AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A \$3988 \$ BJ #-96-758448
PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT COOK COUNTY RECORDER
AND GRANTING A VARIATION

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Arlington Heights has hereviore passed and approved Ordinance Number 89-007 approving a final planned unit development for the property located at 800 West Oakton Street, Arlington Heights, Illinois, on which property is located the Lutheran Home & Services for the Aged; and

to allow the construction of a new 100-unit senior living facility, child and adult day care facilities, and a 4,700 square foot addition to the kitchen, in substantial comptiance with the Grading Pian dated April 9, 1996 with revisions through May 17, 1996, consisting of sheet C1; the Utility Pian dated April 9, 1996 with revisions through Bay 17, 1996, consisting of Sheet C2; Topographic Survey dated April 9, 1996 with revisions through May 17, 1996 consisting of Sheet C3; Site Pian dated July 11, 1996 with revisions through July 18, 1996, consisting of Sheet A0-02; Vicinity Site Pian, dated Pebruary 1, 1988 with revisions through July 18, 1996, consisting of sheet A0-02A; Tree Preservation Pian, dated July 18, 1996, consisting of sheet L1; Tree Preservation Schedule, dated July 18, 1996, consisting of sheet L1. A; Landscape Pian, dated May 21, 1996, consisting of sheets L2, L3 and L4; all of which were prepared by BRW Filness Architects, Inc., copies of which are on file with the Village Clerk and available for public inspection

SECTION TWO: That a variation from Chapter 28, Section 11.4, Schedule of Perking Requirements, is hereby granted to allow a reduction in the minimum number of parking spaces.

SECTION TARRE: That the approval of the amendment to the planted unit development and variation are subject to the following conditions, to which the petitioner has agreed:

- 1. The acreening that was to be provided along Ridge Avenue (the cast side of the property) when the future parking lot is developed shall instead be done at this time.
- 2. Deliveries shall be limited to workdays, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- 3. If, upon the determination of Village staff, on-site parking becomes a problem, the petitioner shall be required to construct land banked parking spaces on the east side of the property within 90 days of notification.
- 4. The layout and location of the annual outdoor festivals and activities held by the petitioner shall be in substantial conformance with the 1996 Fall Festival plant in which the festivities are to be located on the south side of the Olson Pavilion stretching to the west end of the property.
- 5. The development shall comply with all applicable ordinances, policies and regulations of the Village of Arlington Heights.

SECTION FOUR: Except as amended by this ordinance, the provisions of Ordinance Numbers 71-104, 76-021, 79-011, 88-093 and 89-007, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FIVE: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law and shall be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Cook County, Illinois.
