- (c) Rents. All rents, issues, profits, royalties, avails, income and other benefits derived or owned by the Mortgagor directly or indirectly from the premises (or any portion thereof) (all of the foregoing is berein collectively called the "Rents");
- (f) Leases. All rights of the Mortgagor under all leases, licenses, occupancy agreements, concessions or other arrangements, whether written or oral, whether now existing or entered into at any time hereafter, whereby any person agrees to pay money or any consideration for the use, possession or occupancy of, or any estate in, the premises tor any portion thereof), and all rents, income, profits, benefits, avails, advantages and claims against guarantors under any thereof (all of the foregoing is herein called the "Leases");

It is understood that the enumeration of any specific items of property shall in no way exclude or be held to exclude any items of property not specifically mentioned. - 1. Maintenance, Repair and Restoration of Improvement, Fayment of Prior Liens, Etc. Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or irresitter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep said promises in good condition and repair; want waste, and free from mechanics' liens or other liens or claims for lion not expressly subordinated to the lion hereof, (e) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Mortgagee; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (e) comply with all requirements of law, municipal ordinances, or restrictions of record with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (f) make no rea erial alterations in said premises except us required by law or municipal ordinance; (g) suffer or pormit no change in the goveral nature of the occupancy of the promises, without Mortgagee's written consent; (h) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning reclassification, without Mortgagee's written consent; (i) pay each item of indebtedness secured by this Mortgage when due according to the terms hereof or of the Note; (i) not to suffer or permit any unlawful use of or any nuisance to exist upon the premises; (ii) not to diminish or impair the value of promises or the security intended to be effected by virtue of this Mortgage by any act or omission to act; (1) appear in and defend any proceeding which in the opinion of the Mortgagee affects its security here are ler, and to pay all costs, expenses and attorney's fees incurred or paid by the Mortgagee in any proceeding in which Mortgagee tracy participate in any capacity by reason of this Mortgage; (m) not suffer or permit, without Mortgageo's written consent. - 2. Sale or Transfer of Premises or Interest Thoroin. Mortgagor agrees and understands that it shall constitute an event of default under this Mortgago and the Note entitling the remedies beroin and in the Note to be exercised if (a) the Mortgagor, or any beneficiary of the Mortgagor, shall convey title to, or beneficial interest in, or otherwise suffer or permit any equitable or beneficial interest in the premises to become vested in any person or persons, firm or corporation or other entity recognized in law or equity other than the Mortgagor or the present beneficiary or beneficiaries, (b) allow any line or security interest to attach to the premises or the beneficial interest in the premises other than the lien of this Mortgage, excluding taxes and assessments not yet due and payable, (c) any articles of agreement for deed or other installment contract for deed, title or beneficial interest or land contract in the premises are entered into, or (d) any partnership interest of a partnership, if any, owning all or a portion of the beneficial interest in the Mortgagor or any

- 3. Payment of Taxes. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches all real estate taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall upon written request, furnish to Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder, Mortgagor shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagor may desire to contest.
- 4. Insurance. Mortgagor shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured, until the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage is fully paid, or in case of foreclosure, until the expiration of any period of redemption, against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as may reasonably be required by Mortgagee, including, without limitation on the generality of the foregoing, war damage insurance whenever in the opinion of Mortgagee such protection is necessary. Mortgagor shall also provide liability insurance with such limits for personal injury and death and property damage as Mortgagee may require and if required by Mortgagee, flood and rents (which will assure coverage for loss of rental income for twelve (12) consecutive months) insurance. All policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be in forms, companies and amounts satisfactory to Mortgagee, (but in no event loss than the amount needed to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby) with mortgagee clauses attached to all policies in favor of and in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, including a provision requiring that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or materially modified without ten (10) days' prior written notice to the Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall deliver all policies, including adv'ribinal and renowal policies, to Mortgagee, and, in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies no. Its than ten (10) days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

