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6. TITLE:

(a) At the time of closing the premises shall be clear of all liens, encumbrances, or charges, except those in the power of seller's expense as set forth in the Duplicate Certificate of Title issued by the Register of Titles and Securities for the State of Illinois or a commitment issued by a title insurance company licensed to do business in Illinois, to issue a contract containing the insurance policy on the current form of *Illinois Land Title Association Owner's Policy* (or equivalent policy) in the amount of the purchase price covering the date hereof, subject only to: (1) the general exceptions contained in the policy, unless the real estate is improved with a single family dwelling or an apartment building of four or fewer residential units; (2) the "permitted exceptions" set forth in paragraph 2; (3) prior mortgages permitted in paragraph 6; (4) other title exceptions pertaining to liens or encumbrances or a debt of an ascertainable amount, which may be removed by the payment of money, and which shall be removed at or prior to the initial closing and (5) acts done or suffered by or judgments against the Buyer, or those claiming by, through or under the Buyer.

(b) If the title commitment discloses unpermitted exceptions, the Seller shall have thirty (30) days from the date of delivery thereof to have the said exceptions waived, or to have the title insurer commit to insure against loss or damage that may be caused by such exceptions and the initial closing shall be delayed, if necessary, during said 30 day period to allow Seller time to have said exceptions waived. If the Seller fails to have unpermitted exceptions waived, or in the alternative, to obtain a commitment for title insurance specified above as to such exceptions, within the specified time, the Buyer may terminate the contract between the parties, or may elect, upon notice to the Seller, within ten (10) days after the expiration of the thirty (30) day period, to take the title as it stands, with the right to deduct from the purchase price, fees or encumbrances of a definite or ascertainable amount, if the Buyer elects to elect, the contract between the parties shall become null and void, without further action of the parties, and all monies paid by Buyer hereunder shall be refunded.

(c) Every title commitment which conforms with subparagraph "(b)" shall be conclusive evidence of good title therein shown, as to all matters insured by the policy, subject only to special exceptions therein stated.

(d) If a Special Tax Search, Title Search, a Judgment Search or the title commitment disclose judgments against the Buyer which may become items, the Seller may declare this Agreement null and void and all earnest money shall be forfeited by the Buyer.

The buyer's taking possession of the premises shall be conclusive evidence that buyer in all respects accepts and is satisfied with the physical condition of the premises, all matters shown on the survey and the condition of title to the premises as shown to him on or before the initial closing. Seller shall upon said delivery of possession have no further obligation with respect to the title or to furnish further evidence thereof, except that Seller shall remove any exception or defect not permitted under paragraph 2(a) resulting from acts done or suffered by, or judgments against the Seller between the initial closing and the final closing.

5. AFFIDAVIT OF TITLE: Seller shall furnish Buyer, at or prior to the initial closing and, again, prior to final closing with an *Affidavit of Title*, covering and dated, subject only to those permitted exceptions set forth in paragraph 2, prior mortgages permitted in paragraph 6 and unpermitted exceptions, if any, as to which the title insurer commits to extend insurance in the amount specified in paragraph 8. In the event title to the property is held in trust, the *Affidavit of Title* required to be furnished by Seller shall be signed by the Trustee and the beneficiaries or beneficiaries of said trust. All parties shall execute an *ALTA Loan and Evidence Coverage Owner's Policy Statement* and other other documents as are customary or required by the issuer of the commitment for title insurance.

6. HOME OWNERS ASSOCIATION:

(a) If the above premises are subject to a townhouse, condominium or other homeowner's association, Seller shall, prior to the initial closing, furnish Buyer a statement from the Board of managers, treasurer or managing agent of the association certifying payment of assessments and, if applicable, prior or waiver or termination of any right of first refusal or pre-emption contained in the declaration of covenants together with any other documents required by the declaration or bylaws thereof as a pre-condition to the transfer of ownership.

(b) The buyer shall comply with any covenants, conditions, restrictions or declarations or covenants with respect to the premises as well as the bylaws, rules and regulations of any applicable association.

7. PRORATION: If insurance premiums, general taxes, association assessments and, if final meter readings cannot be obtained, water and sewer charges, if not adjusted ratably as of the date of initial closing, Real estate taxes for the year of possession shall be prorated as of the date of initial closing, subject to repayment upon receipt of the actual tax bill. Interest on the unpaid principal amount of the purchase price from the initial closing date until the date of the first installment payment shall be a proration credit in favor of the Seller.

