Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property. This service defines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of obtainey for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the color ang categories is retained (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent oll of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with respect to the types of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. - (b) Financial institution transactions. The agent is outhorized to: open, close, continue and control all accounts and deposits in any type of financial institution (which term includes, without limitation, banks, trust componies, savings and building and loan associations, credit unions and brokerage firms); deposit in and withdraw from and write checks on any financial institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (c) Stock and band transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bonds, mutual lunds and all other types of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and safekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of safe, distributions, shares, certificates and other evidences of ownership pold or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by praxy, enter into voting trusts and consent to limitations on the right to vote; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.