Unless Mortgagor provides encome of the insurance coverage required by this Mortgage, Mortgagee may purchase insurance at Mortgagor's expose to protect Mortgagoe's interest in the premises. The insurance may, but need not, protect Mortgagor's interests. The coverage that Mortgagoe may purchase may not pay any claim that mortgagor makes or any claim that is made against Mortgagor in connection with the premises. Mortgagor may later cancel any insurance purchased by Mortgagoe, but only after providing Mortgagoe with evidence that Mortgagor has obtained insurance as required by this Mortgagoe. If Mortgagoo perchases insurance for the premises, Mortgagor will be responsible for the costs of that insurance, including interest and the costs of the insurance, until the effective (a) of the cancellation or expiration of the insurance. The costs of the insurance may be added to Mortgagor's total one funding balance or obligation. The costs of the insurance may be more than the cost of insurance Mortgagor may be also to obtain acting alone.

5. Tax and Insurance Deposits. To more fully protect the security of this Mortgage and to provide security to the Mortgagee for the payment of real estate taxes and insurance premiums, Mortgagee agrees to pay to Mortgagee, at such place as Mortgagee may from time to time in writing appoint end in the absence of such appointment, then at the office of the Mortgagee in Chicago, Illinois, each month at the due fate for the monthly installments of principal and interest as provided for under the Note (in addition to paying the principal and interest provided for under the Note) in an amount as determined by Mortgagee, in such manner as the Mortgagee thay prescribe, to provide security for the payment of the real estate taxes and insurance premiums.

If at any time the amount of the real estate taxes or insurance premiums are increased or Mortgagee receives information that the same will be increased, or if the monthly deposits then being made by Mortgager for this purpose (if continued) would not make up a fund sufficient in the opinion of the Mortgager to pay such item 60 days prior to its normally scheduled installment due date, said monthly deposits shall thereupon be increased and Mortgager shall deposit immediately with Mortgagee on demand such additional sums as are determined by the Mortgagee so that the posmeys then on hand for the payment of said item plus the increased monthly payments and such additional sums demanded shall be sufficient so that Mortgagee shall have received from Mortgager adequate amounts to pay such item at least 60 days before the normally scheduled installment due date. For the purpose of determining whether Mortgagee has an hand sufficient moneys to pay any particular item at least 60 days prior to the due date therefore, deposits for each item shall be treated separately, it being the intention that Mortgagee shall not be obligated to use moneys deposited for the payment of an item not yet due and payable for the payment of an item had and payable.

Notwithstanding the furegoing, it is understood and agreed (a) that deposits provided for hereunder may be held by Mortgagee in a single non-interest bearing account, and (b) that Mortgagee at its option may, if Mortgagor fails to make any deposit required hereunder, use deposits for one item for the payment of another item then due and payable. All such deposits shall be held in escraw by Mortgagee and shall be applied by Mortgagee to the payment of the said real estate taxes and insurance premiums when the same become due and payable. Failure to pay any of the aforesaid monthly deposits for 10 days after they are due or failure to pay any of the aforesaid additional deposits for 5 days after demand by Mortgagee, shall be an event of default under the Note secured by this Mortgage and under this Mortgage, in which event all remedies under the Note secured by this Mortgage may be immediately exercised by the Mortgagee and, further, all moneys on hand in the deposit fund may, at the option of Mortgagee, be applied in reduction of the indebtedness under the Note secured by this Mortgage.

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If the funds so deposited exceed the amount required to pay such taxes for any year, the excess shall be applied on a subsequent deposit or deposits. The Mortgagor further agrees that Mortgagoe shall not be required to make payments for which insufficient funds are on deposit with the Mortgagoe. Mortgagor agrees that nothing herein contained shall be construed as requiring the Mortgagoe to advance other monies for such purpose and the Mortgagoe shall not incur any liability for anything it may do or omit to do.