8. ESCROW CLOSING: At the election of Seller or Buyer, upon notice to the other party not less than five (5) days prior to the date of either the initial or final closing, this transaction or the conveyance contemplated hereby shall be made through escrow with a title company, by a bank or other institution or an attorney licensed to do business or to practice in the State of Illinois in accordance with the general provision for an express trust, covering articles of agreement for deed consistent with the terms of this Agreement. Upon creation of such escrow, anything in this Agreement to the contrary notwithstanding, installments of payment due thereafter and delivery of the Deed shall be made through escrow. 9. SELLER'S REPRESENTATIONS:

(a) Seller expressly warrants to Buyer that no notice from any city, village or other governmental authority of a dwelling code violation which existed in the dwelling structure on the premises herein described before this Agreement was executed, has been received by the seller, his principal or his agent within ten (10) years of the date of execution of this Agreement.

(b) Seller represents that all equipment and appliances to be conveyed, including but not limited to the following, are in operating condition: all mechanical equipment; heating and cooling equipment; water heaters and softeners; septic, plumbing, and electrical systems; kitchen equipment remaining with the premises and all miscellaneous mechanical personal property to be transferred to the Buyer; upon the Buyer's request prior to the time of possession, Seller shall demonstrate to the Buyer or his representative all said equipment and upon receipt of written notice of deficiency shall promptly and at Seller's expense correct the deficiency. IN THE ABSENCE OF WRITTEN NOTICE OF ANY DEFICIENCY FROM THE BUYER PRIOR TO THE DATE SPECIFIED FOR INITIAL CLOSING, IT SHALL BE CONCLUDED THAT THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE EQUIPMENT IS SATISFACTORY TO THE BUYER AND THE SELLER SHALL HAVE NO FURTHER RESPONSIBILITY WITH RESPECT THERETO.

(c) Seller agrees to leave the premises in broom clean condition. All fixtures and personal property, not to be delivered to Buyer shall be removed from the premises at Seller's expense before the date of initial closing.

10. SELLER'S MAINTAINANCE: buyer shall keep the improvements on premises and the grounds in a clean and repairable condition as they now exist, ordinary wear and tear excepted. Buyer shall make all necessary repairs and renew all improvements on premises including by way of exterior and interior insulation, interior and exterior painting and decorating, windows, glass, hardware, ventilating and air conditioning equipment, incinerators and electrical systems and fixtures; roof; masonry, including chimneys and fireplaces, etc. It, however, the said premises shall not be made and in good repair, and in a clean, sanitary, and healthy condition by Buyer. Seller may enter (a) onto same, himself, or by other agents, servants, or employees, without such entering causing or constituting a violation of this Agreement or an interference with normal possession of the premises, and make the necessary repairs and do all work on same, to place said premises in good repair and a clean, sanitary, and healthy condition, and Buyer agrees to pay to Seller, as to such additional purchase price for the premises, the expenses of the Seller in making said repairs and in placing the premises in a clean, sanitary, and healthy condition, or (b) notify the Buyer to have such repairs and to place said premises in a clean, sanitary, and healthy condition, within thirty (30) days of such notice (except as otherwise provided in paragraph 21), and, upon default by Buyer in complying with said notice, then, Seller may avail himself of such remedies as Seller may elect, if any, from those that are by this Agreement or at law or equity provided.

11. FIXTURES AND EQUIPMENT: At the time of delivery of possession of the premises to Buyer, Seller shall receive possession of the personal property to be sold to Buyer pursuant to the terms of this Agreement as well as of the fixtures and equipment permanently attached to the improvements on the premises, but until payment in full of the purchase price where no title to some of such personal property, fixtures or equipment shall be removed from the premises without the prior written consent of the Seller.

12. INSURANCE:

(a) Buyer shall from and after the time specified in paragraph 5 for possession, keep insured against loss or damage by fire or other causes, the improvements now and hereafter erected on premises with a company, or companies, reasonably acceptable to Seller in policies conforming to Insurance Service Bureau Homeowners Form 2 ("H.O.3") and, also, hold insurance where applicable, with coverage not less than the balance of the purchase price hereof (except that if the full insurable value of such improvements is less than the balance of purchase price, then at such full insurable value) for the benefit of the parties hereto and the interests of any mortgagee or trustee, if any, as their interests may appear; such policy or policies shall be held by Seller, and Buyer shall pay the premium thereon when due.

