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TOGETHER WITH all the improvements now of hereafter exercit on the property and all cast ments, appurtenances, and fixtures now or hereafter a part of the property. All replacements and additions shall also be covered by this Security Instrument. All of the foregoing is referred to in this Security Instrument as the "Property".

BORROWER COVENANTS that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against eliciaims and demands, subject to any encumbrances of record.

Borrower and lender covenant and agree as follows:

1. Payment of Principal and Interest; Late Charges or Other Fees and Charges. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the debt owed under the Agreement and any late charges or any other fees and charges due under the Agreement.

2. Charges: Liens. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Borrower shall pay these obligances directly to the person owed payment. At Lender's request, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts to be paid under this

paragraph and shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing the payments.

Borrower shall promptly discharge any tien which has priority over this Security Instrument unless Borrower: (a) agrees in writing to the payment of the obligation secured by the lien in a manner acceptable to Lender; (b) secures in good faith the lien by, or defends against enforcement of the lien in legal proceedings which in the Lender sopinion operate to prevent the enforcement of the lien; (c) secures from the holder of the lien or present. 3. Hazard or Property of an ance. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards including thin the term extended coverage and any other hazards, including floods or flooding, for which Lender requires insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lender requires. The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrow's subject to Lender's approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld. If Borrower fails to maintain coverage described above, Lender may at Lender's option, obtain coverage to inselect Lender srights in the Property in accordance

with paragraphs.

All insurance policies and renewals shall be acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals. If Lender requires, Borrower shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid premiums and renewal notices. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Lender, Lender may make proof of loss if not

made promptly by Borrower.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, or drance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged, if the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lender's security is not leaded. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender security would be lessened, the in urance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. If Borrower abandons the Property, or does not answer within 30 days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claim, then Lender may collect the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The 30-day period will begin when the notice is given.

Unless Lender and Borrower enherwise agree in writing, any application of rowceds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date or amount of the payments due under the Agreement. If under paragraph 17 the property is acquired by Lender, Borrower sright to any insurance policies and proceeds resulting from damage to the Property prior to the acquiration shall pass to Lender to the extent of the sums

secured by this Security Instrument immediately prior to the acquisition.

4. Preservation, Maintenance and Protection of the Property. Borrower shall not design, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall be in default if any forfatore action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal is begun that in Lender sgood faith judgment could result in forfeiture of the Property or of cruise materially impair the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower may cure such a default and reinstally as provided in paragraph 15, by causing the action or proceeding to be dismissed with a ruling that, in Lender's good faith determination, preclaims forfeiture of the Borrower's interest in the Property or other material impairment of the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest.

5. Protection of Leader's Rights in the Property. 7. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender. In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not than due, with any excess paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property in which the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking is equal to or greater than the amount of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately before the taking, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing, the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall be reduced by the amount of the proceeds multiplied by the following fraction: (a) the total amount of the sums secured immediately before the taking, divided by (b) the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking. Any balance shall be paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property in which the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking is less the amount of the sums secured immediately before the taking, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing or unless applicable law otherwise provides, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument whether or not the sums are then due.

- 8. Borrower Not Released; Forbarance By Lender Not a Walver. Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to belease the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower ssuccessors in interest. Any ferbearance by Lender in exercising by right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.
- 9. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signs: The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 14. Borrower scovenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but is not personally liable under the Agreement: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower sinterest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (o) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Agreement without that Borrower's consent.
- 10. Loan Charges. If the loar secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that taw is finally interpreted so that the interest of other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. - 11. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender saddress stated havein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be desimed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- 12. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall n: governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provisions or clause of this Security Instrument or the Agreement conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Agreement which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Agreement are declared to be severable.
  - 13. Borrower's Cany. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of this Security 'aspument.
- 14. Transfer of the Property of a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. - 15. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. 17. Acceleration: Remedies. Lender shall give notice to Borrover prior to acceleration following Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument or to the Agreement under which acceleration is permitted (but not provide to care the default; (b) the sation acceleration under paragraph 14 unless applicable taw provides otherwise).