Upon an assignment of this Mortgage, Mortgagee shall have the right to pay over the balance of such deposits in its possession to the assignee and Mortgagee shall thereupon be completely released from all liability with respect to such deposits and Mortgager shall look solely to the assignee or transferee with respect thereto. This provision shall apply to every transfer of such deposits to a new assignee. Upon full payment of the indebtedness under the Note secured by this Mortgage and the Mortgage (or at any prior time at the election of the then holder of the Note and this Mortgage) the balance of the deposits in its possession shall be paid over to the record owner of the premises within a reasonable time period following payment and no other party shall have any right or claim thereto in any event,

6. Hazardous Material; Indomnification. Neither Mortgagor nor, to the best knowledge of Mortgagor, any other person or entity has ever caused or permitted, and Mortgagor will not at any time cause or permit, a Reportable Quantity (as hereinafter defined) to be placed, held, located or disposed of on, under or at the premises, or my part thereof, or to be unlawfully transported from the premises, or to be transported from the premises and unlawfully placed, held, located or disposed of on, under or at any other site or property (by whomsoever owned), or to be released in to the atmosphere or any watercourse, body of water or wetlands, or to be disposed of in any place or manner which, with the assage of time or the giving of notice or beth, would give rise to liability (or potential liability) under any Environmental L (32) (as hereinafter defined). Neither the premises nor any part thereof, has ever been used (whether by Mortgagor or, to the best knowledge of Mortgagor, by any other person or entity), and Mortgagor will not use or permit the premises, or any part thereof, to be used, as a treatment, storage or disposal (whether permanent or temporary) site for any Hazardous Material.

Mortgagor hereby indemnifies Mortgagee and agrees to hold Mortgagee harmless from and against any and all losses, liabilities, damages, fines, penalties, injuries, easts, expenses and claims of any and every kind whatsoever (including, without limitation, attorneys' and paralegals be stud other legal expenses) which at any time or from time to time may be paid, incurred or suffered by, or asserted against. Mortgagee for, with respect to, or as a direct or indirect result of, the presence on, at or under the premises, or, following colocation thereof from the premises, the presence on, at or under any other site or property, or the escape, scopage, leakage, spillage, discharge, emission or release from the premises into or upon any land, the atmosphere, or any watercourse, body of water or wetland, of any Hazardous Material (including, without limitation, any losses, liabilities, damages, lines, or adties, injuries, costs, expenses or claims asserted or arising under any Environmental Laws.) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Mortgage, the Note or any other instrument or document, the provisions of and undertakings and materialization set out in this provision shall survive the satisfaction and release of this Mortgage and the payment and satisfaction of all indebtedness secured by this Mortgage, and shall continue in effect forever.

"Hazardous Material" means and includes any hazardous, toxic or dangerous substance or any pollutant or contaminant defined as such in, or for purpose of, any Environmental Laws. "Reportable Quantity," means, with respect to any Hazardous Material, a reportable quantity of such Hazardous Material as specified in , or for purposes of, any Environmental Laws. "Environmental Laws" means the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, any so-called "Superfund" or "Superfien" law, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, the Clean Valter Act, the Toxic Substances Control Act, the Illinois Responsible Property Transfer Act or any other existing or future federal, state or local stature, law, ordinance, code, rule, regulation, order or decree, regulating, relating to, or imposing liability or standards of conduct or remediation concerning any hazardous, toxic or dangerous waste, substance or material, each as not or hereafter in effect.

- 7. Mortgageo's Interest In and Use of Deposits. In the event of a default in any of the previsions contained in this mortgage or in the Note, the Mortgageo may at its option, without being required to do so, apply 600 moneys at the time on deposit pursuant to paragraph 5 horsel, as any one or more of the same may be applicable, on any of Mortgagor's obligations berein or in the Note contained, in such order and manner as the Mortgageo may elect. When the indebtedness secured hereby has been fully paid, any remaining deposits shall be paid to Mortgageor or to the then owner or owners of the mortgaged premises within a reasonable period of time. Such deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the indebtedness hereunder and shall be held in trust to be irrevocably applied by the Mortgageo for the purposes for which made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of the Mortgagor; provided, however, that the Mortgageo shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes and insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgagor, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested Mortgageo in writing not less than thirty (30) days prior to the due date therefore to make application of such lands to the payment of the particular taxes or insurance promiums for payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes and insurance premiums.
- 8. Mortgagee's Right to Act. If Mortgagor fails to pay any claim, lien or encumbrance which shall have a prior lien to the lien of this indenture, or to pay, when due, any tax or assessment, or any insurance premium, or to keep

