5. Hazard or Property Insurance. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured arginst loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage" and any other hazards, including floods or flooding, for which Lender or applicable law requires insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the proceeds that Lender, or applicable law, requires. The insurance entrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld. If Borrower fails to maintain coverage described above, Lender may, at Lender's option, obtain coverage to protect Lender's rights in the Property in accordance with paragraph 7.

All insurance policies and renewals show be acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals. If Lender requires, Borrower shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid premiums and renewal notices. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Lender. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in wiking, and subject to the rights of the holder of any Approved Senior Security Instrument, insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged, if the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lender's ecurity is not lessened. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's security would be lessened, the insurance proceeds shall be applied, subject to the rights of the holder of any Approved Senior Security Instrument, to the sams secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. If Borrower abandons the Property, or does not answer within 30 days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claim, then Lender, subject to the rights of the holder of any Approved Senior Security Instrument, may collect the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds received by Lender to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The 30-day period will begin when the notice is given.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of the payments. If under paragraph 19 the Property is acquired by Lender, Borrower's right to any insurance policies and proceeds resulting from damage to the Property prior to the acquisition shall pass to Lender to the extent of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately prior to the acquisition.

6. Occupancy, Preservation, Maintenance and Protection of the Property; Borrower's Long Application; Leascholds. Unless Borrower's loan application and the Lender's loan approval provided that the Property was not required to be occupied as Borrower's principal residence. Borrower shall occupy, establish, and use the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least one year after the date of occupancy, unless Lender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Borrower's control. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall be in default if any forfeiture action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's good faith judgment could result in forfeiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower may cure such a default and reinstate, by causing the action or proceeding to be dismissed with a culing that, in Lender's good faith determination, precludes forfeiture of the Borrower's interest in the Property or other material impairment of the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower shall also be in default if Borrower, during the loan application process, gave materially false or inaccurate information or statements to Lender (or failed to provide Lender with any material information) in connection with the loan evidenced by the Note, including, but not

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limited to, representations concerning Borrower's occupancy of the Property as a principal residence. If this Security instrument is on a leasehold, Borrower shall comply with all the provisions of the lease. If Borrower acquires fee title to the Property, the leasehold and the fee title shall not merge unless Lender agrees to the merger in writing.

7. Protection of Lender's Rights in the Property. If Borrower falls to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or forfeiture or to enforce laws or regulations), then Lender may do and pay for whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. Lender's actions may include paying any sums secured by a lien which has priority over this Security Instrument, paying real estate taxes, flood insurance and mortgage insurance premiums, appearing in court, paying reasonable attorners' fees, entering on the Property to make repairs, and paying property insurance premiums. Although Lender may take action under this paragraph 7, Lender does not have to do so.

Any amounts distanced by Lender under this paragraph 7 shall become additional debt of Borrower secured by this Security Instrument. Coless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these amounts shall bear interest from the date of disbursement at the Note rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment.

- 8. Mortgage Insurance. It Lender required mortgage insurance as a condition of making the loan evidenced by the Note and secured by this Security instrument, Borrower shall pay the premiums required to maintain the mortgage insurance in effect. If, for any reason, the martgage insurance coverage required by lender lapses or ceases to be in effect, Borrower shall pay the premiums required to obtain coverage substantially equivalent to the mortgage insurance previously in effect, at a cost substantially equivalent to the cost to Borrower of the mortgage insurance previously in effect, from an alternate mortgage insurer approved by Lender. - 9. Inspection. Lender or its agent may make reasonable entries upon and largertions of the Property. Lender shall give Borrower notice at the time of or prior to an inspection specifying reasonable cruse for the inspection.
- 10. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of the Property, or any part thereof, or for conveyance in decorporation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender, subject only to the rights of the holder of any Approved Senior Security Instrument. Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of such proceeds which does not pay the principal sum secured by this Security Instrument in full, shall not extend or postpone the dire of ac of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of such payments.
- 11. Borrower Not Released; Forbenrance By Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.
- 12. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 19(B). Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who cosigns this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to grant and

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convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.

