

DEED IN TRUST

THE GRANTORS, JOSEPH SWIATEK and JANETTE SWIATEK (husband and wife) of the city of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, for and in consideration of One Dollar, and other good and valuable consideration paid in hand, convey and warrant a one half undivided interest to JOSEPH SWIATEK and JANETTE SWIATEK, Trustee ("Trustee" regardless of the number of trustees) of 6620 West Belmont Ave., Chicago, IL 60634 under the provisions of a trust agreement dated August 2, 1997 and known as THE JOSEPH SWIATEK LIVING TRUST DATED August 2, 1997, and a one half undivided interest to JOSEPH SWIATEK and JANETTE SWIATEK, Trustee ("Trustee" regardless of the number of trustees) of 6620 West Belmont Ave., Chicago, IL 60634, under the provisions of a trust agreement dated August 2, 1997 and known as THE JANETTE SWIATEK LIVING TRUST DATED August 2, 1997, and unto all and every successor or successors in trust under the trust agreement, the following described real estate in Cook County, Illinois:

The West 16 Feet of Lot 13 and Lot 14 in Block 23 in Edison Park, a Subdivision in Section 36, Township 41 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian in Cook County, Illinois

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said real estate and appurtenances thereto upon the trusts set forth in said Trust Agreement and for the following uses:

1. The Trustee (or Trustees, as the case may be), is invested with the following powers: (a) to manage, improve, divide or subdivide the trust property, or any part thereof. (b) To sell on any terms, grant options to purchase, contract to sell, to convey with or without consideration, to convey to a successor or successors in trust, any or all of the title and estate of the trust, and to grant to such successor or successors in trust all the powers vested in the Trustee. (c) To mortgage, encumber or otherwise transfer the trust property, or any interest therein, as security for advances or loans. (d) To dedicate parks, street, highways or alleys, and to vacate any portion of the premises. (e) To lease and enter into leases for the whole or part of the premises, from time to time, but any such leasehold or renewal shall not exceed a single term of 199 years, and to renew, extend or modify any existing lease.

2. Any party dealing with the Trustee with regard to the trust property, whether by contract, sale, mortgage, lease or otherwise, shall not be required to see to the application of the purchase money, loan proceeds, rental or other consideration given, nor shall be required to see that the terms of the trust have been complied with, or to enquire into the powers and authority of the Trustee, and the execution of every contract, option, deal, mortgage or other instrument dealing with the trust property, shall be conclusive evidence in favor of every person relying upon or claiming under such conveyance or other instrument; that at the time of the execution and delivery of any of the aforesaid instruments, the Trust Agreement above described was in full force and effect; that said instrument so executed was pursuant to and in accordance with the authority granted the Trustee, and is binding upon the beneficiary or beneficiaries under said Trust Agreement; and if said instrument is executed by a successor or successors in trust, that he or they were duly appointed and are fully invested with the title, estate, rights, powers and duties of the preceding Trustee.

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disposition of the trust property, and such interest is hereby declared to be personal property only, and the beneficiary or beneficiaries of the trust shall not have any title or interest therein, legal or equitable, except as stated.




All of the covenants, conditions, powers, rights and duties vested hereby, in the respective parties, shall inure to and be binding upon their heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

If the title to any of the above real estate now is or hereafter shall be registered, the Registrar of Titles is directed not to register or note in the Certificate of Title, duplicate thereof, or memorial, the words "in trust" or "upon condition", or "with limitation", or words of similar import, in compliance with the statute of the State of Illinois in such case made and provided.

The Grantor S hereby waive ___ and release ___ any and all right and benefit under and by virtue of the Statutes of the State of Illinois providing for exemption of homestead from sale or execution or otherwise.


