Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property. This Surface father each category of powers fisted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the "allowing categories is retained (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with "espect to the types of property and transactions covered by the nationed category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of property or transaction class ted by the granted power or the time of exercise, whichter the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or contractual, as a joint tenant or enant in common or held in any other form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory categories (a) through (b) to make gifts of the principal's property. (c) Stock and band transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bands, mutual funds and off other types of investment securities and financial instruments); callect, hold and solidates all dividends, interest, corrings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, cartificates and other evidences of ownership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by prany, writer into voting and other evidences of ownership paid or distributed with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.

- (d) Tangible personal property transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell, lease, exchange, collect, possess and take title to all tangible personal property; move, store, ship, restore, maintain, repair, improve, manage, present, insure and safekerp tangible personal property, and in general, exercise all powers with respect to tangible personal property which the principal to local postern are usually and an original property.
- (e) Safe deposit box transactions. - (m) Borrowing transactions. The agent is authorized to: borrow money: mortgage or pledge any real estate or tangible or intangible personal property as security for such purposes; sign, renew, extend, pay and satisfy any notes or other forms of obligation; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to secured and unsecured borrowing which the principal could if present and under no disability.
