Together with all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, appurtenances, and fixtures-now or floreafter a part of the property. All replacements and additions shall also be covered by this Security Instrument. All of the foregoing is referred to in this Security Instrument as the "Property."

Borrower Covenants that Borrower is tawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any encumbrances of record.

This Security instrument combines uniform coverants for national use and non-uniform coverants with limited variations by jurisdiction to constitute a uniform security instrument covering real property.

**Uniform Covenants.** Borrower and Lender covenant and agree as follows.

- 1. Payment of Principal and Interest; Prepayment and Late Charges. Borrower shall promptly pay when the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment and late charges due under the Note
- 2. Funds for Tixes and it are uses. Subject to applicable law or to a written waiver by Lender. Borrower shall pay to Lender on the day monthly payments are due or ser the Note, until the Note is paid in full, a sum ("Funds") for: (a) yearly taxes and assessments which may attain priority over this Security if strument as a lien on the Property, (b) yearly leasehold payments or ground rems on the Property, if any; (c) yearly hazard or property insurance premiums. (d) yearly flood insurance premiums, if any, (e) yearly mortgage insurance premiums. These items are called "Foorow Items." Lender may, at any time, collect and hold Funds in an arround not to exceed the maximum amount a lender for a federally related mortgage foan may require for Borrower's escrew account under the federal Real Estate. Settlement Procedures Act of 1974 as amended from time to time. 12 U.S.C. § 2601 et seq. ("RESPA") unless another two that applies to the Funds sets a lesser amount, it so, Lender may, at any time, collect and hold Funds in an amount not to exceed the lesser amount. Lender may estimate the amount of Funds due on the basis of current design and reasonable estimates of expenditures of future Escrow Items or otherwise in accordance with applicable law.

The Funds shall be held in an institution whose deposits are insured by a federal agency, instrumentality, or entity (including Lender, if Lender is such an institution) or in any Federal Home Loan Bank. Lender shall apply the Funds to pay the Escrow items. Lender may not charge Borrower for holding and applying the Funds, annually analyzing the escrow account, or verifying the Escrow items, unless Lender pays Borrower interest on the Funds and applicable law permits Lender to make such a charge. However, Lender may require Borrower to pay a cone-time charge for an independent real estate tax reporting service used by Lender in or innection with this loan, unless applicable law provides otherwise. Unless an agreement is made or applicable law requires interest to be paid. Lender shall not be required to pay Borrower any interest or earnings on the Funds. Borrower and lender may agree in writing, however, it is interest shall be paid on the Funds. Lender shall give to Borrower, without charge, an annual accounting of the Funds, showing credits and dian's to the Funds and the purpose for which each debit to the Funds was made. The Funds are pledged as additional security for all sums secured by the Security Instrument.

If the Funds held by Lender exceed the amounts permitted to be held by applicable law. Lender shall account to florrower for the excess Funds in accordance with the requirements of applicable law. If the amount of the Funds held by Lender at any time is not sufficient to say the Escrow Rems when due, Lender may so notify Borrower in writing, and, in such case Borrower shall pay to Lende, the amount necessary to make up the deficiency. - 4. Charges: Elens. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any, Borrower shall pay these obligations in the manner provided in paragraph 2, or if not paid in that manner, Borrower shall pay them on time directly to the person owed payment. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts to be paid under this paragraph, if Borrower makes these payments directly, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing the payments.

Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien which has priority over this Security Instrument unless Borrower: (a) agrees in writing to the payment of the obligation secured by the lien in a manner acceptable to Lender. (b) contest in good faith the lien by, or defends against

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enforcement of the lien in, legal proceedings which in the Lender's opinion operate to prevent the emorcement of the lien; or (c) secures from the holder of the lien an agreement satisfactory to Lender subordinating the lien to this Security Instrument. If Lender determines that any part of the Property is subject to a lien which may attain priority over this Security Instrument. Lender may give Borrower a notice identifying the lien. Somewhat shall satisfy the lien or take one or more of the actions set forth above within 10 days of the giving of notice.

5. Hazard or Property Insurance. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage" and any other hazards, including floods or flooding, for which Lender requires insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lender requires. The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld. If Borrower falls to maintain coverage described above, Lender may, at Lender's option, obtain coverage to protect Lender's rights in the Property in accordance with paragraph 7.