(b) In case of loss of or damage to such improvements, whether before or after possession is given hereunder, any insurance proceeds to which either or both of the parties hereto shall be entitled on account thereof, shall be used (i) in the event the insurance proceeds are sufficient to fully reconstruct or restore such improvements, to pay for the restoration or reconstruction of such damage or lost improvement, or (ii) in the event the insurance proceeds are not sufficient to fully reconstruct or restore such improvements, then the proceeds of insurance shall be applied to the unpaid balance of purchase price.

13. TAXES AND CHARGES: It shall be the Buyer's obligation to pay immediately when due and payable and prior to the date when the same shall become delinquent all general and special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges and other rates, fees, rents, homeowners association assessments and charges now or hereafter levied or assessed or charged against the premises or any part thereof, or any improvements thereon, including those heretofore due and to furnish Seller with the original or duplicate receipts therefore.

14. FUNDS FOR TAXES AND CHARGES: In addition to the agreed installments, if any, provided in paragraph 3, Buyer shall deposit with Seller on the day each installment payment is due, or if none are provided for, on the first day of each month subsequent to the date of initial closing, until the purchase price is paid in full, a sum (herein referred to as "funds") equal to one-twelfth of the yearly taxes, assessments, which may become a lien on the premises, and the estimated annual premiums for the insurance coverages required to be paid and maintained by Buyer, all as reasonably estimated to provide sufficient sums for the full payment of such charges one month prior to their becoming due and payable. Failure to make the deposits required hereunder shall constitute a breach of this Agreement.

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The funds shall be held by Seller in an account, the deposits of which are insured by the insurance of Federal or state agencies. Seller is responsible for the collection of the amounts due him, assessments, rents and contributions. Seller shall hold the funds of the Buyer, giving the Buyer a non-interesting, non-chargeable cash fund deposit, and disbursing the same to the Buyer for the amounts so disbursed. The funds are hereby pledged as additional security to the Seller for the payment of the purchase price.

3. THE AMOUNT OF THE FUNDS together with the future periodic deposits of such funds payable prior to the due date of the aforementioned charges, shall exceed the amount reasonably estimated as being required to pay said charges one month prior to the time at which they fall due. Such excess shall be applied first to carry any breach in the performance of the Buyer's covenants or agreements hereunder of which Seller has given written notice to Buyer and, secondly, at Buyer's option, as a cash refund to Buyer or a credit toward Buyer's future obligation hereunder. If the amount of the funds held by Seller shall not be sufficient to pay all such charges as herein provided, Buyer shall pay to Seller any amount necessary to make up the deficiency within 30 days from the date notice is mailed by Seller to Buyer requesting payment thereof.

Seller may not charge for so holding and applying the funds, analyzing said account, or verifying and compiling said assessments and bills, nor shall Buyer be entitled to interest or earnings on the funds, unless otherwise agreed in writing at the time of execution of this Agreement. Upon payment in full of all sums due hereunder, Seller shall promptly return to Buyer any funds so held by Seller.

19. BUYER'S INTERESTS:

(a) No right, title, or interest, legal or equitable, in the premises described herein, or in any part thereof, shall vest in the Buyer until the Deed, as herein provided, shall be delivered to the Buyer.

(b) In the event of the termination of this Agreement by lapse of time, forfeiture or otherwise, all improvements, whether finished or unfinished, whether installed or disassembled or of about said premises by the Buyer or others shall belong to and become the property of the Seller without liability or obligation on seller's part to account to the Buyer therefore or for any part thereof.

20. LIENS:

(a) Buyer shall not suffer or permit any mechanics' lien, judgment lien or other lien of any nature whatsoever to attach to or be against the property which shall be superior to his rights as Seller.

(b) Each and every contract for repairs or improvements on the premises aforesaid, or any part thereof, shall contain an express, full and complete waiver and release of any and all lien or claim of lien against the subject premises, and no contract or agreement, oral or written shall be executed by the Buyer for repairs or improvements upon the premises, except if in some shall contain such express waiver or release of lien upon the part of the party contracting, and a copy of each and every such contract shall be promptly delivered to Seller.

21. PERFORMANCE:

(a) If Buyer (1) defaults by failing to pay, when due any single installment or payment required to be made to Seller under the terms of this Agreement and such default is not cured within ten (10) days of written notice to Buyer in the performance of any other covenant or agreement hereof and such default is not cured by Buyer within thirty (30) days after written notice to Buyer (unless the default involves a dangerous condition which shall be cured forthwith); Seller may treat such a default as a breach of this Agreement and may thereupon take any one or more of the following remedies in addition to all other rights and remedies provided at law or in equity: (i) declare an action for any unpaid installments; (ii) declare the entire balance due and maintain an action for such amounts; (iii) forfeit the property covered under this Agreement and retain all sums paid as liquidated damages in full satisfaction of any claim against Buyer; and (iv) sue for failure to surrender possession, maintain an action for possession under the "Forfeiture and Detainer Act," subject to the laws of the State of California as provided in that Act.

