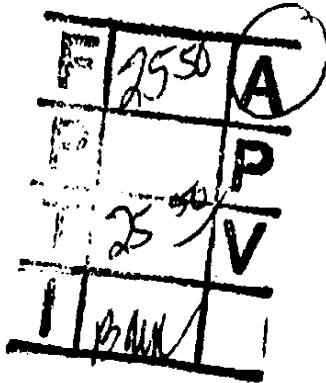

Full power and authority is hereby granted to the Trustee(s) with respect to the real estate or any part or parts of it, and at any time or times to: subdivide and resubdivide; dedicate parks, streets, highways or alleys; vacate any subdivision or part thereof; contract to sell; grant options to purchase, sell and convey on any terms with or without consideration; convey to a successor or successors in trust; grant to each successor or successors all of the title, estate, powers and authorities vested in the Trustee(s); donate; dedicate; mortgage, pledge or otherwise encumber it; execute leases in possession or reversion, to commence in the present or in the future on any terms and for any period of time, not exceeding 99 years; renew or extend leases upon any terms and for any periods of time; amend, change or modify leases; contract to execute leases; grant options to lease and options to renew leases; grant options to purchase the whole or any part of the real estate; contract with respect to the manner of fixing the amount of present or future rentals; partition or exchange it for other real or personal property; grant easements or charges of any kind, release, convey or assign any right, title or interest in or about or appurtenant to it; and to deal with in every way and for such other considerations as would be lawful for any person owning it even though different from the ways above specified.

In no case shall any party dealing with the Trustee in relation to the real estate or to whom it or any part shall be conveyed, contracted to be sold, leased, or mortgaged by the Trustee(s) be obligated to see the application of any purchase money, rent, or money borrowed or advanced on the trust property or be obliged to see that the terms of the trust have been complied with, or be obliged to see that the terms of the trust have been complied with or be obliged to inquire into the necessity or expediency of any act of the Trustee(s), or be obliged or privileged to inquire into any of the terms of the trust agreement. Every deed, trust deed, mortgage, lease or other instrument executed by the Trustee(s) in relation to the trust property shall be conclusive evidence in favor of every person relying on or claiming under any such conveyance, or other instrument, that: (a) at the time of delivery thereof the trust created hereby and by the trust agreement was in full force and effect; (b) such conveyance or other instrument was executed in accordance with the trusts, conditions, and limitations contained herein and in the trust agreement and any amendment thereof and is binding on all beneficiaries; (c) the Trustee(s) was duly authorized to execute and deliver every deed, trust deed, lease, mortgage or other instrument; and (d) if the conveyance is made to a successor or successors in trust, that such successor or successors in trust have been properly appointed and are fully vested with all the title, estate, rights, powers, authorities, duties and obligations of the trust.

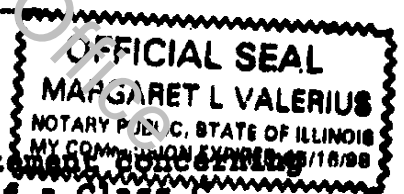