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the promises in repair, as aforesaid, or shall commit or permit waste, or if there be commenced any action or proceeding affecting the premises or the title thereto, then Mortgagee, at its option, may pay such claim, lien, encumbrance, tax, assessment or promium, with right of subrogation thereunder, may procure such abstracts or other evidence of title as it deems necessary, may make such repairs and take such steps as it deems advisable to prevent or cure such waste, and may appear in any such action or proceeding and retain counsel therein, and take such action therein as Mortgagee deems advisable, and for any of such purposes Mortgagee may advance such sums of money as it deems necessary. Mortgagee shall be the sole judge of the legality, validity and priority of any such claim, lien, encambrance, tax, assessment and premium, and of the amount necessary to be paid in satisfaction thereof. Mortgager will pay to Mortgagee, immediately and without demand, all sums of money advanced by Mortgagee pursuant to this paragraph, together with interest on each such advance at the rate set forth in the Note, and all such sums and interest thereon shall be secured hereby.

Adjustment of Losses with Insurer and Application of Proceeds of Insurance. In case of loss, the Mortgagee (or after entry of decree of foreclosure, purchaser at the sale, or the decree creditor, as the case may be) is heroby authorized either (a) to settlo, collect, compromise and adjust, in its discretion any claim under such insurance policies without consent of Mortgagor, or (b) to allow Mortgagor to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss. In either case Mortgagee is authorized to collect and receipt for any such insurance money. Mortgagor agrees to sign, upon demand by Mortgageo, all receipts, vouchers and releases required of him by the companies. If (a) Mortgagor is obligated to restore or replace the damaged or destroyed buildings or improvements under the terms of any lease or leases which are or may be prior to the lien of this Mortgage, (b) such damage or destruction does not result in cancellation or termination of such louse, (c) the insurers do not dony liability as to the insureds, and (d) such proceeds are sufficient to extere or replace the damaged or destroyed buildings or improvements in the judgement of Mortgageo, such proceeds, Wer deducting therefrom any expenses incurred in the collection thereof, shall be used to reimburse Mortgagor for the cost of rebuilding or restoration of buildings and improvements of said premises. In all other cases, such insurance proceeds may at the option of Mortgagee, either be applied in reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not, or be hold by the Mortgagee and used to reimburse Mortgagor for the cost of the rebuilding or restoration of buildings or improvements or said premises. The buildings and improvements shall be so restored or rebuilt as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. In the event Mortgagor is entitled to reimbursement out of insurance proceeds, or, if Mortgagee elects to permit reimbursement out of insurance proceeds, such proceeds shall be made exailable, from time to time, upon the Moctgagee being farmished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of combbition thereof and with such architect's certificates, waivers of lien. contractors' sworn statements and other eyidence of cost ray of payments as the Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve, and if the estimated cost of the work exceeds ten percent (10%) of the original principal amount of the indebtodness secured hereby, with all plans and specifications for such rebuilding or restoration as the Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve, no payment made prior to the final completion of the Sork shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed, from time to time, and at all times the undisbursed induce of said proceeds remaining in the hands of the Mortgagee shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work free and clear of liens. In the case where insurance proceeds are used for reimbarsement, Mortgagor agrees to pay Mortgagee its out of pocket fees and expenses and its inspection and processing fees.

