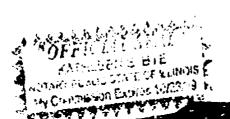

2. Definitions. In this accument, the following definitions apply.

"Barrawer": CHICAGO AS TRUSTEE # 4176 8/30/1977
will be called "Borrower".

"Lender": TCF Bank tilinois fab will be called "Lender". Lender is a federal savings bank which was formed and which exists under the laws of the United States of America. Lender's address for the purpose of receiveing notices and making payments is 1420 Kensigton, Suite 320, Oak Brook, IL 60521-2147.

"Agreement": The CommandCredit Plus Agreement signed by one or more Borrower and dated the same date as this Mortgage will be called the "Agreement". Under the Agreement, any Borrower signing the Agreement has a revolving line of credit called the "Account". The Agreement allows Borrower to obtain Loan Advances from the Account, make payments, and obtain readvances. Under the Agreement, Borrower may request Loan Advances from the Lender at any time until the final due date, shown in section 3 below.

Property": The property that is described in section 5 is called the "Property".

3. Final Due Listi. The scheduled date for final payment of what Borrower owes under the Agreement is

Variable Annual Percentage Rate. The Annual Percentage Rate is the cost of Borrower's credit as a yearly rate. The Annual Percentage Title Lender uses to figure Finance Charges will go up and down, based on the highest U.S. prime rate published daily in Fig. Wall Street Journal under "Money Rates" (the "Index"). The index is not the lowest or hest rate offered by Lender of exter lenders. If the index becomes unavailable, Lender will select, to the extent permitted by applicable laws and regulations, some other interest rate index that is comparable to the index and notify Borrower. If the Arinual Percentage Rate goes up or down, the Dally Periodic Rate will also go up or down. To figure the ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE, we add 2.50 percentage points to the index rate in effect the previous business day. ("business day" does not include Saturday". Sundays and legal holidays.) On each business day we will recalculate the % ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE for this loan to that it is 2.49 (2.40 percentage points) above the index published the previous business day. If the infex rate changes, however, the ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE for this loan will change the next business day. The beginning ordex rate for this loan is 8.50 % per year. The beginning ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE for this loan is therefore 10.90 % per year, which is a Daily Periodic Rate of 1029098 %.

The maximum ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE is 19.00 %. The minimum ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE is 9.50

- 5. Description of the Property. Bossower gives Lender rights in the following Property:
 - a. The Land, which is located at (address)

- b. All buildings and all other improvements and fixtures (such as pidmbing and electrical equipment) that are now or will in the future be located on the Land.
- c. All "easements, rights, hereditaments, appurtenances, rents, royalties, and plofits" that go along the Land. These are rights in other property that Sorrower has as owner of the Land.

6. Notice of Variable Rate of Interest. This Mortgage secures a line of credit that has a lariable rate of interest. This means that the interest rate may increase or decrease from time to time, as explained in paragraph 4.

- 7. Finance Charge. Borrower will pay a Finance Charge until Borrower has repaid everything nived under the Agreement. Lender figures the Finance Charge at the end of every monthly billing cycle. The monthly billing cycle runs from and including the first day of a month to and including the last day of that month. To figure the Finance Charge for a monthly billing cycle. Lender adds up the Finance Charges for each day in the billing cycle. To figure the Finance Charge for each day, Lander multiplies the Daily Periodic Rate times the Daily Balance of Borrower's Account on that day ffor each day in the monthly billing cycle). Lender figures the Daily Periodic Rate by dividing the Annual Percentage Rate by 385 (or 366, in any leap year). Lender determines the Daily Balance by first taking the beginning balance of Borrower's Account each day, adding any new Loan Advances, and subtracting any payments or other credits to the Account, and subtracting any unpaid Finance Charges and Other Charges. Borrower pays & Finance Charge on Loan Advances beginning with the day they are made.
- 8. Transfer of Rights in the Property. Borrower mortgages, grants and conveys the Property to Lender subject to the terms of this Mortgage. This means that, by signing this Mortgage, Borrower is giving Lender those rights that are stated in this Mortgage and also those rights that the law gives to lenders who have taken mortgages on land. Borrower is giving Lender these rights to protect Lender from possible losses that might result if Borrower fails to keep the promises made in this Mortgage and in the Agreement.
- 9. Termination of the Mortgage. Lender's rights in the Property will end when the Agreement has been terminated and Borrower has paid all amounts owed to Lender under the Agreement and this Mortgage. Lender will send Borrower a document stating this and Borrower can file it with the County in which the Property is located.

