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On or about December 29, 1994, the Village of Ford Heights filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County a suit to abate the nuisance on the above-described real estate, being case number 94M6-6898, and thereafter, on the 30th day of June, 1995, the Honorable Patrick J. Grossi, one of the Judges of the Circuit Court of Cook County, did enter a Decree authorizing the directing the Claimant herein to demolish the buildings and clean up the premises situated upon the above-described real estate. Chapter 24 of the Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 11-31-1, as amended, authorizes reimbursement for costs spent in the demolition of said buildings, and thereafter the Village of Ford Heights did secure the demolition of said structures and the clean-up of said premises on or about the 25th day of September, 1995, and the Village of Ford Heights, in securing the demolition of said buildings, did cause to be furnished labor and materials pursuant to a contract.

The said owner is entitled to no credits on account thereof and there is unpaid and owing to the Claimant, the Village of Ford Heights, on account thereof, the sum of SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO AND 51/100 DOLLARS (\$6,652.51), for which, with interest at the statutory rate, the Claimant claims a lien on said land.
