AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO ESTABLISH AND OPERATE A RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT WITH THE SALE OF PACKAGED LIQUOR GOODS AT 9454 SKOKIE BOULEVARD, SKOKIE, ILLINOIS IN A B-2 COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission, who public hearing duty held, made appropriate findings of fact as required under Section 13.3.2. of the Skokie Zoning Ordinance and recommended to the Mayor and Board of Trustees that the requested Special Use Permit be granted subject to various conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees, after a public meeting duly held, concurred in the aforesaid recommendations and findings of fact of the Plan Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Skokie, Cook County, Illinois:

Section 1: That the Special Use Permit requested by the petitioner to establish and operate a retail establishment with the sale of packaged fiquor goods within the shopping center legally described above at 9454 Skokie Boulevard, Skokie, Illinois in a B-2 Commercial District is hereby granted and approved subject to each of the conditions set forth below:

That the construction and operation of the retail establishment with the sale
of packaged liquor goods shall be in substantial compliance with the Site
Plan dated May 8, 1984, and the Floor Plan dated October 8, 1996;

- That the hours of the sale of liquor shall be in accordance with all State and local laws and shall not be extended beyond 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Sundays;
- 3. That inasmuch as the Special Use Permit is granted in part on the basis of the subject establishment's operating pattern and limited liquor sales, any change in the business ownership or operator of the liquor sales from Cost Plus World Market shall cause the subject Special Use Permit to cease:
- That landscaping in the shopping center shall be maintained and all dead landscaping shall be replaced.
- 5 That all Skokie Health Codes and Requirements shall be met;
- That detailed plans showing all food service equipment, plumbing, electrical and finishes shall be submitted to the Health Department;
- 7. Track if open food is offered for sale (e.g. bulk foods, coffee, soft drinks, etc.) aren an approved three-compartment sink with open site drain is needed.
- 8. That the flow areas in the food storage and display area must be smooth and easily carable;
- 9. That the facility must be supplied with a janitorial sink for cleaning and storage of maintenance equipment;
- 10. That if handling of ray foods or ready-to-eat foods is done on site, then a separate hand washing will be required;
- 11. That the subject store shall the allowed to operate as a food establishment, as defined in the Amended Zoong Ordinance. The establishment of a restaurant of any type in the store is prohibited;
- That an approved garbage corral are), shall be provided for all waste materials generated by the store. This enclosure shall be six (6) feet high and be constructed of chain link fencing with privacy stats. If open foods sales or any food preparation are conducted in the store the corral shall be equipped with a hose bib and drain;
- 13. That coin-operated amusement devices are specifical prohibited;
- 14. That the entire site be kept clean, free of weeds and Jetas at all times;
- 15. That the property owners shall sign an "Agreement for Installation and Maintenance of Landscaping" to assure that the landscaping is rupintained in accordance with the final approved landscape plan;
- 16. That all Federal, State, and Village regulations, ordinances, and course shall be complied with:
- 17. That the fence along the south property line of the site shall be repaired and maintained in a state of good repair;
- 18. That failure to abide by any and all terms of the Special Use Permit shall be cause for the Village to initiate hearings to determine whether the Special Use Permit should be revoked, as well as any applicable license and;
