain, Mortgagor will promptly give written notice to Bank of the institution of such proceedings. Mortgagor further agrees to notify Bank of any attempt to purchase or appropriate the Property or any easement therein, by any public authority or by any other person or corporation claiming or having the right of eminent domain or appropriation. Mortgagor further agrees and direct; that all condemnation proceeds or purchase money which may be agreed upon or which may be found to be due shall be paid to Bank as a prepayment under the Note. Mortgagor also agrees to notify the Bank of any proceedings instituted for the establishment of any sewer, water, conservation, ditch, drainage, or other district relating to or binding upon the Property or any part thereof. All awards payable for the taking of title to, or possession of, or damage to all or any portion of the Property by reason of any private taking, condemnation, eminent domain, change of grade, or other proceeding shall, at the option of Bank, be paid to Bank. Such awards or compensation are hereby assigned to Bank, and judgment therefor shall be entered in favor of Bank.

When paid, such awards shall be used, at Bank's option, toward the payment of the Obligations or payment of taxes, assessments, repairs or other items provided for In this Mortgage, whether one or not, all in such order and manner as Bank may determine. Such application or release shall not cure or waive any default. In the event Bank deems it necessary to appear or answer in any condemnation action, hearing or proceeding, Mortgagor shall hold Bank harmless from and pay all legal expenses, including but not limited to reasonable attorneys' fees and paralegal fees, court costs and other expenses.

- OTHER PROCEDINGS. If any action or proceeding is commenced to which Bank is made or chooses to become a party by reason of the execution of the Note, this Mortgage, any loan documents or the existence of any Obligations or in which Bank deems it necessary to appear or answer in order to protect its interests, Mortgagor agrees to pay and to hold Bank harmless for all liabilities, costs and expenses paid or incurred by Bank in such action or proceedings, including but not limited to reasonable attorneys' fees, paralegal fees, court costs and all other damages and expenses.
- 22. WAIVER BY MORTGAGOR. To the extent not specifically prohibited by law, Mortgagor hereby waives and releases any and all rights and remedies Mortgagor may now have or acquire in the future relating to:
 - A. homestead;
 - 8. exemptions as to the Property;

- C. redemption;
- D. right of reinstatement;
- E. appraisement;
- F. marshalling of liens and assets; and
- G. statutes of limitations.

In addition, redemption by Mortgagor after foreclosure sale is expressly waized to the extent not prohibited by law.

- 23. PARTIAL FORECLOSURE. In case of default in the payment of the Obligations or in case of payment by Bank of any tax, insurance premium, cost or expense or the filting, imposition or attachment of any lien, judgment or encumbrance, Bank shall have the right, without declaring the whole indebtedness due and payable, to foreclose against the Property or any part thereof on account of such specific default. This Mortgage shall continue as a lien on any of the property not sold on foreclosure for such unpaid balance of the Obligations.
- 24. BANK MAY PAY I Mortgagor fails to pay when due any of the items it is obligated to pay or fails to perform when obligated to perform, Bank may, at its option:

