Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attarney for property. This section delines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of anomey for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the fallowing categories is retained (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with espect to the types of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the farm. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of property or transaction cover as in the granted power at the time of exercise, whether the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or contractival, as a joint fend, it are furniting an held in any other form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory categories (a) through (a) to make gills of the principal's properly. The agent is authorized to: open, close, continue and control all accounts and deposits in any type of financial institution (which term includes, willhout limitation, banks, trust companies, savings and building and loan associations, credit unions and brokerage firms); deposit in and withdraw from and write checks an anylinancial institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (c) Stock and band transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bands, mulval funds and all other types of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and safekeep all dividends, interest, cornings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shores, confinates and other evidences of awnership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by praxy, enter into voting trusts and content in limitations on the right to water and in general exercise all powers with respect to socialists which the principal could if present and under no disability.
