THE NOTE CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST DATE AND THE MONTHLY PAYMENT. THE NOTE LIMITS THE AMOUNT THE BORROWER'S ADJUSTABLE INTEREST RATE CAN CHANGE AT ANY ONE TIME AND THE MAXIMUM RATE THE BORROWER MUST PAY. THE NOTE ALSO CONTAINS THE OPTION TO CONVERT THE ADJUSTABLE RATE TO A FIXED RATE.

ADDITIONAL COVERENTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as foliows:

A. ADJUSTABLE RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

The Note provides for an Intrial Interest rate of 6.7500 %. The Note provides for changes in the adjustable interest rate and the monthly payments, as follows:

4. ADJUSTABLE INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

(A) Change Dates

The adjustable interest rate I will pay may change on the lirst day of October, 1997 that day every 12th month thereafter. Each date in which my adjustable interest rate could change is called a "Charige Date."

(B) The Index

Beginning with the first Change Date, my adjustable interest rate will be based on an Index. (C) Calculation of Changes

Before each Change Date, the Note Holder will calculate my new interest returnly adding. Two and Seven / Eighths percentage point(s) (2.8750 %) to the Current Index. The Note Holder will then round the result of this addition to the nearest one-eighth of or e pricentage point (0.125%). Subject to the limits stated in Section 4(D) below, this rounded amount will go my new interest rate until the next Change Data.

The Note Holder will then determine the amount of the monthly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal that I am expected to owe at the Change Date in full on the maturity dute at my now interest rate in substantially equal payments. The result of this calculation will be the new amount of my

monthly payment.

(D) Limits on interest Rate Changes

The interest rate I am required to pay at the lirst Change Date will not be greater than 8.7500 % or less than 4.7500 %. Thereafter, my adjustable interest rate will never be increased or decreased on any single Change Date by more than Two percentage point(s) %) from the rate of interest I have been paying for the preceding 12 months. (E) Effective Date of Changes

My new interest rate will become effective on each Change Date. I will pay the amount of my new monthly payment beginning on the first monthly payment date after the Change Date until the amount of my monthly payment changes again.

(F) Notice of Changes

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The Note Holder will deliver or mail to me a notice of any changes in my adjustable interest rate and the amount of my monthly payment before the effective data of any change. The notice will include information required by law to be given me and also the title and telephone number of a person who will answer any question I may have regarding the notice.

B. FIXE INTEREST RATE OPTION

The Note provides for the Borrower's option to convert from an adjustable interest rate with interest rate limits to a fixed interest rate, as follows:

8. FIXED INTEREST RATE CONVERSION OPTION

(A) Option to Convert to Fixed Rate

I have a Conversion Option which I can exercise unless I am in default or this Section 5(A) will not permit me to do so. The "Conversion Option" is my option to convert the interest rate I am required to pay by this Note from an adjustable rate with interest rate limits to the fixed rate calculated under Section 5(B) below.

If this required net yield senset be determined because the applicable commitments are not available, the Note Holder will determine my interest rate by using comparable information. My new rate calculated under this Section 5(B) will not be greater than the Maximum Rate stated in Section 4(D) above.

(C) New Payment Amount and Effective Date

If I choose to exercise the Conversion Option, the Note Holder will determine the among of the monthly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal i am expected to owe on the Conversion Date in full on the Maturity Date at my new fixed interest rate in substantially equal payments. The recult of this calculation will be the new amount of my monthly payment. Beginning with my first monthly payment after the Conversion Date, I will pay the new amount as my monthly payment until the maturity date.

C. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWER

1. Until Borrower exercises the Conversion Option under the conditions stated in Section B of this Adjustable Rate Rider, Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:

Lender also may require the transferee to sign an assumption agreement must is acceptable to Lender and that obligates the transferee to keep all the promises and agreements mude in the Note and in this Security Instrument. Borrower will continue to be obligated under

the Note and this Socurity Instrument unless Lender releases Corrower in writing.

If Lender exercises the option to require immediate payment in full, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or malled within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower falls to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

2. If Borrower exercises the Conversion Option under the conditions stated in Section B of this Adjustable Rate Rider, the amendment to Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument contained in Section C 1 above shall then cease to be in effect, and the provisions of Uniform Covenant 17 of the Security

Instrument shall instead be in effect, as rollows:
