THIS INDENTURE made October 16, 19 96, between American National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago a corporation organized under the laws of Illinois, not personally, but as trustee u/t/a dtd 10/15/96 and known as Trust No. 122201-09, herein referred to as "Mortgagor," and CHICAGO TITLE AND TRUST COMPANY, an Illinois corporation doing business in Chicago, Illinois, herein referred to as "Trustee", witnesseth:

THAT, WHEREAS the Mortgagor is justly indebted to the legal holder of the Installment Note hereinafter described, said legal holder from time to time being herein referred to as the Holder of the Note, in the principal sum of

One Million Five Hundred and Seventy-Nine Thousand and 00/100-----Dollars, evidenced by one certain Installment Note of the Mortgagor of even date herewith, made payable to THE ORDER OF BEARER

and delivered, herein referred to as the "Note," in and by which the Mortgagor promises to pay the said principal sum and interest on the balance of principal remaining from time to time unpaid in accordance with the rate of interest and other terms and conditions as set forth in the Note until the Note is fully paid except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the 1st day of November 2016

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagor to secure the payment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, including interest thereon and any refinancing, extension, renewal or modification thereof, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained by the Mortgagor to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents GRANT, REMISE, RELEASE, ALIEN and CONVEY unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate and all of its estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the City of Chicago, COUNTY OF COOK AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

4. In case of default in payment, Trustee or the Holder of the Note may, but not need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinafter required of Mortgagor in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest or prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim in whole, or redeem from any sale or forfeiture affecting premises or fixtures or other property held by Mortgagor in any manner, or any tax or assessment, All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all

3. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss of damage by fire, lightning or windstorm (and flood damage), where the Holder of the Note is required by law to have such insurance) under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of monies sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Holder of the Note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to trustee for the benefit of the Holder of the Note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy and shall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to the Holder of the Note, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the expiration.

2. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, special assess-
ments, water service charges, and shall pay medical taxes, special assess-
ments, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to Holder of the Note duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent defraudation
of creditors, Trustee or Holder of the Note shall have the right to require payment of taxes and other charges by the mortgagor in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which mortgagee may desire to contest.

1. Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild, any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanics' or other liens or claims for labor not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (e) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (f) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal order;

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises, and the property, rights and interests pledged and assigned in the preceding paragraph, unto the said Trustee, his successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes, and upon the uses and tenures herein set forth.

AND GUTHIER, as additional security for said payment and performance. Mortgagor does hereby pledge and assign to the trustee from and after the date hereof (including without limitation any period of redemption), all rents, issues, profits, proceeds, profits, revenues, royalties, bonuses, rights and benefits of the promises or any party with the promises and not secondary, (a) all rents, issues, profits, proceeds and profits of the promises or any party with the promises and not secondary, (b) all amounts payable to a closing (including without limitation all deposits of money as advance rent, for all "Leases and easements", which term shall herein mean collectively any and all present and future leases, easements, licences, franchises), and other material contracts (including without limitation contracts for the sale of all or any part of the premises) and other agreements relating to the ownership, use or occupancy of all or any part of the premises; (c) all amounts payable in lieu of or as compensation for any loss or destruction of or damage to all or any part of the premises; (d) all amounts payable in lieu of or as compensation for any hazard or casualty insurance premiums or any right, title, interest or value retained therefor.

TOGETHER with all improvements, items, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all rights, issues and profits therefrom so long and during all such times as Mortgagor may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and all apparatus, equipment or articles heretofore or hereinafter delivered to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled) and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing) window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, underbeds, awnings, stoves and water heaters, fireplaces, equipment or articles heretofore placed in the premises by the Mortgagor or its successors or assigns shall be considered as constituting part of the real estate.

expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Trustee or the Holder of the Note to protect the premises and the lien hereof plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter.

Concerning which action herein authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at a rate equivalent to the rate applicable from time to time under the Note. Inaction of Trustee or the Holder of the Note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the part of Mortgagor.

5. The Trustee or the Holder of the Note making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

6. Mortgagor shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both principal and interest, when due according to the terms thereof. At the option of the Holder of the Note, and without notice to Mortgagor, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the Note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the Note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagor herein contained.

7. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, the Holder of the Note or Trustee may, at its option and to the extent permitted by applicable law, (a) institute proceedings for the complete foreclosure of the lien hereof, (b) institute proceedings in equity or at law for the specific performance of any covenant, agreement or condition herein or in aid of the execution of any power granted herein, (c) enter upon and take and maintain possession of all or any part of the premises and all documents, books, records, papers and accounts of Mortgagor or the then manager of the premises relating thereto, exclude Mortgagor and its beneficiaries, agents and servants wholly therefrom and possess, operate, manage and control the premises or any part thereof and conduct any business thereon, with full power to (i) collect all rents, issues and profits from the premises, (ii) take such action, legal or equitable, as may, in Trustee's or the Holder of the Note's discretion, be necessary or desirable to protect or enforce the payment of the rents, issues and profits from the premises, including without limitation instituting actions for recovery of rent, actions in forcible detainer and actions in distress for rent, (iii) cancel or terminate any tenancy, lease or sublease for any cause or reason which would entitle Mortgagor or the Lessor to cancel such tenancy, lease or sublease, (iv) elect to disaffirm any tenancy, lease or sublease made subject hereto or which is or becomes subordinate to the lien hereof, (v) extend or modify any lease or tenancy and make new leases, which extensions, modifications and new leases may provide for terms or options for terms to expire beyond the maturity date of all obligations secured hereby, it being understood and agreed that any such leases and the options and other provisions contained therein shall be binding upon Mortgagor, upon all persons whose interests in the premises are subject to the lien of this Mortgage and upon any purchaser or purchasers at any foreclosure sale, notwithstanding any redemption from sale, discharge of the indebtedness secured hereby, satisfaction of any foreclosure decree or issuance of any certificate of sale or deed to any purchaser or purchasers at any foreclosure sale, (vi) make any repairs, decorations, renewals, replacements, alterations, additions and improvements to the premises as Trustee or the Holder of the Note may deem reasonably necessary or desirable, (vii) insure and reinsure the premises and any risks incident to the possession, operation, management and control of the premises by Trustee or the Holder of the Note, and (viii) take such other action for the possession, operation, management and control of the premises as Trustee or the Holder of the Note may deem necessary or appropriate, and/or (d) take such other action as may be permitted by applicable law. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or the Holder of the Note for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or the Holder of the Note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at a rate equivalent to the rate applicable from time to time under the Note, when paid or incurred by Trustee or the Holder of the Note in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this Trust Deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.

8. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute

16. Before releasing this Trust Deed, Trustee or its successor shall receive for its services a fee as determined by its rate schedule in effect when the release deed is issued. Trustee or its successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for any other act or service performed under any provisions of this Trust Deed. The provisions of the "Trust And Trustees Act" of the State of Illinois shall be applicable to this Trust Deed.

17. If all or any part of the premises or any interest therein, including, but not limited to, a beneficial interest in a land trust which holds title to the premises or any part thereof, is sold or transferred by Mortagor without the prior written consent of the Holder of the Note, excluding (a) the creation of a lien or encumbrance subordinate to this Trust Deed; (b) a transfer by devise, descent or by operation of law upon the death of a joint tenant; or (c) the grant of any leasehold interest of three years or less not containing an option to purchase, the Holder of the Note may, at its option, declare all sums secured by and due under the Note and this Trust Deed to be immediately due and payable. Execution of Articles of Agreement for Deed or an Installment Contract shall also be considered a sale or transfer for purposes of this paragraph.

18. All of the terms and provisions of the certain loan commitment, (as stated in the offer of The South Shore Bank of Chicago) dated September 30, 1996 addressed to and accepted by Arthur and Frances Smith as are not herein set forth and as are relevant and germane hereto and the loan secured by this Trust Deed, are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof as though fully set forth and recited herein to the extent they are not inconsistent with any provisions of this Trust Deed.

19. Additional Payment due hereunder: In addition to each monthly payment of principal and interest under the Note, there shall be due and payable hereunder, and paid, monthly deposits of funds equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of the then last ascertained bill for general taxes on the premises, and such funds so paid shall be held by the Holder of the Note and used by said Holder to pay general taxes from time to time levied and due upon the premises. No interest shall accrue or become due upon any funds so deposited.

20. Mortagor acknowledges that the proceeds of the Note shall be used for the purposes specified in Section 6404 (4) (1) (e) of Chapter 17 of the Illinois Revised Statutes; and that the principal obligation secured hereby constitutes a business loan within the purview and operation of said section.

21. Mortagor hereby waives any and all rights of redemption from sale under any order or decree of foreclosure of this Trust Deed, on its own behalf and on behalf of each and every person, except decree or judgement creditors of Mortagor, acquiring any interest in or title to the premises subsequent to the date of this Trust Deed.

22. Mortagor shall not, without the prior written consent of the Holder of the Note, (i) make any other pledge or collateral assignment of any Leases and Agreements or of any rents or other rights thereunder, or (ii) accept any installment of rent more than thirty (30) days before the due date of any such installment.