In the case of loss after forcelosure proceedings have been instituted, the proceeds of any such insurance policy or policies, if not applied as aforesaid in rebuilding or restoring the buildings of improvements, shall be used to pay the amount due in accordance with any decree of forcelosure that may be entered in any such proceedings, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the owner of the equity of redemption if he shall then be entired to the same or as the court may direct. In case of the forcelosure of this mortgage, the court in its decree may provide that the mortgages's chause attached to each of said insurance policies may be canceled and that the decree creditor may [aus : a new loss chause to be attached to each of said policies making the loss thereunder payable to said creditor; and any and of each case made and provided, that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the statute of such case made and provided, then and in every such case, each sucressive redemptor may cause the preceding loss or as attached to each insurance policy to be canceled and a new loss clause to be attached thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to such redemptor. In the event of forcelosure sale, Mortgages is hereby authorized, without the consent of Mortgager, to assign any and all insurance policies to the purchaser at the sale, or to take such other steps as Mortgagee may deem advisable, to cause the interest of such purchaser to be protected by any of the said insurance policies.

- 10. Stamp, Transfor or Revenue Tax. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state having jurisdiction over the Mortgagor or the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note or this Mortgago or the recordation thereof, the Mortgagor covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagor further covenants to hold harmless and agrees to indemnify the Mortgagoe, its successor or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any such tax.
- 11. Propayment Privilege. At such time as the Mortgagor is not in default either under the terms of the Note or under the terms of this Mortgago, the Mortgagor shall have such privilege of making prepayments on the principal of the Note (in addition to the required payments) as may be provided in the Note, and in accordance with the terms and conditions, if any, set forth in the Note.

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- the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefore, or interested fin said premises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and full provisions becoof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.
- In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of the state in which the premises are located deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien hereon, for imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein trequired to be paid by Mortgagee, or changing in any way laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagees interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this Mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then, and in any such event, the Mortgager, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgagee therefore; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgager to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest in excess of the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to the Maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to the Maximum amount permitted by law independences secured hereby to be and beginned due and payable sixty (60) days from the date of giving of such notice.
 - 14. Mortgageo's i's formance of Defaulted Acts. In case of default therein, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgager in any form and manner deemed expedient by Mortgagee, and may, but need not, make letter partial payments of principal or interest on prior ancumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and affecting said reincurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of interest then applicable to the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on excount of any default on the part of Mortgager.
 - 15. Mortgagee's Reliance on Tax and Invarince Bills, Etc. Mortgagee in making any payment is hereby authorized; (a) to pay any taxes, assessments and making nee premiums, according to any bill, statement or estimate produced from the appropriate public office or vendor without or, viry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, insurance premiums, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof; or (b) to purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any other prior lien, without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted.
- 16. Acceleration of Indebtedness in Case of Default. If we of the following occur: (a) default be made for fifteen (15) days in the due and punctual payment of the Note, or any instrument due in accordance with the terms thereof, either of principal or interest; or (b) the Mortgagor shall file a petition in exhantary bankruptcy under the United States Bankruptcy Code or any similar law, state or federal, whether now or hereafter existing, or an answer admitting insolvency or inability to pay its dobts, or fail to obtain a vacation or stay of involuntary proceedings within the (10) days, as hereinafter provided; or (e) the Mortgagor shall be adjudicated a bankrupt, or a receiver or a receiver shall be appointed for the Mortgagor or for all of its proporty or the major part thereof in any involutiony proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction of the property of the Mortgagor or the major part thereof in a 17 involuntary proceeding for the reorganization, dissolution, liquidation or winding up of the Mortgagor, and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacatud or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within; (en (10) days; or (d) the Mortgagor shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or shall admit in writing its it ability to pay its debts generally as they become due, or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or it addator of all of its property or the major part thereof; or (o) default shall be made in the due observance or performance of any other of the covenants, agreements or conditions bereinbefore or hereinafter contained, required to be kept or pe. Formed or observed by the Mortgagor and the same shall continue for three (3) days; or (f) a default or event of default excars under any other loan, secured or unsecured, or other agreement made by Mortgagee to Mortgager (and/or any beneficiary of Mortgagor) or any agreement between Mortgagee and Mortgagor (and/or any beneficiary of Mortgagor) or to any guarantor of this loan, then and in every such case the whole of said principal sum hereby secured shall, at once, at the option of the Mortgagee, become immediately due and payable, together with accrued interest thereon, without notice to Mortgagor.
- 17. Foreclosure; Exponse of Litigation. When the indobtedness hereby secured, or any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such indebtedness or part thereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title sourches and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title and any other expenses as Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or

