2. REPRESENTATIONS, WARRANTIES AND COVENANTS. Mortgagor represents, warrants and covenants to Lender

Mortgago shall bear the entire fisk of any toss, trieft, destruction or damage (cumulatively "Loss or Damage") to the Property or any portion thereof from any cause whatsoever.