 - C. The making or furnishing of any verbal or written representation, statement or warranty to Bank which is or becomes false or incorrect in any material respect by or on behalf of Owner, Borrower, or any co-signer, endorser, surely or guaranter of the Obligations; or
 - D. Failure to cottain or maintain the insurance coverages required by Bank, or insurance as is customary and proper for the Collateral (as herein defined); or
 - E.  - (2) "Hazardous Substance" metors any toxic, radioactive or hazardous material, waste, pollutant or contaminant which has characteristics which render the substance dangerous or potentially dangerous to the public health, safety, welfare or the environment. The term includes, without limitation, any substances defined as "hazardous material," "toxic substances," "hazardous waste" or "hazardous substance" under any Environmental Law.
- B. Owner represents, warrants and agrees that:
 - (1) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, no Hazardous Substance has been, is or will be located, transported, manufactured, treated, refined, or handled by any person on, under or about the Property except in the ordinary course of business and in strict compliance with all applicable Environmental Law.
 - (2) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank. Owner has not and shall not cause, contribute to or permit the release of any Hazardous Substance on the Property.
 - (3) Owner shall immediately notify Bank if: (a) a release or threatened release of Hazardous Substance occurs on under or about the Property or migrates or threatened to migrate from nearby property; or (b) there is a violation of any Environmental Law concerning the Property. In such an event, Owner shall take all necessary remedial action in accordance with any Environmental Law.
 - (4) Except its previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, Owner has no knowledge of or reason to believe there is any pending or threatened investigation, claim, or proceeding of any kind relating to (a) any Hazardous Substance located on, under or about the Property or (b) any violation by Owner or any tenant of any Environmental Law. Owner shall immediately notify Bank in writing as soon as Owner has reason to believe there is any such pending or threatened investigation, claim, or proceeding. In such an event, Bank has the right, but not the obligation, to participate in any such proceeding including the right to receive copies of any documents relating to such proceedings.
 - (5) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, Owner and every tenant have treen, are and shall remain in full compliance with any applicable Environmental Law.
 - (6) Except as previously disclosed and acknowledged in writing to Bank, there are no

- underground storage tanks, private dumps or open wells located on or under the Property and no such tank, dump or well shall be added unless Bank first agrees in writing.
- (7) Owner will regularly inspect the Property, monitor the activities and operations on the Property, and confirm that all permits, licenses or approvals required by any applicable Environmental Law are obtained and complied with.
- (8) Owner will permit, or cause any tenant to permit, Bank or Bank's agent to enter and inspect the Property and review all records at any reasonable time to determine: (a) the existence, location and nature of any Hazardous Substance on, under or about the Property; (b) the existence, location, nature, and magnitude of any Hazardous Substance that has been released on, under or about the Property; (c) whether or not Owner and any tenant are in compliance with any applicable Environmental Law.
- (9) Upon Bank's request, Owner agrees, at Owner's expense, to engage a qualified environmental engineer to prepare an environmental audit of the Property and to submit the results of such audit to Bank. The choice of the environmental engineer who will perform such audit is subject to the approval of Bank.
- (10) Bank has the right, but not the obligation, to perform any of Owner's obligations under this paragraph at Owner's expense.
- (11) As a consequence of any breach of any representation, warranty or promise made in this paragraph, (a) Owner will indemnify and hold Bank and Bank's successors or assigns harmless from and against all losses, claims, demands, liabilities, damages, cleanup, response and remodiation costs, penalties and expenses, including without limitation all costs of litigation and reasonable attorneys' fees, which Bank and Bank's successors or assigns may sustain; and (b) at Bank's discretion, Bank may release this Agreement and in return Owner will provide Bank with collateral of at least equal value to the Property secured by this Agreement without projudice to any of Bank's rights under this Agreement.
- (12) Notwithstanding any of the language contained in this Agreement to the contrary, the terms of this paragraph shall survive any foreclosure or satisfaction of any deed of trust, mortgage or any obligation regardless of any passage of title to Bank or any disposition by Bank of any or all of the Property. Any claims and defenses to the contrary are hereby waived.
- ADDITIONAL POWERS OF BANK. In addition to all other powers granted by this Agreement and the Mortgage, Bank also has the rights and powers, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Code of Civil Procedure, Section 15-1101, et seq.

- E. FURTHER ASSURANCES. Owner agrees, upon request of Bank and within the time Bank specifies, to provide any information, and to execute, acknowledge, deliver and record or file such

- J. DEANTIONS. The terms used in this Agreement, if not defined herein, shall have their meanings as defined in the other documents executed contemporaneously, or in conjunction, with this
- K. PARAGRAPH HEADINGS. The headings at the beginning of any paragraph, or any subparagraph, in this Agreement are for convenience only and shall not be dispositive in interpreting or construing this Agreement.
- IF HELD UNENFORCEABLE. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held unenforceable or void, then such provision to the extent not otherwise limited by law shall be severable from the remaining provisions and shall in no way affect the enforceability of the remaining provisions nor the validity of this Agreement.