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to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned, and such expenses and fees an may be incurred in the protection of said premises and the maintenance of the lien of this mortgage, including the fees of any attorney employed by Mortgagee in any litigation or proceeding affecting this Mortgage, the Note or said premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparations for the continencement or defense of any proceeding or threatened suit or proceedings, whether or not actually commenced, shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, with interest thereon at the rate applicable to the indebtodness secured by this Mortgage and the same shall be secured by this Mortgage.

- 18. Application of Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority; First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagor, its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 19. Appointment of Receiver. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Mortgage, the court in which each complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the new value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the horizoge hereunder or any holder of the Note may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the londs, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and in ease of a sale and a delicierzy, thiring the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, manager, as and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the not income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of:

 (a) the indebtedness secured hereby, or by at y decree foreclosing this Mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien become of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (b) the deficiency in case of a sale, and deficiency.
- 20. Assignment of Rents and Lonsos. To further secure the induhtedness secured hereby, Mortgagor does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto the Mortgagee all the rents, issues and profits now due and which may hereafter become due under or by virtue of any lease, whether written or verbal, or any letting of, or of any agreement for the use or occupancy of the premises or any part thereof, which may have been hereology or may be hereafter made or agreed to or which may be made or agreed to by the Mortgagee under the powers herein granted. It doing the intention hereby to establish an absolute transfer and assignment of all of such leases and agreements, and all of the avails theremaier, unto the Mortgagee, and Mortgager does hereby appoint irrevocably the Mortgagee its true and lawled attorney in its name and stead (with or without taking possession of the premises as provided herein) to rent, lease or let all or any portion of said premises to any party or parties at such rental and upon such terms as said Mortgagee shall in its discretion, determine, and to collect all of said avails, rents, issues and profits arising from or accruing at any time hereafter, and all now due or that may hereafter become due under each and every of the leases and agreements, written or verbal, or other tenancy existing, or which may hereafter exist on said premises, with the same rights and powers and subject or the same immunities, exoveration of liability and rights of recourse and indemnity as the Mortgagee would have upon taking possession pursuant to the provisions herein.

The Mortgagor represents and agrees that no rent has been or will be paid by any person in possession of any portion of the above described premises for more than one installment in advance and that the payment of some of the rents to accrue for any portion of the said premises has been or will be waived, released, reduced, disci unced or otherwise (discharged or compromised by the Mortgagor. The Mortgagor waives any rights of set-off against any person in possession of any portion of the above described promises. Mortgagor agrees that it will not assign any of the rents or profits of said premises, except to a purchaser or grantee of the premises.

Nothing berein contained shall be construed as constituting the Mortgagee a mortgagee in possession in the absence of the taking of actual possession of the premises by the Mortgagee pursuant to the provisions herein. In the exercise of the power berein grunted the Mortgagee, no liability shall be asserted or enforced against the Mortgagee, all such liability being expressly waived and released by Mortgagor.

The Mortgagor further agrees to assign and transfer to the Mortgagee all future leases upon all or any part of the promises heroinabove described and to execute and deliver, at the request of the Mortgagee, all such further assurances and assignments in the promises as the Mortgagee shall from time to time require,

Although it is the intention of the parties that the assignment contained herein shall be a present assignment, it is expressly understood and agreed, anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding, that the Mortgagee shall not exercise any of the rights or powers conferred upon it by this paragraph until a default shall exist hereunder.

