GRANT OF MORTGAGE. Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Renta from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINATIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not atherates defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

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Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving line of credit agreement dated October 2, 1997, between Lender and Grantor with a credit limit of \$17,000.00, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The maturity date of this Mortgage is October 2, 2004. The interest rate under the Credit Agreement is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 8.500% per annum. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate 1.000 percentage points above the index, subject however to the following maximum rate. Under no circumstances shall the interest rate be more than the leaser of 21.000% per annum or the maximum rate allowed by applicable law.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means RICHARD M. YOO and ANN M. YOO. The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage.

Maintenance of treatrance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard undended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for faiture to give such notice. EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Gramor marrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mixtgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and

At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be field, recorded, reflied, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such medicales, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Credit Agreement, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by law or acred to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Alterney-in-Fact. If Grantor tails to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph, Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby inevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, things, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, terminates the credit line account, and charmise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage. Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a subside satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's accurity interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will pay, if parallied by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time. If however, payment is made by Grantor, whether voluntarily or otherwise, or by guarantor or by any third party, on the Indebtedness and thereafter Lender is forced to remit the amount of that payment (a) to Grantor's trustee in bankruptcy or to any similar person under any federal or state bankruptcy law or law for the relief of debtors, (b) by russion of any judgment, decree or order of any court or administrative body having jurisdiction over Lender or any of Lender's property, or (c) by reason of any settlement or compromise of any claim made by Lender with any

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cleimant (including without limitation Grantor), the indebtedness shall be considered unpaid for the purpose of enforcement of this Mortgage and this Mortgage shall continue to be effective or shall be reinstated, as the case may be, notwithstanding any cancellation of this Mortgage or of any note or other instrument or agreement evidencing the indebtedness and the Property will continue to secure the amount repaid or recovered to the same extent as if that amount never had been originally received by Lender, and Grantor shall be bound by any judgment, decree, order, settlement or compromise relating to the indebtedness or to this Mortgage.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage: (a) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, sublities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral for the credit line account or Lander's rights in the collateral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or thouse of the dwelling, tailure to pay taxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or state of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling without Lender's permission, foreclosure by the holder of another lien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.

Lander, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other tights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtation in a Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire indebtedness in callately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be tequired to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Herds. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the indebtadorss. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payments thereof in the name of threater and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosing or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the apparent of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

Audicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency temaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the highis provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Credit Agreement or available at law or in equity.

Side of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property mirrahalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be free to (e) all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Metice of Sale. Lender shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Waiver: Election of Remedica. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after takers of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its tempetics under this Mortgage.

Allernays' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' tees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the antorcoment of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate provided for in the Credit Agreement. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's



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attorneys' tees and Lender's tegal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any articipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining trile reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, and appraisal fees, and title insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by

NOTICES TO GRANTON AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Mortgage, including without limitation any notice of detault and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing, may be sent by telefactimile (unless otherwise required by law), and shall be effective when actually delivered, or when deposited with a nationally recognized overnight courier, or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, apecifying that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of forestowner from the hodger of any lien which has priority over this Mortgage shall be sent to Lender's address, as afform near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

AGSOCIATION OF LINT OWNERS. The following provisions apply if the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership law or care law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of the Real Property:

Power of Atterney. Grantus grants an irrevocable power of attorney to Lender to vote in its discretion on any matter that may can be before the association of unit owners. Lender shall have the right to exercise this power of attorney only after datum by Grantor; however, Lender may decline to exercise this power as it sees fit.

Insurance. No alteration of or amendment to this Mortgage shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lawer and accepted by Lender in the State of Missie. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of

Marger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this wortgage with any other interest or state in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Multiple Parties. All obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage shall be joint and Everal, and all references to Grantor shall mean each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Mortgage.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Buccessors and Aceigns. Naives of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the numerical exemption laws of the State of Minois as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

Walvara and Conseries. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Cocuments) unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise

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to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions.