(b) As a lawful security in the event of default, Buyer assigns to Seller all unpaid rents, and all rents which accrue thereafter, and in addition thereto, as provided above and in conjunction with any one of them, Seller may collect any rents due and owing and may seek an injunction or decree for:

(c) default by Buyer upon the failure to pay taxes, assessments, insurance, or hem. Seller may elect to make such payments and add the amount to the principal balance due, which amount shall become immediately due and payable by Buyer to Seller.

(d) Seller may impose a late fee if Buyer agrees to pay a late charge not exceeding 5% of any sum due hereunder which Seller elects to accept after the date the sum is due.

(e) Anything contained in paragraphs (a) through (d) to the contrary notwithstanding, this Agreement shall not be forfeited and discontinued, it within 30 days after such written notice of default, Buyer tenders to Seller the entire unpaid principal balance of the Purchase Price and interest thereon then outstanding and cures any other defaults of a monetary nature affecting the premises or monetary claims arising from acts or omissions of Buyer under this Agreement.

22. DISPUTES, FEES:

(a) Buyer or Seller shall pay all reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred by the other in enforcing the terms and provisions of this Agreement, including forfeiture of specific performance, in defending any proceeding to which Buyer or Seller is made a party to any of proceedings as a result of the acts or omissions of the other party.

(b) (1) All rights and remedies given to Buyer or Seller shall be distinct, separate and cumulative, and the use of one or more thereof shall not estop or waive any other right or remedy allowed by law, unless specifically waived in this Agreement; (2) no waiver of any breach or default of either party hereto under this Agreement shall be implied from any omission by the other party to take any action on account of any similar or different breach or default; the payment or acceptance of money after it falls due after knowledge of any breach of this Agreement by Buyer or Seller, or after the termination or lapsing of any right of possession hereunder, or after the service of any notice, or after commencement of any suit, or after final judgment for possession, the premises shall not be reinstated, continue or extend this Agreement nor affect any such note, demand or suit or any right hereunder not herein expressly waived.

(c) NOTICES: All notices required to be given under this Agreement shall be construed to mean notice in writing signed by or on behalf of the party giving the same, and the same may be served upon the other party or his agent personally or by certified or registered mail, except as set forth in paragraph V or to the Buyer at the address of the premises. Notice shall be deemed made when it is filed or served.

(d) **ABANDONMENT:** Should Buyer's physical absence by Buyer with any installment being unpaid, or removal of the substantial portion of Buyer's personal property, with installments being paid, and, in either case, action to believe Buyer has vacated the premises with no intent again to take up residence, then the same shall be conclusively deemed to be an abandonment of the premises by Buyer. In such event, and in addition to Seller's remedies set forth in paragraph 20, Seller may, but need not, enter upon the premises and act at Buyer's agent to perform necessary恭uring and repairs and to repossess the premises outright or in trust, similar to those contained in this Agreement, with reference to them existing恭uring conditions. Buyer shall be conclusively deemed to have abandoned all personal property remaining in or about the premises and Buyer's interest therein shall thereby pass under the Agreement as a bill of sale to Seller without additional payment on Seller's part.

(e) **SELLER'S ACTS:** Seller may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon and inspection of the premises, provided that Seller shall give the Buyer notice prior to any such inspection specifying reasonable cause therefor related to Seller's interest in the premises.

(f) **CALCULATION OF INTEREST:** Interest for each month shall be added to the unpaid balance on the first day of each month at the rate equivalent of the annual interest rate and shall be calculated upon the unpaid balance due as of the last day of the preceding month based upon a 360 day year. Interest for the period from the date of initial closing until the date the final installment is due shall be payable in advance of the date of initial closing.

(g) **ASSIGNMENT:** The Buyer shall not transfer, pledge or assign this Agreement or any interest herein. The Seller under nor shall the Buyer have any subject the premises, or any part thereof. Any violation or breach or attempted violation, ... by any of the provisions of this Agreement by Buyer, or any acts inconsistent therewith, shall vest no right, title or interest herein or hereunder, or in the said premises in any such transferee, pledgee, assignee, lessee or sub-lessee, but Seller may, at Seller's option, declare it null and void and cancel the provisions of this Agreement relating to forfeiture hereof.

