Amendments to Willow Hill Condominium Association By-Laws

- Voting rights of any unit owner shall be revoked if the association monthly dues, as determined by the board of managers, is three or more months in arrears.
 Voting rights will be reinstated when an owner resumes a current status with the dues.
- II. A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to each unit owner(s) who fails to pay a monthly assessment prior to the 15th of the month in which it is due. For example, all nonthly association assessments are due on or before the fifth of each month. A cen day grace period will be provided before the late fee is charged. This charge will then become an obligation to pay by that certain unit member (who is in arrears) and the Willow Hill Condominium Association reserves all rights and remedies associated with the collection of these dues as it would assume for all other assessments.
- III. If a pet owner violates any of the Village of Northfield (chapter 17) ordinances, that certain owner will be subject to the law enforcement deemed necessary by the Village of Northfield Police Department. However, the Willow Hill Condominium Association reserves the right of establish its own lawful remedies to the control of animals and fowl, which are cared for, or may be deemed pets of any association member or resident. If a pet, owner or caretaker of a pet violates any of the Village of Northfield Ordinance Chapter 17, regarding regulations of animals and fowl in any individual unit or common area of Willow Hill Condominium Association, the offense should be:
 - (1). Immediately reported to a condc association board member and sworn to by at least two neighbors.
 - (2). The board member receiving the statement, will then be authorized to issue a \$25 fine for the first reported instance. The fine will be due immediately and will then become an obligation to pay by that certain unit member (who is in violation of this amendment). The Willow Hill Condominium Association reserves all rights and remedies associated with the collection of these fires as it would assume for all other assessments.
 - (3). The second offense, to be reported in the same manner, will result in a fifty dollar(\$50) fine.
 - (4). A third offense will result in an order of removal of the pet within thirty(30) days from the date of any such notification.
