Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short farm power of attorney for property. This 5 cross defines each category of power shisted in the statutory short farm power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the inflowing categories is retained and struck outly in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with capent to the types of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the (granted powers that appear on the face of the form.
