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- ARTICLE 4: The purposes for which the Corporation is formed, and the business and objects to be carried on and promoted by it, are as follows:
 - (a) The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes, including, for such purpose, the making of distributions to organization which qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development for the time being exclusively for a public purpose, in pursuance of the foregoing purposes, the corporation shall have the power to provide elderly persons and handicapped persons with housing facilities and services specially designed to meet their physical, social and psychological needs, and to promote their health, security, happiness, and the usefulness in longer living, the charges for such facilities end services to be predicated upon the provision, maintenance, and operation thereof on a nonprofit basis.
 - (b) No part of the 1 et earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services actually rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its exempt purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda, of otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not perocipate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income taxation under Section 501(c)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1966, as amended, or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law, or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding section of any future United States internal revenue law.

5. The Corporation is empowered:

(a) To buy, own, sell assign, mortgage, or lease any interest in real estate and personal property and to construct, maintain, and operate improvements thereon necessary or incident to the accomplishment of the proposes set forth in Article II hereof, but solely in connection with the project assisted under (Section 202 of the housing act of 1959, as amended, or Section 811 of the National Affordable Housing Act).

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- (b) To borrow money and issue evidence of indebtedness in furtherance of any or all of the objects of its businesses, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, or other lien on the Corporation's property.
- (c) To do and perform all acts reasonably necessary to accomplish the purposes of the corporation, including the execution of a Regulatory Agreement with the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, and of such other instruments and undertakings as may be necessary to enable the Corporation to secure the benefits of financing under (Section 202 or Section 811). Such Regulatory Agreement and other instruments and undertaking shall remain binding upon the corporation, its successors and assigns, so long as a mortgage on the Corporation's property is held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development.
- (d) Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, all of the remaining assets of the corporation shall be distributed only to one or more organizations created and operated for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Article II(a) hereof, other than for religious purposes, all of the foregoing within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the future corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue iate, or shall be distributed to the Secretary of Housing and urban Development exclusively for a public purpose, any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
- 6. The officers of the Corporation, as provided by the By Laws of the Corporation shall be elected by the directors of the Corporation, in the manner therein set out, and shall serve until their successors are elected and have qualified. the directors shall elect the regular officers of the Corporation at the annual meeting, for terms of one (1) year. The secretary and treasurer may be one and the same person, and need not be a director of the corporation.
 - 7. The annual meeting shall be held on the last Wednesday of June of each year.
- 8. By-Laws of the Corporation may be adopted by the directors at any regular meeting or any special meeting called for that purpose, so long as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of these Articles or of the Regulatory Agreement between the Corporation and the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development.
- 9. So long as a mortgage on the corporation's property is held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, these Articles may not be amended without the prior written approval of the said Secretary.
 - 10. The directors shall serve without compensation.

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11. The directors of the Corporation shall, at all times, be limited to individuals who are either members of St. Paul Church of God in Christ or nonmembers who have the approval of the Board of Trustees of said Church. In the event that a director of the Corporation ceases to be a member of St. Paul Church of God in Christ or, if the aforesaid approval is withdrawn, then, in either event, such shall constitute automatic resignation as a director of the corporation.
