14. INSURANCE. Grantor shall keep the Property Insured for its full value against all hazards including loss or damage caused by fire, collision, their, flood (if applicable) or other casualty. Grantor may obtain insurance on the Property from such companies as are acceptable to Lender in its sole discretion. The insurance policies shall require the insurance company to provide Lender with at least thirty (30) days' written notice before such policies are altered or cancelled in any manner. Grantor shall not initiate or consent to any change in the zoning provisions or private covenants affecting the use of the Property without Lender's prior written consent. If Grantor's use of the Property becomes a nonconforming use under any zoning provision, Grantor shall not cause or permit such use to be discontinued or a paragoned without the prior written consent of Lender. 16. CONDEMNATION. Brantor shall immediately provide Lender with written notice of any actual or threatened condemnation or eminent description proceeding pertaining to the Property. Grantor shall immediately provide Lender and its shall holders, directors, officers, employees and agents with written notice of and Indemnify and hold Lender harmless from all claims, damages, liabilities (including attorneys' fees and ingol expenses), causes of action, actions, suits and other legal proceedings (cumulatively "Claims") pertaining to the Emperty (including, but not limited to, those involving Hazardous Materials). (a) fails to pay any Obligation to Lender when due; (b) fails to perform any Obligation or breaches any warranty or covenant to Lender contained in this Mortgage or any other present or future, written or oral, agreement;

(c) allows the Property to be damaged, destroyed, lost or stolen in any material respect; (d) seeks to revoke, terminate or otherwise limit its liability under any guaranty to Lender;

(e) allow goods to be used on, transported or stored on the Property, the possession, transportation, or use of which, is illegal; or