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24. Mortgagoe's Right of Possession in Case of Default. In any case in which under the provisions of this Mortgage the Mortgagee has a right to institute foreclosure proceedings, whether before or after the whole principal Sum secured hereby is declared to be immediately due as aforesaid, or whether before or after the institution of legal sproceedings to forcelose the lien bereaf or before or after sale theremader, forthwith, upon demand of Mortgagee, Mortgager Eshall surrender to Mortgagee and Mortgagee shall be entitled to take actual possession of the premises or any part thereto personally, or by its agents or attorneys, as for condition broken, and Mortgagee in its discretion may, with or without I force and with or without process of law, enter upon and take and maintain possession of all or any part of said premises, together with all documents, books, records, papers and accounts of the Mortgagor or then owner of the premises relating Thereto, and may exclude the Mortgagor, its agents or servants, wholly therefrom and may as attorney in fact or agent of Tthe Mortgagor, or in its own name as Mortgagee and under the powers herein granted, hold, operate, manage and control the premises and conduct the business, if any, thereof, either personally or by its agents and with full power to use such measures, legal or equitable, as in its discretion or in the discretion of its successors or assigns may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the avails, ronts issues, and profits of the promises, including actions for the recovery of rent, actions in forcible detainer and actions in distress for rent, hereby granting full power and authority to exercise each and every of the rights, privileges and powers berein granted at any and all times bereafter, without notice to the Mortgagor, and with full power to cancel or terminate any lease or sublense for any cause or on any ground which would ortitle Mortgagor to cancel the same, to elect to disaffirm any lease or sublease made subsequent to this Mortgage or subordinated to the lient hereof, to make all necessary or proper repairs, decorating, renewals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments and improvements to the premises as to it may seem judicious, insure and reinsure the sume and all risks incidented to Mortgagee's possession, operation and management thereof and to receive all of such avails. rents, issues and profits.

The Mortgagee shall not be obligeted to perform or discharge, nor does it hereby undertake to perform or discharge, any obligation, duty or liability and or any leases, and the Mortgagee shall and does hereby agree to indemnify and hold the Mortgagee harmless of and from any, and all liability, loss or damage which it may or might incur under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment the sol and of and from any and all claims and demands whatsoever which may be asserted against it by reason of any alleged on actions or undertakings on its part to perform or discharge any of the terms, covenants or agreements contained in said leases. Should the Mortgagee incur any such liability, loss or damage, under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment thereof, or in the defense of any claims or demands, the amount thereof, including costs, expenses and reasonable afterney's fees, shall be secured bereby, and the Mortgager shall reimburse the Mortgagee therefore immediately upon demand.

- 22. Application of Income Received by Martgageo. The Martgageo in the exercise of the rights and powers herein conferred shall have full power to use and apply the avails, rents, issues and profits of the premises to the payment of or an account of the following, in such order as the Martgageo may determine:
 - (a) to the payment of the operating expenses of said proversy, including cost of management and leasing thereof (which shall include reasonable compensation to the Mortezgoe and its agent or agents, if management be delegated to an agent or agents, and shall also include lease examissions and other compensation and expenses of seeking and procuring tenants and entering into leases) established claims for damages, if any, and premiums on insurance hereinabove authorized;
 - (b) to the payment of taxes and special assessments now due or which may here after become due on said premises;
 - (c) to the payment of all repairs, decorating, renewals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments, and improvements of said premises, including the cost from time to time of installing or reprecing refrigeration and gas or electric stoves therein, and of placing said property in such condition as will, in the judgment of the Mortgagee, make it readily rentable;
 - (d) to the payment of any indebtisfness secured hereby or any deficiency which may result from any foreclosure sale,
- 23. Mortgagoo's Right of Inspection. Mortgagee shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 24. Late Charge. In the event the Mortgagee shall, from time to time, accept payment of any installment required on the Note and under this Mortgage which is in arrears, Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" as provided for in the Note to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments; provided, however, that nothing in this paragraph contained shall authorize the Mortgagee to collect or demand any payment which would result in the imposition of interest in excess of the maximum amount allowed by law.
- 25. Condemnation. Mortgagor bereby assigns, transfers and sets over unto Mortgagee the entire proceeds of any award or any claim for damages for any of the mortgaged property taken or damaged under the power of eminent domain or by condemnation. Mortgageo may elect to apply the proceeds of the award upon or in reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, whother due or not, or to require Mortgagor to restore or rebuild, in which event the proceeds shall be held by Mortgagee and used to reinburso Mortgagor for the cost of the rebuilding or restoring of buildings or improvements on said premises, in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted to and approved by Mortgagee. If the Mortgagor is