All insurance policies and renewals shall be acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals. If Lender requires, Borrower shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid premiums and renewal notices. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Lender Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Unless Lender and Bource: Otherwise agree in writing, insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged, if the restoration or repair is commoncally feasible and Lender's security is not lessened. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's security would be lessened, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Derrower If Borrower abandons the Property, or does not answer within 30 days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to bertie a claim, then Lender may collect the insurance proceeds. Liniess Lander and Borrower otherwise agree in whiten any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of the payments. If under paragraph 21 the Property is acquired by Lender, Borrower's right to any insurance policies Lorz proceeds resulting from damage to the Property prior to the acquisition shall pass to Lender to the extent of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately prior to the acquisition.

- 8. Occupy, establish, and use the Property as Borrower's principal residence within pixty days after the execution of this Security Instrument and shall continue to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least one year after the date of occupancy, unless Lender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Borrower's control. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall be in default if any forfeiture action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's good faith judgment could result in forfeiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien creater in this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower may cure such a default and reinstate as provided in paragraph 18, by causing the action or proceeding to be dismissed with a ruling that, in Lender's good faith determination, precludes forfeiture of the Borrower's interest in the Property or other material impairment of the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower shall so be in default if Borrower, during the lean application process, gave materially false or inaccurate information or statements to Lender (or false) to provide Lender with any material information) in connection with the loan evidenced by the Note, including, but not limited to, representable comply with all the provisions of the lease. In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Dornover. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in Interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Cacurity Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in elercision any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.
- 12. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Etablity; Co-signors. The covenants and agreements of this Security instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrower's coverants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's consent.
- 13. Lean Charges. If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.

Anymotice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- 15. Governing Law, Severability. This Security instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located, in the event that any grovision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provisions. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.
- 18. Surremer's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.
- 17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (of if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent. Lender may, at its option, not be immediate payment in tuit of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, I ender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delicated or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. So long as the Owners Association maintains, with a generally accepted insurance califor, 2 innster" or "blanket" policy on the Condominium Project which is satisfactory to Lender and which provides insurance coverage in the amounts for the periods, and against the hazards Lender requires, including fire and hazards included within the term "extended coverage," then:
- (i) Lender waives the provision in Uniform Covenant 2 for the monthly payment to Lender of one-twelfth of the yearly premium installments for hazard insurance on the Property: and
- (ii) Borrower's obligation under Uniform Covenant 5 to maintain hazard insurance coverage on the Property is deemed satisfied to the extent that the required coverage is provided by the Owners Association policy.

Borrower shall give Lender prompt notice of any lapse in required hazard insurance coverage

In the event of a distribution of hazard insurance proceeds in lieu of restoration or repair following a loss to the Property, whether to the unit or to common elements, any proceeds payable to Borrower are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender for application to the sums secured by the Security Instrument, with any excess paid to Borrower.

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- C. Public Liability Incurance. Borrower shall take such actions as may be reasonable to ensure that the Owners Association quantities public liability insurance policy acceptable in form, amount, and extent of coverage to Lender.
- D. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, payable to Borrower in connection with any condemnation or other taking of all or any part of the Property, whether of the unit or of the common elements, or for any conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender. Such proceeds shall be applied by Lender to the sums secured by the Security Instrument as provided in Uniform Covenant 10.
- E. Lendor's Prior Consent. Borrower shall not, except after notice to Lender and with Lender's prior written consent, either partition or subdivide the Property or consent to:
- (i) the abandonment or termination of the Condominium Project, except for abandonment or termination required by law in the case of substantial destruction by fire or other casualty, or in the case of a taking by condemnation or eminent domain.
- (ii) any amendment to an provision of the "Constituent Documents" if the provision is for the express benefit of Lender,
- (iii) termination of professir (a) management and assumption of self-management of the Owners Association; or
- (hr) any action which would have the effect of rendering the public liability insurance coverage maintained by the Owners Association unacceptable to Lender.
- F. Remoties. If Borrower does not pay condominium dues and assessments when due, then Lender may pay them. Any amounts, disbursed by Lender under this paragraph F shall become artistical debt of Borrower secured by the Security Instrument. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these amounts shall be an interest from the date of disbursement at the Note rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower request no payment.