- 10. Promises of Borrower Borrower represents and warrants that:
 - a. Borrower owns the Property:
 - b. Borrower has the right to mortgage, grant, and convey the Property to Lender; and
 - c. There are no cialms or charges outstanding against the Property except any mortgages that are currently shown in the office where real estate records are filed for the County where the Property is located.

Borrower gives a general warranty of title to Lender. This means that Borrower will be fully responsible for any losses which Lender suffers because someone other than Borrower has some of the rights in the Property that Borrower represents and warrants to have. Borrower will defend ownerable of the Property against any claims of such rights.

- 11. Borrower's Promise to Pay -- The Agreement. Borrower promises to promptly pay all amounts due on the Agreement except as explained in paragraph 18.
- 12. Borrower's Promise to Pay -- Charges and Assessment. Borrower promises to pay all present and future liens, taxes, assessments, utility bills, and other charges on the Property, including any amounts on any prior mortgage, as they become due-
- 13. Somewer's Promise to Buy Hazard Insurance. Borrower promises to obtain a hazard insurance policy naming Lender as mortgage, and which covers all buildings on the Property. The insurance must be satisfactory to Lender and must cover loss or damage caused by fire and hazards normally covered by "extended coverage" hazard insurance policies. The insurance must be in the amounts and for the periods of time required by Lender. Borrower will notify Lender promptly if there is any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may file a "Proof of Loss" form with the insurance company. Borrower directs the insurance company to pay all "proceeds" to Lender. "Proceeds" are any money that the insurance company, owes to the Borrower under the policy. Unless Lender agrees in writing that the Proceeds can be used differently, the Proceeds will be applied to pay the amount Borrower owas Lender.

If any Proceeds are used to reduce the amount which Borrower owes Lender under the Agreement, Borrower will still have to make the regular payments under the Agreement until the entire amount Borrower owes is paid in full.

If Lender forecloses this Mortgage, anyone who buys the Property at the foreclosure sale will have all the rights under the insurance policy.

- 14. Borrower's Promise to Buy Flood Insurance. If the Land or any part of the Land is located in a designated official flood-hazardous area, Borrower promises to buy flood insurance in the maximum amount available or the amount secured by this Mortgage, whichever is less. Borrower agrees to direct that any money payable under the flood insurance will be paid to Lender, but Borrower will still have to make regular payments under the Agreement until the entire amount Borrower owes is paid in full.
- 15. Borrower's Promise to Maintain the Property. Borrowler promises that Borrower won't damage or destroy the Property. Borrower also promises to keep the Property in good rapair. If any improvements are made to the Property, Borrower promises that they won't be removed from the Property.
- 16. Lender's Right to Take Action to Protect the Property. If (1) bor ower does not keep Borrower's promises and agreements made in this Mortgage, or (2) someone (Borrower or anyone else) begins a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as, for example, a legal proceeding in bankruptcy, or to condemn the Property), then Lender may do and pay for whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. Lender's actions under this section may include, for example, paying any amount due under any prior mortgage, appearing in court, paying reasonable actorneys' fees, and entering on the Property to make repairs.

Borrower promises to pay Lender all amounts that Lender pays under this section. If Lender pays an obligation, Lender will have all of the rights that the person Lender paid would have had against Borroviet. This Mortgage covers all these amounts that Lender pays, plus interest, at the rate that is figured as if the money had usen given under the Agreement, or if that rate violates the law, then at the highest rate that the law allows.

If Borrower fails to maintain insurance on the Property as required in paragraph 13, Lender may prochase insurance on the Property and charge Borrower for the cost as provided in this Mortgage. If Lender purchases this insurance, it will have the right to select the agent. Lender is not required to obtain the lowest cost insurance that might be available.

