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SECTION 3-4 of the Illinois Statutory Short Form Power of Attorney for Property Law

. Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property. This Section defines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the following categories is retained (not attuck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with respect to the types of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of property or transaction covered by the granted power at the time of exercise, whether the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or contractual, as a joint tenent or tream in common or held in any other form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory eategories (a) through (o) to make gifts of the principal's property, to exercise powers to appoint to others or to change any beneficiary whom the principal has designated to take the principal's interests at death under any will, trust, joint tenancy, beneficiary form or contractual arrangement. (b) Financial institution transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, close, continue and control all accounts and deposits in any type of financial institution (which tern includes, without limitation, banks, trust companies, savings and building and loan associations, credit unions and brokerage firms); denotes in and withraw from and write checks on any financial institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(0) Stock and bond transactions. The agent is tuthorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bads, mutual lunds and all other ypes of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and satekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, certificates and other evidences of ownership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting tights with respect to securities in person or by promy, anter into voting trusts and consent to limitations on the right to vote; and, in general, councies all powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(d) Tangible personal property transactions. The agent is authorised to: buy and sell, lease, exchage, collect, possess and take title to all tangible personal property; move, ecore, ship, restore, maintain, repair improve, manage, preserve, insure and safekeep tangible personal property; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to tangible personal property which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(e) Safe deposit box transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, continue and nave access to all safe deposit boxes; sign, renew, release or terminate any safe deposit contract; drill or succender any safe deposit boxi and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to safe deposit matters which the principal could if present and under no disability.

(f) Insurance and annuity transactions. 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- (i) Tax matters. The agent is authorized to: sign, verify and file all the principal's federal, state and local income, gift, entere, property and other tax returns, including joint returns and declarations of estimated tax; pay all taxes; claim, sue for shid receive all tax returnds; examine and copy all the principal's tax returns and records; represent the principal before any federal, state or local revenue agency or taxing body and sign and deliver all tax powers of attotney on behalf of the principal that may be necessary for such purposes; waive rights and sign all documents on behalf of the principal as required to settle, pay and determine all taxiliabilities; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to tax matters which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (I) Claims and litigation.
