- (4) Any person who accepts or accepted any hazardous substances for transport to disposal, storage or treatment facilities or sites from which there is a release or substantial threat of a release of a hazardous substance."

2. Section 4(q) of the Act states:

"The Agency shall have the authority to provide notice to any person who may be liable pursuant to Section 22.2 (f) of this Act for a release or substantial threat of a release of a hazardous substance. Such notice shall include the identified response action and an opportunity for such person to perform the response action."

3. Section 22.2(k) of the Act states:

"If any person who is liable for a release or substantial threat of a release of a hazardous substance fails without sufficient cause to provide removal or remedial action upon or in accordance with a notice and request by the agency or upon or in accordance with any

order of the Board or any court, such person may be liable to the State for punitive damages in an amount at least equal to, and not more than 3 times, the amount of any costs incurred by the State of Illinois as a result of such failure to take such removal or remedial action. The punitive damage imposed by the Board shall be in addition to any costs recovered from such person pursuant to this Section and in addition to any other penalty or relief provided by this Act or any other law."

4. Section 22.18(a) of the Act states:

"Norwithstanding any other provision or rule or law, except as provided ornerwise in subsection (b), the owner or operator, or both, of an underground storage tank shall be liable for all costs of preventive action, corrective action and enforcement action incurred by the State of Himois as a result of a release or substantial threat of a release of petroleum from an underground storage tank."

EDA responded positively to questions 1, 3, 4, 8 ond 9. Further explanation is provided.

Between 1876 and 1980 various portions of this property functioned as a fully-integrated steel mill operated by the Wisconsin Steel Company. Title is currently held by American National Bank & trustee for the Wisconsin Steel Trust. The Economic Development Administration ("EDA") is the 90% beneficiary of the Trust and Navistar International Transportation Corp. ("Navistar") is the 10% beneficiary. In this transfer, EDA is transferring its 90% beneficial interest in the Trust to Navistar.

No steel-making operations have been conducted on the site since 1980. In 1984, EDA, as directing beneficiary, directed the demolition of the majority of above-ground structures.

demolition was conducted by Cuyahoga Wrecting Co. and National Wrecking Co. EDA sold various portions of the property in the 1980s.

In November, 1983, EDA and International Harvester Co., Inc. were notified by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("IEPA") that hazardous waste handling at the main site did not meet the requirements of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act ("RCRA"). In May, 1984, EDA submitted a RCRA Part A application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("USEPA"). IEPA deferred enforcement to USEPA, given the federal interest in the site. In September, 1984, Cuyahoga, as operator, entered into an agreed consent decree with USEPA directing the preparation by Cuyahoga of a RCRA site closure plan. In March, 1987, EDA submitted a partial closure plan to SEPA and USEPA. This plan was approved by IEPA in July, 1987. IEPA granted a series of extensions of time to finalize the closure plan, culminating in IEPA's February, 1989, indefinite extension of time for completion of RCRA closure activities pending completion of a CERCLA remedial action at the site. In November, 1990, IEPA formally notified FDA that enforcement of various Notices of Apparent Violation would be suspended and the matter deferred to USEPA for CERCLA cleanup.

In April, 1991 EDA directed the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (the Corps) to investigate and remediate the site on EDA's behalf. The Corps conducted two Rapid Response removals at the site to secure it and make it safe for investigation, the first in 1992 and the second in 1993. The Corps completed the Phase 1 Remedial Investigation in the Spring of 1994.
