THIS MORTGAGE ("Security Instrument") is given on December 8, 1997.
The mortgagor is Barbara J. Barnhouse and Michael D. Barnhouse, Wife and Husband,
whose address is 4809 North Hermitage, Chicago, IL 60640 ("Borrower").
This Security Instrument is given to Superior Bank FSB,
which is organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, and whose address is 5600 North River Road, Suite 600, Rosemont, IL 60018 ("Lender").
Borrower owes Lender the principal sum of Sixty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (U.S. \$ 64,800.00). This debt is evidenced by Borrower's note dated the same date as this Security Instrument ("Note"), which provides for monthly payments with the full debt, if not paid earlier, due and payable on December 12, 2012. This Security Instrument secures to Lender: (a) the repayment of the debt evidenced by the Note, with interest as provided by the terms of the Note, and all renewals, extensions and modifications of the Note; (b) the payment of all other sums, with interest, advanced under paragraph 6 to protect the security of this Security Instrument; and (c) the performance of Borrower's covenants and agreements under this Security Instrument and the Note. 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All insurance policies and renewals must be acceptable to Lender and must include a standard mortgage clause in favor of and in a form acceptable to Lender. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals, if Lender requires. Borrower shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid policies and renewals.

4. Hazard or Property Insurance. Borrowers shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against losses by fire, hazards included within the term "extinguished coverage," and any other hazards, including floods or flooding, for which Lender requires reinsurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods for which Lender requires reinsurance. Borrower shall satisfy the lien or take one or more of the actions set forth above within 10 days of the giving of notice.

3. Prior Mortgagor: Charges: Liens: Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Borrower shall pay these obligations on time directly to the person owed payment. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts to be paid under this paragraph, and receiveable evidencing such payment.

2. **Applicable Law of Payments.** Unless applicable law provides otherwise, Lender will apply each of Borrower's payments under the Note to accrued and unpaid interest under the Note to the date of payment and the remainder, if any, to the unpaid principal balance under the Note. Any late payment and the remedies; (ii) to the unpaid principal balance under the Note. Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraph 1 or change the amount of the payments. If under paragraph 17 the Property is acquired by Lender, Borrower's right to any insurance policies and proceeds resulting from damage to the Property prior to the acquisition shall pass to Lender to the extent of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately prior to the acquisition.

5. Occupancy, Preservation, Maintenance and Protection of the Property; Borrower's Loan Application; Leaseholds; Condominiums; Planned Unit Developments. Unless Borrower's loan application and Lender's loan approval provided that the Property was not required to be occupied as Borrower's principal residence, Borrower shall occupy, establish, and use the Property as Borrower's principal residence within 60 days after the execution of this Security Instrument and shall continue to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least 1 year after the date of occupancy, unless Lender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Borrower's control. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall not permit, or be alleged to have permitted, the Property to be used in connection with any illegal activity. In that regard, Borrower shall be in default if any forfeiture action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's good faith judgment could result in forfeiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower shall also be in default if Borrower, during the loan application process, gave materially false or inaccurate information or statements to Lender (or failed to provide Lender with any material information) in connection with the loan evidenced by the Note, including, but not limited to, representations concerning Borrower's occupancy of the Property as a principal residence. A sale may result in a change in the entity (known as the "Loan Servicer") that collects monthly payments due under the Note and this Security Instrument. There also may be one or more changes of the Loan Servicer unrelated to a sale of the Note. If there is a change of the Loan Servicer, Borrower will be given written notice of the change in accordance with paragraph 12 and applicable law. The notice will state the name and address of the new Loan Servicer and the address to which payments should be made. The notice will also contain any other information required by applicable law.

16. Hazardous Substances. Borrower shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storage, or release of any Hazardous Substances on or in the Property. Borrower shall not do, nor allow anyone else to do, anything affecting the Property that is in violation of any Environmental Law. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Property of small quantities of Hazardous Substances that are generally recognized to be appropriate to normal residential uses and to maintenance of the Property.

Borrower shall promptly give Lender written notice of any investigation, claim, demand, lawsuit or other action by any governmental or regulatory agency or private party involving the Property and any Hazardous Substance or Environmental Law of which Borrower has actual knowledge. If Borrower learns, or is notified by any governmental or regulatory authority, that any removal or other remediation of any Hazardous Substance affecting the Property is necessary, Borrower shall promptly take all necessary remedial actions in accordance with Environmental Law.

17. Lender's Rights if Borrower Fails to Keep Promises and Agreements.