- 13. Loan Charges. If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law or regulation which sets maximum loan charges, and that law or regulation is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.
- 14. Notices. Any ordice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class man' orders applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- 15. Governing Law: Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall are affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.
- 16. Borrower's Copy. Borrower acknowledges receipt of a conformed copy or a photocopy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.
- 17. Sale of Note; Change of Loan Servicer. The Note or a partial interest in the Note (together with this Security Instrument) may be sold one or more times without prior notice to Borrower. A sale may result in a change in the entity (known as the "Loan Servicer") that collects monthly payments due under the Note, and this Security Instrument. There also may be one or more changes of the Loan Servicer unrelated to a sale of the Note. If there is a change of the Loan Servicer, Borrower will be given written notice of the change in accordance with paragraph 14 above and applicable law. The notice will state the name and address of the new Loan Servicer and the address to which payments should be made. The notice will also contain any other information required by applicable law.
- 18. Hazardous Substances. Borrower shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storige, or release of any Hazardous Substances on or in the Property. Borrower shall not do, nor allow anyone else to do, exphing affecting the Property that is in violation of any Environmental Law. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Property of small quantities of Hazardous Substances that are generally recognized to be appropriate to normal residential uses and to maintenance of the Property.

Borrower shall promptly give Lender written notice of any investigation, claim, demand, lawsuit or other action by any governmental or regulatory agency or private party involving the Property and any Hazardous Substance or Environmental Law of which Borrower has actual knowledge. If Borrower learns, or is notified by any governmental or regulatory authority, that any removal or other remediation of any Hazardous Substance affecting the Property is necessary, Borrower shall promptly take all necessary remedial actions in accordance with Environmental Law.

As used in this paragraph 18, "Hazardous Substances" are those substances defined as toxic or hazardous substances by Environmental Law and the following substances: gasoline, kerosene, other flammable or toxic petroleum products, toxic pesticides and herbicides, volatile solvents, materials containing asbestos or formaldehyde, and radioactive-materials. As used in this paragraph 18, "Environmental Law" means federal laws and laws of the jurisdiction where the Property is located that relate to health, safety or environmental protection.

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19. Lender's Rights If Borrower Fails To Keep Promises. If any of the events or conditions described in subparagraphs (A), (B), (C), (D) or (E) of this paragraph 19 shall occur. Lender may require that Borrower pays immediately the entire amount remaining unpaid under the Note and this Security Instrument. This requirement will be called "immediate payment in full". If Lender requires immediate payment in full Lender may foreclose this Security Instrument by judicial proceeding. (A) Borrower fails to make any payment required by the Note or this Security Instrument when it is due; or

(B) All or any part of the Property, or any interest in the Property is sold or transferred (or, if Borrower is not a natural person, if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred) without Lender's prior written consent; or

Lender may require immediate payment in full under this paragraph 19 if:

(C) On application of Lender two or more insurance companies licensed to do business in the state in which the Property is located refuse to issue policies insuring the buildings and improvements on the Property; or

(D) If Borrover fails to make any required payment when due on any Approved Senior Security Instrument, or if Borrower fails to keep any other promise or agreement contained in any Approved Senior Security Instrument; or

- (E) Borrower fails to keep any other promise or agreement in this Security Instrument within the time set forth, or if no time is set forth in the Security Instrument, then within the time set forth in the notice sent to Borrower by Lender, or if Borrower is otherwise in default under this Security Instrument, or if any of the representations and/or warranties made by Borrower in his Security Instrument are not true and correct in any material respect or are otherwise breached by Borrower.
- 20. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall cancel this Security Instrument without charge to Borrower. Borrower shall pay any recordation costs.
 - 21. Whiver of Homestead. Borrower hereby walles all rights of homestead exemption in the Property.
- 22. Riders to this Security Instrument. If one or more riders are executed by Borrower and recorded together with this Security Instrument, the covenants and agreements of this Security instrument as if the rider(s) were a part of this Security Instrument.
