

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11. Borrower Not Released By Lender Not in Writing. Extension of the time of payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower's successor in interest. Lender shall not be required to file a notice of non-payment or default with the appropriate state or federal authority if the original Borrower's successor in interest has failed to make timely payments.

10. Reinstatement. Borrower has a right to be reinstated if Lender has received immediate payment because of
Borrower's failure to pay an amount due under the Note or this Security Instrument. This right applies even after foreclosure
proceedings are instituted. To reinstate the Security Instrument, Borrower shall render in a lump sum all amounts required to

(e) **Automatic Rent Increase.** Borrower agrees that should this Security Instrument and the Note become payable not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act within 60 days from the date hereof, Lender may, at his option and without demand and notice, increase the monthly payment by 1% per annum.

(d) **Regulations of HED Secretaries.** In many circumstances regulations issued by the Secretary will limit Lender's rights in the case of payment defaults to require immediate payment in full and foreclose if not paid. This Securitization does not authorize acceleration or foreclosure if not permitted by regulations of the Secretary.

14. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.

15. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of this Security Instrument.

16. Assignment of Rents. Borrower unconditionally assigns and transfers to Lender all the rents and revenues of the Property. Borrower authorizes Lender or Lender's agents to collect the rents and revenues and hereby directs each tenant of the Property to pay the rents to Lender or Lender's agents. 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

ADJUSTABLE RATE RIDER

THIS ADJUSTABLE RATE RIDER is made this **23RD** day of **FEBRUARY**, 1996, and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Security Deed ("Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned ("Borrower") to secure Borrower's Note ("Note") to **CARLTON MORTGAGE SERVICES, INC.**

(the "Lender") of the same date and covering the property described in the Security Instrument and located at:

THE NOTE CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE AND THE MONTHLY PAYMENT. THE NOTE LIMITS THE AMOUNT THE BORROWER'S INTEREST RATE CAN CHANGE AT ANY ONE TIME AND THE MAXIMUM RATE THE BORROWER MUST PAY.

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

(A) Change Date

The interest rate may change on the first day of **JULY 1**, 1997, and on that day of each succeeding year. "Change Date" means each date on which the interest rate could change.

(B) The Index

Beginning with the first Change Date, the interest rate will be based on an Index. "Index" means the weekly average yield on United States Treasury Securities adjusted to a constant maturity of one year, as made available by the Federal Reserve Board. "Current Index" means the most recent Index figure available 30 days before the Change Date. If the Index (as defined above) is no longer available, Lender will use as a new Index any index prescribed by the Secretary. As used in this Rider, "Secretary" means the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development or his or her designee. Lender will give Borrower notice of the new Index.

(C) Calculation of Interest Rate Changes

Before each Change Date, Lender will calculate a new interest rate by adding a margin of **TWO AND THREE FOURTHS** percentage point(s) (**2.750 %**) to the Current Index and rounding the sum to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). Subject to the limits stated in paragraph (D) of this Rider, this rounded amount will be the new interest rate until the next Change Date.

(D) Limits on Interest Rate Changes

The interest rate will never increase or decrease by more than one percentage point (1.0%) on any single Change Date. The interest rate will never be more than five percentage points (5.0%) higher or lower than the initial interest rate.

A new interest rate calculated in accordance with paragraphs (C) and (D) of this Rider will become effective on the Change Date. Borrower shall make a payment in the new monthly amount beginning on the first payment date which occurs at least 25 days after Lender has given Borrower the notice of changes required by paragraph (F) of this Rider. Borrower shall have no obligation to pay any increase in the monthly payment amount (F) of this Rider. Borrower has agreed to pay any increase in the monthly payment amount (F) of this Rider for any payment date occurring less than 25 days after Lender has given the required notice. If the monthly payment amount calculated in accordance with paragraph (E) of this Rider decreased, but Lender failed to give timely notice of the decrease and Borrower made any monthly payment amounts exceeding the payment amount which should have been stated in a timely notice, then Borrower shall demand the option to either (1) demand the return of any excess payment, with interest accrued thereon at the rate equal to the interest rate which should have been stated in a timely notice, or (ii) request that the Note be paid in full with interest accrued thereon at the rate equal to the interest rate which should have been stated in a timely notice, or (iii) request that the Note be paid in full with interest accrued thereon at the rate equal to the interest rate which should have been stated in a timely notice, even if the Note is otherwise assignable before return of payment.

(G) Effective Date of Changes

Lender will give notice to Borrower of any change in the interest rate and monthly payment amount. The notice must be given at least 25 days before the new monthly payment amount is due, and must set forth (i) the date of the notice, (ii) the Change Date, (iii) the old interest rate, (iv) the new interest rate, (v) the new monthly payment amount, (vi) the current index and the date it was published, (vii) the method of calculating the charge in monthly payment, and (viii) any other information which may be required by law from time to time.

(D) Notice of Changes

If the interest rate changes on a Change Date, Lender will calculate the amount of monthly payment of principal and interest which would be necessary to repay the unpaid principal balance in full at the maturity date of the note through substantially equal payments. In making such calculation, Lender will use the new interest rate through the date of the Change Date if there had been no default in payment of unpaid principal which would be owed on the Change Date. The result of this calculation will be the amount of principal and interest.
