AM ORDINANCE PROPOSING THE RETABLISHING TO 001 1997-09-15 13:39:15 SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER FOUR IN THE CITY of DES PLAINES. IL. (WOODLAND TOWNHOUSE AREA), Recorder

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Plaines, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

BECTION 1: That pursuant to Section 7 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and 35 ILCS 235/1 et seq., of the Illinois Compiled Statutes (1992), the City of Des Plaines hereby proposes the establishment of a special service area to be der grated as "Special Service Area Number Four", being a contiguous area within the city, more particularly described as follows:

> and 5 in Block 17 (Slocus Block) in Park Addition to Des Plaines, being a part of the North 1/2 of Sections 16 and 17, Township 41 North Range 12, East of the Third Principal Merician, in Cook County, Illinois, (Recorded September 21, 1872, Doc. No. 57452)

SECTION 2: A public hearing shall be held on April 17, 1995, at 7:00 p.m., in the less Plaines Civic Center Council Chambers, 1420 Miner Street, in the city of Des Plaines (being the time and place of a scheduled meeting of the City Council of the City of Des Plaines) to consider the establishment of Special Service Area Number Four.

The special services to be provided within Special Service Area Number Four shall be the construction of others sewers and funding of the residents' share of the costs related thereto. At the hearing there will also be considered a proposal for the imposition and levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to produce revenues to provide such special services within the Special Service Area, which annual tax shall be levied against all taxable property in Special Service Area Number Four, at a rate not to exceed 100% of the value of such taxable property based on assessed value as equalized pursuant to the Revenue Act of 1939. Said levy shall be for tax levy years 1995 through 2009, inclusive, and shall

be in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00 annually.

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shall be given by epociting and notice in the United States mail addressed to the person or persons in whose name the last general taxes for the preceding year were paid on each lot, block, tract or parcel of land lying within the proposed Special Service Area number Four. Said notice shall be mailed not less than 10 days prior to the date set for the public hearing. In the event taxes for the last preceding year were not paid, the notice shall be sent to the person last listed on the tax rolls prior to that year as the owner of said property. The City Clerk shall provide for the publication and mailing of the notice, which shall be in the following form:

The purpose of the public hearing is to consider the establishment of Special Service Area Number Four. The special services to be provided within Special Service Area Number Four shall be the construction of Storm Sewers and funding of the residents' share of the costs related thereto. At the hearing there will also be considered a proposal for the imposition and levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to produce revenues to provide such special services within Special Service Area Number Four, which annual tax shall be levied against all taxable property in Special Service Area Number Four, at a rate not to exceed 100% of the value of such taxable property based on assessed value as equalized pursuant to the Revenue Act of 1939. Said levy shall be for tax levy years 1995 through 2009, inclusive, and shall be in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00 annually.

All interested persons, including all persons owning taxable real property located within the proposed special Service Area Number Four, will be given an opportunity to be heard at the public hearing regarding the establishment of Special Service Area Number Four and the

imposition of the tax levy, all as described above, and an opportunity to file objections to the establishment of Special Service and the abount of such tax levy.

The hearing may be adjourned by the City Council to another date without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes of its meeting fixing the time and place of its adjournment.

If a petition signed by at least 51% of the electors residing within Special Service Area Number Four and by at least 51% of the owners of record of the land included within the boundaries of Special Service Area Number Four is filed with the City Clerk within 60 days following the final adjournment of the public hearing objecting to the creation of Special Service Area Number Four or the levy on imposition of taxes and the amount thereof for the provisions of special services in said Special Service Area Number Four, no such Special Service Area Number Four may be created or tax may be levied or imposed.

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




