If Borrower abandons the Property, or does not answer within 30 days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claun, then Lender may collect the incurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums record by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The 30-day period will begin when the notice is given

Unless Lander and Borrowe, wherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or prospers the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of the payments. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall be in default if any fortesture action of proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's go a faith judgment could result in forteiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien created by this Security Instrumery of Lender's security interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to ex end time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.
- 12. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Porrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. An Porrower who co signs the Norway Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and conversions Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the same secured by this Security Instrument; and (e) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that borrower's consent.
- If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets in aimum loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in covacction with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.
- 14. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- 15. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to hora with a so be severable.

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16. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument

Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations secured hereby shall remain fully effective as it no acceleration had occurred. However, this right to reinstate shall not apply in the case of acceleration under paragraph 17.

19. Sale of Note; Change of Loan Scryler. The Note or a partial interest in the Note (together with this Security Instrument) may be sold one or more times without prior notice to Borrower. The notice shall specify: (a) the default; (b) the action required to cure the default; (c) a date, not less than 30 days from the date the notice is given to Borrower, by which the default must be cured; and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Security Instrument, foreclosure by judicial proceeding and sale of the Property. The notice shall further inform Borrower of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in the foreclosure proceeding the non-existence of a default or any other defense of Borrower to acceleration and foreclosure. If the default is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice, Lender, at its option, may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument without further demand and may foreclose this Security Instrument by judicial proceeding. Lender shall be entitled to collect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this paragraph 21, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of title evidence.
