III. NOTIFICATION

(1) The owner and operator of a facility or vessel from which there is a release or substantial threat of release of a hazardous substance;

- (2)Any person who at the time of disposal, transport, storage or treatment of a hazardous substance owned or operated the facility or vessel used for such disposal, transport, treatment or storage from which there was a release or substantial threat of a release of any such hazardous substance;
- (3)Any person who by contract, agreement, or otherwise has arranged with another party or entity for transport, storage, disposal or treatment of hazardous substances owned, controlled or possessed by such person at a facility there is a release or substantial threat of a release of such hazardous substances; and
- (4) Any person who accepts or accepted any hazardous substances for transport to disposal, storage or treatment facilities or sites from which there is a release of a substantial threat of a release of a hazardous substance."

Section 4(2) of the Act states: 2

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"The Agency shall have the authority to provide notice to any person who may be liable pursuant to Section 22.20) of this Act for a release or a substantial threat of a release of a hazardous subsence. Such notice shall include the identified response action and an opportunity for such person to perform the response 30UNI action."

3. Section 22.2(k) of the Act states:

"If any person who is liable for a release or substartant threat of release of a hazardous substance fails without sufficient cause to provide removal or remedial action upon or in accordance with a notice and request by the agency or upon or in accordance with any order of the Board or any court, such person may be liable to the State for punitive damages in an amount at least equal to, and let more than 3 times, the amount of any costs incurred by the State of Illinois as result of such failure to take such removal or remedial action. The punitive damage imposed by the Board shall be in addition to any costs recovered from such person pursuant to this Section and in addition to any other penulty or relief provided by this Act w any other law."

4. Section 22.18(a) of the Act states:

"Notwithstanding any other provision or rule or law, except as provided otherwise in subsection (b), the owner or operator, or both, of an underground storage tank shall be liable for all costs of preventive action, corrective action and enforcement action incurred by the State of Illinois as a result of a release or a substantial threat of release of petroleum from an underground storage tank."