(h) **FINAL CLOSING:** Seller shall be entitled to delivery of the Deed of conveyance aforesaid Affidavit of Title and a Bill of Sale to the personal property to be transferred to Buyer under this Agreement at any time upon payment of all amounts due hereunder in the form of cash or cashier's or certified check made payable to Seller, which amount shall be without premium or penalty. At the time Buyer provides notice to Seller that he is prepared to pay all amounts due hereunder, Seller (without further notice) shall produce his/her original release deed to the prior mortgage, or obtain a currently dated loan repayment letter reflecting the amount, interest, and/or due date and release the prior mortgage. Seller at all have the right to repay and discharge such prior mortgage in whole or in part from time to time as provided hereinunder. From Buyer, the repayment of the prior mortgage shall be supervised and administered by Buyer's mortgage lender, if any. Upon repayment of the prior mortgage Seller shall receive the cancelled note and a release dated in form satisfactory for recording which shall be delivered to Buyer. Seller shall give Buyer a credit against the balance of the purchase price for the cost of recording such release. In the event Buyer does not have a mortgage lender, then the delivery of the cancelled note to Seller shall be simultaneous with the delivery of the Deed from Seller to Buyer, and to facilitate the delivery of documents and the payment of the prior mortgage and the balance of the amount due hereunder, the parties agree to complete such exchange at the offices of the holder of the note secured by the prior mortgage. At the time of delivery of the Deed, Buyer and Seller shall execute and furnish such real estate transfer declarations as may be required to comply with State, County or local law. Seller shall pay the amount of any stamp tax then imposed by State or County law on the transfer of title to Buyer, and Buyer shall pay any such stamp tax and meet other requirements as then may be established by any local ordinance with regard to the transfer of title to Buyer unless otherwise provided in the local ordinance.

29. TITLE IN TRUST:

(a) If the event in issue to the premises is held in or conveyed into a trust prior to the initial closing, it shall be conveyed to Buyer when and if appropriate under the terms of this Agreement in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2, except that the conveyance shall be by Trustee's Deed. In such case, the names and addresses of each and every beneficiary of and person with a power to direct the title holder is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

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(b) The beneficiaries of the trust or, and the person or persons with the power to direct the trustee, shall cumulatively be deemed to have joint and several liability of all the rights, benefits, obligations and duties by the power to be exercised or performed hereunder and such action or persons with the power to direct the trustee jointly and severally agree in doing the trustee to perform such obligation and take as such persons or the beneficiaries may not under the terms of the Trust Agreement do or perform themselves directly.

(c) If, at the time of execution of this Agreement, title to the premises is not held in a trust, Seller agrees that upon the written request of the Buyer, any time prior to the final closing, Seller shall convey title into a trust and comply with subparagraphs (a) and (b) of this paragraph 29 with Buyer paying all trustee fees and recording costs resulting therefrom.

20. RECORDING: The parties shall record this Agreement or a memorandum thereof at Buyer's expense.

21. RIDERS: The provisions contained in any rider attached hereto are and for all purposes shall be deemed to be part of this agreement as though herein fully set forth.

22. CAPTIONS AND PRINCIPLES: The captions and headings of the various sections or paragraphs of this Agreement are for convenience only, and are not to be construed as controlling or limiting in any way the scope or intent of the provisions hereof. Whenever the context requires or permits, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular and the masculine, feminine and neuter shall be freely interchangeable.

23. PROVISIONS SEVERABLE: The unenforceability or invalidity of any provision or provisions hereof shall not render any other provision or provisions herein contained unenforceable or invalid.

24. BINDING ON HEIRS, TIME OF ESSENCE: This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Seller and Buyer. Time is of the essence in this Agreement.

25. JOINT AND SEVERAL OBLIGATIONS: The obligations of two or more persons designated "Seller" or "Buyer" in this Agreement shall be joint and several, and in such case each hereby authorizes the other or others of the same designation at his or her sole discretion in fact to do or perform any act or agreement with respect to this Agreement at the premises.

26. NOT BINDING UNTIL SIGNED: A duplicate original of this Agreement duly executed by this Seller and his spouse, if any, or if Seller is a trustee, their by said trustee and the beneficiaries of the trust shall be delivered to the Buyer or his attorney on or before , 19 , otherwise at the Buyer's option this Agreement shall become null and void and the earnest money, if any, shall be refunded to the Buyer.

27. REAL ESTATE BROKER: Seller and Buyer represent and warrant that no real estate broker(s) were involved in this transaction other than _____ Does Not Apply _____
