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- (i) Tax matters. The agent is authorized to: sign, verify and file all the principal's laderal, state and local income, gifter create, properly and other tax returns, including joint returns and declarations of estimated tax; pay all taxes; claim, sue for and receive all tax refunds; examine and copy all the principal's tax returns and records; represent the principal before any federal, state or local revenue agency or taxing body and sign and deliver all tax powers of acturney on behalf of the principal that may be necessary for such purposes; waive rights and sign all documents on behalf of the principal as required to settle, pay and determine all tax liabilities; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to tax matters which the principal could if present and under no disability.

Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property. This Section defines each entegory of powers listed in the statutory short form power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an spent. When the title of any of the following entegories is retained (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with tempert to the types of property and transpections covered by the retained extegory, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of property or transaction covered by the granted power at the time of exercise, whether the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or contractual, as a joint tenant or tenant in common or held in any other form; had the agent will not have power under any of the statutory entegories (a) through (b) to make gifts of the principal's property, to exercise powers to appoint to others or to change any beneficiary whom the principal has designated to take the principal's interests ar death under any will, crust, joint tenancy, beneficiary form or contractual arrangement. - (6) Stock and bond transactions.
