WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 2-120-690 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the City of Chicago, through its Commission on Chicago Landmarks ("Commission") has determined that the 333 North Michigan Avenue Building, located at 333 North Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, is worthy of designation as a Chicago landmark; and

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WHEREAS, The Commission has found that the 333 North Michigan Avenue Building meets certain criteria for designation under Section 2-120 620 (1), (4), (5) and (7) of the Municipal Code of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, The 333 North Michigan Avenue Building is associated with the 1309 Plan of Chicago as an integral element of the redevelopment of Michigan Avenue at the Chicago River into a prestigious and cosmopolitan boulevard, forming the southern end of what has become popularly known as "the Magnificent Mile"; and

WHEREAS, the 333 North Michigan Avenue Building was designed by John Holabird and John Root, whose firm was the successor to one of the oldest and most prominent firms in Chicago's illustrious architectural history; and

WHEREAS, The 333 North Michigan Avenue Building is an exemplar of the Art Deco style, having an aggressively modern design and streamlined details that emphasized manufacturing and technology, and celebrated the rapid economic expansion and optionistic spirit of the era; and

WHEREAS, The 333 North Michigan Avenue Building illustrates Holabird and Root's innovative use of the Art Deco style, and exemplifies the creative and masterful contribution the firm made to Chicago architecture during the late 1920s; and

WHEREAS, The 333 North Michigan Avenue Building has unique physical characteristics, a prominent location, and a proximity to other prominent structures that make it a significant contribute, to the collection of buildings surrounding the Michigan Avenue Bridge, except the most important urban ensembles in the United States; now, therefore

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. The 333 North Michigan Avenue Building, located at 333 North Michigan Avenue and legally described as:

SECTION 3. The Commission on Chicago Landmarks is directed to comply with provisions of Section 2-120-720 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, regarding notification of said designation.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