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obligated to restore or replace the damaged or destroyed buildings or improvements under the terms of any lease or lease which are or may be prior to the lien of this Mortgage and if such taking does not result in cancellation or termination of such lease, the award shall be used to reimburse Mortgagor for the cost of the rebuilding or restoring of buildings or improvements on said premises, provided Mortgagor is not then in default under this Mortgage. In the event Mortgagor is required or authorized, either by Mortgagoe's election as aforesaid, or by virtue of any such lease, to rebuild or restore the proceeds of the award shall be paid out in the same manner as is provided herein for the payment of insurance proceeds toward the cost of rebuilding or restoration. If the amount of such award is insufficient to cover the cost of rebuilding or restoration, Mortgagor shall pay such cost in excess of the award, before being entitled toreimbursement out of the award. Any surplus which may remain out of said award after payment of such cost of rebuilding or restoration shall, at the option of Mortgagee, be applied on account of the indebtedness secured hereby or be paid to any other party entitled thereto. In applying the proceeds of any award on account of the indebtedness secured hereby, Mortgagee shall be entitled to collect, out of the proceeds of the award, a promium on the amount prepaid, at the same rate as though Mortgagor had elected at the time of such application of proceeds for if Mortgagor than has no such election, at the first succeeding date on which Mortgagor could so elect) to prepay the indebtedness in accordance with the terms of the Note secured hereby.

- 26. Rolense upon Payment and Discharge of Mortgagor's Obligations. Mortgagee shall release this mortgage and the lien thereof by proper sestrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby and payment of a reasonable fee to Mortgagee for the proparation and execution of such release.
- 27. Giving of Notice. Any notice which either party hereta may desire or be required to give to the other party shall be in writing and the mailing thereof by certified mail addressed to the Mortgagor at the mortgaged premises (designated by street address) or to the Mortgagee, at its principal office in Chicago, Illinois to the attention of the office of the Vice President in charge of commercial/multi-family real estate loans and specifying the loan number, or at such other place within the United States as any party hereto may by notice in writing designate as a place for service of notice, shall constitute service of notice hereunder. Any notice given by the Mortgagee shall be deemed given on the date the same is deposited in the United States mail.
- 28. Waiver of Defense. No action for the onforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the purty interposing same in an action at law upon the Note hereby secured.
- 29. Waiver of Statutory Rights. Mortgagor shar not and will not apply for or avail itself of any appraisement, valuation, stay, extension or exemption laws, or any so-ceden "Moratorium Laws", now existing or hereafter enacted, in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement or foreclosure of Dis Mortgago, but hereby waives the benefit of such laws. Mortgagor for itself and all who may claim through or under it entires any and all right to have the property and estates comprising the mortgagod property marshalled upon any foreclosure of the lien hereof and agrees that any court having jurisdiction to foreclose such lien may order the mortgagod property sublass an entirety. Mortgagor and Mortgagee agree that all disputes between them arising out of, in a connection with, related to, or incidental to this Mortgage, and whether arising in contract, tort, equity or otherwise, a shall be resolved only by state or federal courts located in Cook County, Illinois, but the parties acknowledge that any appeals from those courts may have to be heard by a court located outside of Cook County, Illinois.
