Section 3-4 of the Illinois Statutury Short Form Power of Attorney for Proper vicaw

Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property. This Section defines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the inflawing categories is retained (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with capent to the types of property and transactions cavered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of property or transaction, covernd by the granted power at the time of exercise, whether the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or contractual, as a joint tent or fenant in common or held in any other form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory categories (a) through (a) to make gifts of the principal's property, in enercise powers to appoint to others or to change any beneficiary whom the principal has designated to take the principal's interests at death under any will, trust, joint returney, beneficiary form or contractual arrangement. The agent will be under no duty to exercise granted powers or to assume control of or responsibility for the principal's property or affairs; but when granted powers are exercised, the agent will be required to use due care to act for the benefit of the principal in accordance with the terms of the subjutory property power and will be liable for negligent exercise. - (a) Real estate transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy, self, exchange, rent and lease real estate (which term includes, without limitation, real estate subject to a land trust and all beneficial interests in and powers of direction under any land trust); collect all rent, sale proceeds and earnings from real estate; convey, assign and accept title to real estate; grant easements, create conditions and release rights of homestead with respect to real estate; create land trusts and exercise all powers under land trusts; hold, possess, maintain, repair, improve, subdivide, irranage, operate and insure real estate; pay, contest, profest and compromise real estate taxes and assessments; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to real estate which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (b) Financial institution transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, close, continue and control off accounts and deposits in any type of financial institution (which term includes, without limitation, banks, trust companies, savings and building and loan associations, credit unions and brokerage firms); deposit in and withdraw from and write checks on anythrancial institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (c) Stock and bond transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bonds, mutual funds and all other types of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and safekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, certificates and other evidences of ownership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by proxy, enter into voting trusts and consent to limitations on the right to vote; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.

- (d) Tangible personal property transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell, lease, exchange, cullect, possess and take title to all tangible personal property; move, stare, ship, restore, maintain, repair, improve, property is sue and infektep tangible cursonal property; and in general, exercise all powers with respect to tangible personal property which the principal sould if pless fit and under our disability.
- (e) Safe deposit bax transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, continue and have occess to all safe deposit baxes; sign, ranew, release or terminate any safe deposit contract; drill or surrender any safe deposit box; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to safe deposit matters which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (1) Insurance and annulty transactions.