- 17. Lander's Rights. Any failure or delay by Lender in enforcing the rights that this Mortgage or the try give it, will not cause Lender to give up those rights. Lender may exercise and enforce any of its rights until its rights under the Mortgage end. Each right that this Mortgage gives to Lender is separate. Lender may enforce and exercise them one at a time or all at once.
- 18. Joint Borrowers. Each person that signs this Mortgage is responsible for keeping all of the promises made by "Borrower". Lender may choose to enforce its rights against anyone signing the Mortgage as an individual or against all of them. However, if someone signed this Mortgage, but did not sign the Agreement, then that person will not be required to pay any amount under the Agreement, but will have signed only to give Lender the rights that person has in the Property under the terms of this Mortgage.
- 19. Notices. Unless the law requires differently, or unless Borrower tells Lender differently, any notice that must be given to Borrower will be delivered or mailed to Borrower at the address shown in section 5. Notices that must be sent to Lender will be given by mailing them to Lender's address shown in section 2. Any notice will be "given" when it is mailed, or when it is delivered according to this paragraph.

20. Selling the Property. Borrower agrees not to sell or transfer all or any part of the Property, or any rights in the Property, without the Lander's written consent. This includes sale by Contract for Deed

21. No Defaults Under Prior Mortgages. If there is already a mortgage against the Property, the Borrower promises

that there will never be a default under that mortgage.

22. No Other Mortgages. Borrower agrees not to mortgage all or any part of the Property or allow anyone else to

have a lien on the Property without the Lender's written consent.

23. Lender's Remedies -- Foreclosure. If Lender requires Borrower to pay the entire outstanding balance under the Agreement in one payment (called "acceleration") and Borrower fails to make the payment when due, then Lender may foreclose this mortgage as provided below. However, before accelerating, Lender will send Borrower a written notice by certified mail which states:

a. The promise that Borrower failed to keep or the representation or werranty that Borrower breached;

b. The action Borrower must take to correct that failure;

c. The date, at least 30 days away, by which the failure must be corrected;

d. That if Borrower doesn't correct the fature or the representation or warranty that Borrower breached, Lander will accelerate, and if Borrower doesn't pay, Lander or another person may buy the Property et a foreclosure sale:

e. That Illinois tow allows Borrower to reinstate the Mortgage after acceleration; and

f. That Borrower may bring suit in court to argue that all promises were kept and to present any other defenses

Borrower has to acceleration.

Lender need not renil the notice if the promise Borrower failed to keep consists of Borrower's sale or transfer of all or a part of the Property of any rights in the Property without Lender's written consent. If Borrower does not correct the failure by the date stated in the notice, Lender may accelerate. If Lender accelerates, Lender may foreclose this Mortgage according to the illinois Statutes. Borrower gives Lender a power to sell the Property at a public auction. Borrower also agrees to pay Lender's attorneys' fees for the foreclosure in the maximum amount allowed by law-Lender will apply the proceeds of the foreclosure sale to the amount Borrower owes under this Mortgage, and to the costs of the foreclosure and Lender's attorneys' fees.

24. Obligations After Assignment. Any person who takes over Borrower's right or obligations under this Mortgage with Lender's consent will have Borrower's rights and will be obligated to keep all of the promises Borrower made in this Mortgage. It another person takes over Borrower's rights or obligations under this Mortgage, Borrower will not be released. Any person or organization who takes over Lender's rights or obligations under this Mortgage will have all of Lender's rights and must keep all of Lender's obligations under this Mortgage.

25. Waiver of Homestead. Under the homestead exemption law, Botrower's homestead is usually free from the claims of creditors. Botrower gives up the homestead exemption right for all claims arising out of this Mortgage. This includes Botrower's right to demand that property other than Botrower's homestead that has been mortgaged to Lender

be foreclosed, before the homestead is foreclosed.

23. Condemnation. If all or part of the Property is condemned, Bostower cirects the party condemning the Property to pay all of the money to Lender. Lender will apply the money to say the amount Bostower owes Lender, unless Lender agrees in writing that the proceeds can be used differently. If Lender uses the money to reduce the amount Bostower owes under the Agreement, Bostower will still have to make regular monthly payments until everything Bostower owes is paid.

27. Paragraph Headings. The headings of the paragraphs are for convenience only, and are not a part of this

Mortgage.
