THIS SECURITY INSTRUMENT combines uniform coverants for national use and non-uniform coverants with limited variations by jurisdiction to constitute a security instrument covering real property.

UNIFORM COVENANTS. Butto in and Lender covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. Payment of Principal and Interest, Propayment and Late Charges. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment and late charges due under the Note.
- 2. Application of Payments. Unless applicable law provides otherwise, all payment received by Lender under paragraph. I shall be applied; first, to accrued interest; second, to past due insurance; third, to current billed insurance; fourth to past due principal; fifth, to current billed rincipal; sixth, to charges; seventh, to principal due; and last; to eccrued out unbilled insurance.
- 3. Chargest Liens. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, tharges, fires and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, and leasehold payments or ground reads, if any. Borrower shall pay them on time directly to the person owed payment. Upon Lender's request, Regenver shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of smounts to be paid under this rangement and shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing the payments.

Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien which has priority over this Security Instrument except for the Prior Mortgage unless Borrower: (a) agrees in writing to the payment of the obligation recured by the lien in a manner acceptable to Lender; (b) contests in good faith the lien by, or defends against enforcement of the lien in legal proceedings which in the Lender's opinion operate to prevent the enforcement of the lien or terfeiture of any part of the Property; or (c) secures from the holder of the lien an agreement satisfactory to Lender mine dinating the lien to this Security Instrument. 4. Hazard Insurance. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter exceed on the Property insured against loss by fire, heards included within the term "extended coverage" and any other hazards, including floods or flooding, for which Lender requires insurance. Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged, if the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lender's security is not lessened. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's security would be lessened, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. If Borrower abandons the Property, or does not answer within 30 days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claim, then Lender may collect the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property of to pay sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The 30-day period will begin when the notice is given.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraph 1 or change the amount of the payments. - 5. Preservation and Maintenance of Property: Borrower's Application; Leaseholds. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or abstantially change the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate or commit waste. - 10. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. The coverants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Leader and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 16. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be juint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the property under the terms of this Security Instrument, (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Leader and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any according taking with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's sonsent.
- 13. Long Charges. If m loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finally recepted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any much loan charge shall be reclased by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Autower which exceeded permitted limits will—chanded to Borrower. Leader may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.
- 12. Legislation Affering Lender's Right. If ensemble or expiration of applicable laws has the affect of rendering any provision of the Note or this Security instrument unonforceable according to its terms. Lender, at its option, may require immediate payment in full of all sums accured by this Security Instrument and may invoke any rensedies pennitted by paragraph 20. If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall take the steps specified in the second paragraph of paragraph 16.
- 13. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of nother method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Londer shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by matice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be diemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- id. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable taw, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.
- 15. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.
- 16. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural purson) without Londor's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all some secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give florrower notice of acceleration. 17. Borrover's Right to Reinstate. If Borrower meets certain conditions, Borrower shall have the right to have enforcement of this Security instrument discontinued at any time prior to the earlier of: (a) 5 days (or such other period as applicable law may specify for reinstatement) before sale of the Property pursuant to any power of sale contained in this Security Instrument; or (b) entry of a judgment enforcing this Security Instrument. Those conditions are that Borrower: (a) pays Lender all sums which then would be due under this Security Instrument and the Note had no acceleration occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees; and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to ascure that the lien of this Security Instrument, Lender's rights in the Property and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall continue unchanged. Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations secured bereby shall remain fully effective as is no acceleration had occurred. However, this right to reinstate shall not apply in the case of acceleration under paragraphs 12 or 16.

18. Hazardous Substances. Borrower shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storage, or release of any Hazardous Substances on or in the Property.
