MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED MAY 12, 1998, between ROBERTA A. LEVY, DIVORCED AND NOT SINCE REMARRIED, whose address is 3028 HIGHLAND AVE., WILMETTE, IL 60091 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and Hairls Bank Arlington-Meadows, whose address is 5223 Kircholf Road, Rolling Meadows, IL 60008 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgiges, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described retal property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures, all ensements, rights of way, and appurtonances; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including ateck in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in COOK County, State of Illinois (the "Real Property"):

BUILDING LOT 2A AND PARKING LOT P-2-A IN BLOCK 2, ALL IN REALCOA SKOKIE BOULEVARD RESUBDIVISION BEING A RESUBDIVISION OF PART OF UNITED REALTY COMPANY'S FIRST ADDITION TO SKOKIE BOULEVARD ADDITION TO WILMETTE IN SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 42 NORTH, RANGE 13, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 3028 HIGHLAND AVE., WILMETTE, IL 60091. The Roal Property tax identification number is 05-32-106-028.

Grantor prosently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Londer a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to deliar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful mency of the United States of America.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving line of credit agreement dated May 12, 1998, between Londor and Grantor with a credit limit of \$100,000.00, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The interest

rate under the Credit Agreement is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 8,500% per annum. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate equal to the index, subject however to the following maximum rate. Under no circumstances shall the interest rate be more than the lesser of 18,000% per annum or the maximum rate allowed by applicable law.

Existing indebtedness. The words "Existing indebtedness" mean the indebtedness described below in the Existing indebtedness section of this Mortgage.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means ROBERTA A. LEVY. The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage.

Guarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation each and all of the guarantors, sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the indebtedness.

Improvements. The word "Improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions, replacements and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The yerd "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agreement and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without limitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit and shall secure not only the arrount which Lender has presently advanced to Grantor under the Credit Agreement, but also any future procunts which Lender may advance to Grantor under the Credit Agreement within twenty (20) years from the date of this Mortgage to the same extent as if such future advance were made as of the date of the execution of this Mortgage. The revolving line of credit obligates Lender to make advances to Creator so long as Grantor compiles with all the terms of the Credit Agreement and Related Documents. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the limitation that the total cutstanding balance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such balance at a fixed or variable rate or sum as provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in this paragraph, shall not exceed the Credit Limit as provided in the Credit Agreement. It is the intention of Grantor and Lender that this Mortgage secures the balance outstanding under the Credit Agreement from time to time from zero up to the Credit Limit as provided above and any intermediate balance. At no time shall the principal amount of indebtedness secured by the Mortages, not including sums advanced to protect the security of the Mortgage, exceed \$125,000.00.

Lender. The word "Lender" means Harris Bank Arlington-Meadows, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the mortgage under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and London and includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or sixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements, lean agreements, environmental agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments, agreements and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with the indebtedness.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Duty to Maintain. Frantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and neintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superlund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Pub. L. No. 99-499-("SARA"), the Hazardous Maierials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 22 U.S.C. Section 801, ot seq., or other applicable state or Federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. The terms "hazardous waste" and "hazardous substance" shall also include, without limitation, petroleum and petroleum by perducts or any fraction thereof and asbestos. Grantor represents and varrants to Lender that: (a) During the period of Grantor's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, Seneration, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on, under, about or from the Property (b) Grantor-has no knowledged by Lender in writing, (i) any use generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardous vaste or substance on, under, about or from the Property by any prior owners or occupants of the Property or vi, any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any kind by any person-relating to such matters; and (c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (ii) neither, Grantor not any tenant, confusion, agent or other subnized with all applicables federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinarioes, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinarioes described above. Grantor authorize the Property, whether by loreclosure or otherwise.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace such improvements with improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lender's sole opinion, Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized.

Lander may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Londer, to protect Lander's interest.

Outy to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and proserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Londer's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether logal, beneficial or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by trny other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Granter is a corporation, partnership or limited liability company, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-live percent (25%) of the voting stock, partnership interests or limited liability company interests, as the case may be, of Granter. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by fillness law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and flow on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Granter shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payrell taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Granter shall maintain the Property free of all lions having priority over or equal to the interest of Londer under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Existing Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Granter may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good fall dispute over the obligation to pay, so lock as Lendor's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Granter shall within filteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fifteen (15) days after Granter has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or if recupated by Lender, deposit with Londor cash on a sufficient corporate surety band or other security satisfactory to Londor in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and atterneys' fees or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure of sale under the lien. In any contest, Granter shall defend itself and Londor and shall satisfy any adverse jurgment before enforcement against the Property. Granter shall name Lender as an additional oblighe under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Legider satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governments, official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Londer at least liftoen (15) can's before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if my mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or a merials and the cost exceeds \$10,000.00. Grantor will upon request of Londer furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a slipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for failure to give such notice. Each insurance policy also shall include an endorsement providing that coverage in favor of Lender will not be impaired in any way by any act, omission or default of Grantor or any other person. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood Insurance for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan, up to the maximum policy limits set under the National Flood Insurance Program, or as otherwise required by Lender, and to maintain such insurance for the term of the loan.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property if the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$5,000.00. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor falls to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain existing indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to the any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate provided for in the Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Granto. Title. Granter warrants that: (a) Granter holds rood and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrancis other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report, or linal title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Granter has the full right, power, and authority to execute and doliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph wove, Granter warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Granter's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Granter shall defend the action at Granter's expense. Granter may be the nominal party it, such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Granter will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

EXISTING INDESTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtodness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing Lien. The lien of this Mortgage securing the Indebtedness may be secondary and inferior to an existing lien. Granter expressly covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the paymon of, the Existing indebtedness and to provent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

No Modification. Grantor shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which that agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lender. Grantor shall neither request nor accept any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lender.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings of by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation. Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and alterneys fees incurred by Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

Current Taxes; Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Propertyl. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage: (a) Granter commits frauc or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account.
